## What you will need:

AUNT LYDIA'S® Classic Crochet Thread, Size 10: 1 ball each Pumpkin 431, Black 12, Hot Pink 332

Susan Bates® Crochet Hook: 1.50mm [US 7]

Tapestry needle

Optional: Fabric Stiffener, Styrofoam® Head form, 1" (2 ½ cm) Brush, Rust proof pins

GAUGE: 23 sc = 4" (10 cm).  
CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size hook to obtain your gauge.

AUNT LYDIA'S® Classic Crochet Thread, Size 10, Art. 154 available in white & ecru 400 yd; solid color 250 yd; shaded color 300 yd balls

# Go Incognito Masks

*Whether you are dressing as a marvelous super heroine or going to a masquerade ball, this clever mask will fit the bill. Choose from any of the many colors of Aunt Lydia's crochet thread for the perfect alluring mask.*

Mask measures approx. 3 ¾" (9 ½ cm) long x 8" (20 ¼ cm) wide, excluding ties.

## Special Stitches

**Dtr5tog** = \*Yo 3 times, insert hook in next st, draw up a loop, [yo, draw through 2 loops] 3 times; repeat from \* 4 times, yo, draw through all 6 loops on hook.

**Picot**: Ch 3, slip st in first ch.

## MASK

### Center Circle

Ch 8, join with slip st in first ch to form a ring.  
**Round 1 (right side)**: Ch 4, 2 tr in ring, ch 2, (3 tr in ring, ch 2) 7 times, join with slip st in top of beginning ch-4. Fasten off.

### Right Eye Circle

Ch 45, join with slip st in first ch to form a ring.  
**Round 1 (right side)**: Ch 1, sc in same ch as join and in each remaining ch around, join with slip st in first sc—45 sc.

**Round 2**: (Ch 4, tr) in first sc, 2 tr in each of next 8 sc, 2 dc in each of next 6 sc, 2 hdc in each of next 3 sc, sc in each of next 12 sc, place marker between 5th and 6th sc and between 8th and 9th sc, 2 hdc in each of next 3 sc, 2 dc in each of next 6 sc, 2 tr in each of next 6 sc, join with slip st in top of beginning ch-5. Fasten off.

### Left Eye Circle

**Round 1**: Work same for Right Eye Circle.

**Round 2**: (Ch 4, tr) in first sc, 2 tr in each of next 8 sc, 2 dc in each of next 6 sc, 2 hdc in each of next 3 sc, sc in each of next 12 sc, place marker between 4th and 5th sc and between 7th and 8th sc, 2 hdc in each of next 3 sc, 2 dc in each of next 6 sc, 2 tr in each of next 6 sc, join with slip st in top of beg ch-5. Do not fasten off.

## Center Seam

Whipstitch 3 sts between markers together, remove markers. Continue with edging on left eye circle.

## Edging and joining center circle

**Round 1**: Ch 6, dtr5tog, ch 6, skip next st, slip st in next st, [ch 4, skip 3 sts, slip st in next st] 5 times, ch 2, slip st in any ch-2 space on Center Circle, ch 2, skip next 3 sts on Eye Circle, slip st in next st on Eye Circle, ch 2, slip st in next ch-2 sp to the left on Center Circle, ch 2, skip next 3 sts on Eye Circle, slip st in next st on Eye Circle, ch 3, tr in Center Seam, skip next dc on Center Circle, slip st in next dc on Center Circle, ch 3, skip next 4 sts on next Eye Circle, slip st in next st, [ch 2, slip st in next ch-2 space on Center Circle, ch 2, skip next 3 sts on Eye Circle, slip st in next st] twice, [ch 4, skip next 3 sts on Eye Circle, slip st in next st] 5 times, ch 6, skip next st, dtr5tog, dtr in next st, ch 6, slip st in next st, [ch 5, skip next 3 sts, slip st in next st, picot, slip st in same st as last slip st made] 7 times, ch 5, skip next 3 sts, slip st in next st, 4 tr in Center Seam, skip next 2 sts, slip st in next st, [ch 5, skip next 3 sts, slip st in next st, picot, slip st in same st as last slip st made] 7 times, ch 5, slip st in last st, ch 6, join with slip st in top of dtr5tog.

**Round 2**: Ch 1, sc in dtr5tog, (ch 6, slip st, picot, slip st) in next ch-6 sp and each of next 4 ch-4 spaces, ch 6, slip st in next ch-5 space, [(slip st, picot, slip st, ch 6) in next unworked ch-2 space on Center Circle] 3 times, (slip st, picot, slip st) in next ch-2 space on Center Circle, slip st in next ch-5 space, [(ch 6, slip

st, picot, slip st) in next ch-5 space] 4 times, (ch 6, slip st, picot, slip st) in next ch-6 space, ch 6, sc in dtr5tog, (ch 6, slip st, picot, slip st) in next ch-6 space and in each of next 7 ch-5 spaces, ch 6, slip st in next ch-5 space, [tr in next tr, ch 1] 3 times, tr in next tr, slip st in next ch-5 space, (ch 6, slip st, picot, slip st) in each of next 7 ch-5 spaces and in next ch-6 space, ch 6, join with slip st in beginning sc.

**Row 3:** (Ch 4, 6 tr) in sc, (ch 6, slip st, picot, slip st) in each of next 7 ch-6 spaces, ch 6, [(tr, picot) 5 times, tr] in next ch-6 space, (ch 6, slip st, picot, slip st) in each of next 7 ch-6 spaces, ch 6, (6 tr, ch 4, slip st) in next sc. Fasten off.

#### Tie

Make tie 48" (122 cm) long. With right side of Mask facing, wrap tie from front to back through first ch-6 space of last row, then pull tie from back to front through last ch-6 space at opposite side. Center strand goes behind head for wearing support. Pull ends of Tie from front to back around 6 tr and ch 4 at each end.

#### FINISHING

Weave in ends.

#### Stiffen Mask

With wrong side of Mask facing, brush fabric stiffener onto Mask. Wrap Mask around the Styrofoam® head form. Form the Mask, pinning it in place with rustproof pins. Brush fabric stiffener onto right side of Mask and let dry completely.

#### ABBREVIATIONS

**ch** = chain; **cm** = centimeter; **dc** = double crochet; **dtr** = double treble crochet; **mm** = millimeters; **sc** = single crochet; **st(s)** = stitch(es); **tr** = treble crochet; **[ ]** = work directions in brackets the number of times specified; **\* or \*\*** = repeat whatever follows the \* or \*\* as indicated.
