## What you will need:

AUNT LYDIA'S° Classic Crochet Thread, Size 10: 1 ball each 805 Blue Hawaii A, 226 Natural B, and 480 Delft C

Susan Bates° Steelite° Crochet Hook: 1.7mm [US 5] Yarn needle, sewing needle and matching threads

GAUGE: Rounds 1-4 of Motif 1 = 2½" (5.5 cm). CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.

AUNT LYDIA'S® Classic Crochet Thread, Size 10, Art. 154 available in white & ecru 400 yd; solid color 350 yd; shaded color 300 yd balls



# Doilyed for Denim Jacket

Pretty little doilies are fun to crochet and then display artfully on your denim jacket or jeans. Choose from seven different motifs featuring cool shades of blue.

Finished diameters after blocking:
Doilies I and II: 2½" (5.5 cm)
Doilies III and IV: 2¾" (7 cm)
Doily V: 4¾" (12 cm)
Doily VI: 3¼" (8.5 cm)
Doily VII: 3¾" (9.5 cm)

#### Notes

- Fourteen doilies in 7 motifs are worked in joined rounds with right side facing at all times.
- To change color, work last stitch of old color to last yarn over. Yarn over with new color and draw through all loops on hook to complete stitch. Proceed with new color. Cut old color.
- Refer to photographs for placement on purchased jacket or arrange and sew as desired.

## **Special Stitches**

indicated space.

**Beg dc3tog** = Ch 3, [yarn over, insert hook in next stitch, yarn over and pull up loop, yarn over, draw through 2 loops] 2 times, yarn over, draw through all 3 loops on hook. **Beg V-st (beginning V-stitch)** = Ch 4, dc in

Beg 2-dc Cl (beginning 2 double crochet Cl) = Ch 3, yarn over, insert hook in indicated stitch, yarn over and pull up loop, [yarn over, draw through 2 loops on hook] 2 times.

Beg 3-dc CI (beginning 3 double crochet CI) = Ch 3, yarn over, insert hook in indicated stitch, yarn over and pull up loop, yarn over, draw through 2 loops on hook, insert hook in same stitch, yarn over and pull up loop, yarn over, draw through all 3 loops on hook.

dc3tog = [Yarn over, insert hook in next stitch, yarn over and pull up loop, yarn over, draw through 2 loops] 3 times, yarn over, draw through all 4 loops on hook.

picot = Ch 3, slip st in 3rd ch from hook.V-st (V-stitch) = (Dc, ch 1, dc) in indicated space.

2-dc Cl (2 double crochet Cl) = Yarn over, insert hook in indicated stitch, yarn over and pull up loop, yarn over, draw through 2 loops on hook (2 loops remain on hook); yarn over, insert hook in same stitch, yarn over and pull up loop, yarn over, draw through 2 loops, yarn over, draw through all 3 loops on hook.

**3-dc CI (3 double crochet CI)** = Yarn over, insert hook in indicated stitch, yarn over and pull up loop, yarn over, draw through 2 loops on hook (2 loops remain on hook); [yarn over, insert hook in same stitch, yarn over and pull up loop, yarn over, draw through 2 loops] 2 times, yarn over, draw through all 4 loops on hook.

2-sc Cl (2 single crochet Cl) = Insert hook in indicated stitch, yarn over and pull up loop, yarn over, yarn over, insert hook in same stitch, yarn over, pull up loop, yarn over, draw through all 4 loops on hook.

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## **DOILIES**

Motif 1 (make 1 each with A and C)



Ch 5; join with slip st in first ch to form a ring.

**Round 1:** Beg 3-dc Cl in ring, \*ch 3, 3-dc Cl in ring; repeat from \* 4 times, ch 3; join with slip st in beg 3-dc Cl—six 3-dc Cls and 6 ch-3 spaces.

Round 2: Ch 1, sc in first 3-dc Cl, ch 5, sc in next ch-3 space, \*ch 5, sc in next 3-dc Cl, ch 5, sc in next ch-3 space; repeat from \* around, ch 2, dc in first sc (ch 2, dc counts as last ch-5 space)—12 sc and 12 ch-5 spaces.

**Round 3:** Ch 1, sc in last ch-5 space, (ch 6, sc) in each remaining ch-5 space, ch 3, dc in first sc (ch 3, dc counts as last ch-6 space—12 sc and 12 ch-6 spaces.

**Round 4:** Ch 1, sc in last ch-6 space (ch 7, sc) in each remaining ch-6 space, ch 7; join with slip st in first sc—12 sc and 12 ch-7 spaces. Fasten off.

#### Motif 2 (make 2)



With **A**, ch 5; join with slip st in first ch to form a ring.

**Round 1:** Work same as Round 1 of Motif 1; change to **B**.

**Rounds 2–4:** Work same as Rounds 2–4 of Motif 1.

### Motif 3 (make 2)



With **B**, ch 5; join with slip st in first ch to form a ring.

**Round 1:** Ch 3 (counts as first dc), dc in ring, \*ch 2, 2 dc in ring; repeat from \* 4 times, ch 2; join with slip st in top of beg ch—12 dc and 6 ch-2 spaces.

Round 2: Slip st in next dc and first ch-2 space, ch 5 (counts as first dc and ch 2), dc in same ch-2 space, [ch 2, dc] 2 times in each remaining ch-2 space, ch 2; join with slip st in 3rd ch of beg ch—12 dc and 12 ch-2 spaces.

**Round 3:** (Beg 2-dc Cl, ch 3, 2-dc Cl) in first dc, (ch 3, dc) in next dc, \*[ch 3, 2-dc Cl] 2 times in next dc, (ch 3, dc) in next dc; repeat from \* around, ch 3; join with slip st in beg 2-dc Cl—twelve 2-dc Cls, 6 dc, and 18 ch-3 spaces.

**Round 4:** Slip st in next dc and first ch-3 space, (beg 3-dc Cl, picot, 3-dc Cl) in same ch-3 space, ch 3, (3-dc Cl, picot, 3-dc Cl) in next dc, \*ch 3, skip next ch-3 space, (3-dc Cl, picot, 3-dc Cl) in next ch-3 space, ch 3, (3-dc Cl, picot, 3-dc Cl) in next dc; repeat from \* around, ch 3; join with slip st in beg 3-dc Cl—twenty-four 3-dc Cls, 12 picots, and 12 ch-3 spaces. Fasten off.

## Motif 4 (make 2)



With **B**, ch 5; join with slip st in first ch to form a ring.

**Round 1:** Work same as Round 1 of Motif 3. **Round 2:** Work same as Round 2 of Motif 3; change to **A**.

**Round 3:** Work same as Round 3 of Motif 3; change to **C**.

Round 4: Work same as Round 4 of Motif 3.

## Motif 5 (make 2)



With **A**, ch 7; join with slip st in first ch to form a ring.

**Round 1:** Ch 3 (counts as first dc here and throughout), 23 dc in ring; join with slip st in top of beg ch—24 dc.

**Round 2:** Ch 3, dc in first dc, \*ch 3, skip next dc, 2 dc next dc; repeat from \* around, ch 3, skip last dc; join with slip st in top of beg ch— 24 dc and 12 ch-3 spaces.

**Round 3:** Slip st in next dc and first ch-3 space, ch 3, 4 dc in same ch-3 space, (ch 1, 5 dc) in each remaining ch-3 space, ch 1; join with slip st in top of beg ch—60 dc and 12 ch-1 spaces.

**Round 4:** (Slip st, ch 1, sc) in last ch-1 space, (ch 6, sc) in each remaining ch-1 space, ch 6; join with slip st in first sc—12 sc and 12 ch-6 spaces. Fasten off.

**Round 5:** Join **B** with slip st in any ch-6 space, (beg 3-dc Cl, ch 3, 3-dc Cl) in same ch-6 space, [ch 3, 3-dc Cl] 2 times in each remaining ch-6 space, ch 3; join with slip st in beg 3-dc Cl— 24 3-dc Cls and 24 ch-3 spaces. Fasten off.

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**Round 6:** Join **C** with slip st in any ch-3 space, ch 1, sc in same ch-3 space, (ch 5, sc) in each remaining ch-3 space, ch 5; join with slip st in first sc—24 sc and 24 ch-5 spaces. **Round 7:** (Slip st, ch 3, 3 dc, 2 tr, picot, 2 tr, 4 dc) in first ch-5 space (first shell made), sc in next ch-5 space, [(ch 5, sc) in next ch-5 space] 2 times, \*(4 dc, 2 tr, picot, 2 tr, 4 dc) in next ch-5 space (shell made), sc in next ch-5 space, [(ch 5, sc) in next ch-5 space] 2 times; repeat from \* around; join with slip st in top of beg ch—6 shells, 18 sc, and 12 ch-5 spaces. Fasten off.

## Motif 6 (make 1 each with A and C)



Ch 5; join with slip st in first ch to form a ring.

Round 1: Ch 6 (counts as first dc and ch-3 space), dc in ring, [ch 3, dc in ring] 6 times, ch 3; join with slip st in 3rd ch of beg ch—8 dc and 8 ch-3 spaces.

Round 2: Ch 1, sc in same st as join, (ch 6, sc) in each dc, ch 6; join with slip st in first sc—8 dc and 8 ch-6 spaces.

Round 3: Slip st in first ch-6 space, ch 3 (counts as first dc), (2 dc, ch 5, 3 dc) in same ch-6 space, (3 dc, ch 5, 3 dc) in each remaining ch-6 space; join with slip st in top of beg ch-3—48 dc and 8 ch-5 spaces.

Round 4: Beg dc3tog, ch 5, 3 dc in first ch-5 space, ch 5, dc3tog, \*dc3tog, ch 5, 3 dc in next ch-5 space, ch 5, dc3tog; repeat from \* around; join with slip st in beg dc3tog-40 dc and 16 ch-5 spaces.

Round 5: (Slip st, ch 1, sc, picot, sc) in first ch-5 space, ch 3, dc3tog, ch 3, (sc, picot, sc) in next ch-5 sp, \*ch 3, (sc, picot, sc) in next ch-5 space, ch 3, dc3tog, ch 3, (sc, picot, sc, ch 3) in next ch-5 space; repeat from \* around, ch 3; join with slip st in first sc-8 dc, 32 sc, and 24 ch-3 spaces. Fasten off.

## Motif 7 (make 2)



With **C**, ch 5; join with slip st in first ch to form a ring.

**Round 1:** Ch 1, sc in ring, \*ch 4, sc in ring; repeat from \* 4 times, ch 1, dc in first sc (ch 1, dc count as last ch-4 sp)—6 sc and 6 ch-4 spaces.

Round 2: Beg V-st in last ch-4 space, (ch 4, V-st) in each remaining ch-4 space, ch 4; join with slip st in 3rd ch of beg V-st—6 V-sts and 6 ch-4 spaces.

Round 3: Slip st in ch-1 space of first V-st, ch 3 (counts as first dc), 4 dc in same space, (ch 3, 5 dc) in ch-1 space of each remaining V-st, ch 3; change to **A**; join with slip st in top of beg ch—30 dc and 6 ch-3 spaces.

Round 4: Ch 1, 2-sc Cl in same st as join, (ch 1, sc) in next 3 dc, ch 1, 2-sc Cl in next dc, \*ch 3, 2-sc Cl in next dc, (ch 1, sc) in next 3 dc, ch 1, 2-sc Cl in next dc; repeat from \* around, ch 3; change to B; join with slip st in first 2-sc Cl-twelve 2-sc Cls, 18 sc, 6 ch-3 spaces, and 24 ch-1 spaces.

Round 5: Ch 1, sc in first ch-1 space, (ch 3, sc) in next 3 ch-1 spaces, \*ch 4, sc in next ch-1 space, (ch 3, sc) in next 3 ch-1 spaces; repeat from \* around, ch 4; join with slip st in first sc-24 sc, 18 ch-3 spaces, and 6 ch-4 spaces.

**Round 6:** Ch 1, sc in first ch-3 space, (ch 3, sc) in next 2 ch-3 spaces, \*ch 8, sc in next ch-3 space, (ch 3, sc) in next 2 ch-3 spaces; repeat from \* around, ch 8; join with slip st in first sc-18 sc, 12 ch-3 spaces, and 6 ch-8

Round 7: Ch 1, sc in first ch-3 space, ch 3, sc in next ch-3 space, ch 3, (3 dc, [picot, 3 dc] 2 times) in same ch-8 space, \*(ch 3, sc) in next 2 ch-3 spaces, ch 3, (3 dc, [picot, 3 dc] 2 times) in next ch-8 space; repeat from \* around, ch 3; join with slip st in first sc—12 sc, 54 dc, and 18 ch-3 spaces. Fasten off.

## **FINISHING**

Weave in ends. Block to finished diameters if desired.

Refer to photographs as a guide for placement. With sewing needle and matching thread, sew doilies on front and back of jacket.

#### **ABBREVIATIONS**

A, B, C = Color A, Color B, Color C; ch = chain(s); **dc** = double crochet; **hdc** = half double crochet; **sc** = single crochet; st(s) = stitch(es); () = work directions in parentheses into same st; [] = work directions in brackets the number of times specified; \* = repeat whatever follows the \* as indicated.
