

## Bodacious Flowers

Flowers are everywhere in the fashion world! Crochet these beauties in bamboo thread with a matching strand of metallic that adds a bit of shimmer. Speedy size 3 thread means you can make one tonight and wear it tomorrow.

Designed by Michele Wilcox.
Pink flower measures 5" diameter.
White flower measures $43 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ diameter.
Yellow flower measures $41 / 2$ " diameter.
AUNT LYDIA'S® "Bamboo Ice ${ }^{\text {TM" }}$ " Size 3: 1 ball each 3702 Pink Ice A, 3631 Green Tea Ice B, 3001 Icicle C, 3201 Lemon Ice D.

Crochet Hook: 3.25 mm [US D-3].
Tapestry needle.
GAUGE: One petal of pink flower $=21 / 4 "$ long. Gauge is not critical for this project. CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.

NOTE: Flowers can be sewn to clothing or accessories. Alternately, pin backs can be sewn to the back of flowers and flowers used as brooches.


## PINK FLOWER

## Petals (make 7)

With A, ch 9 .
Row 1 (Right Side): Sc in 2nd ch from hook (lower end of petal), hdc in next 2 ch , dc in next $4 \mathrm{ch}, 5 \mathrm{dc}$ in last ch (petal tip); working across opposite side of foundation ch, dc in next 4 ch, hdc in next 2 ch , sc in last ch, turn-19 sts.
Row 2: Ch 1, sc in first 3 sts, hdc in next 3 sts, dc in next 3 sts, 5 dc in next st, dc in next 3 sts, hdc in next 3 sts, sc in last 3 sts, turn- 23 sts.
Row 3: Ch 1, sc in first 3 sts, hdc in next 3 sts, dc in next 5 sts, 5 dc in next st, dc in next 5 sts, hdc in next 3 sts, sc in last 3 sts- 27 sts. Fasten off.

## Leaves

With B, ch 12; taking care not to twist ch, join with slip st in first ch to form a ring.
Round 1 (Right Side): Ch 1, work 18 sc in ring; join with slip st in first sc-18 sc.
Round 2: Ch 1, sc in same sc as join, sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc, [sc in next $2 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next sc] 5 times; join with slip st in first sc-24 sc.
Round 3: Ch 1, sc in same sc as join, sc in next $2 \mathrm{sc}, 2$ sc in next sc, [sc in next 3 sc, 2 sc in next sc] 5 times; join with slip st in first sc-30 sc.
Round 4: Ch 1, sc in same sc as join, sc in next $3 \mathrm{sc}, 2$ sc in next sc, [sc in next $4 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next sc] 5 times; join with slip st in first sc-36 sc.
Round 5: Ch 1, sc in same sc as join, sc in next $4 \mathrm{sc}, 2$ sc in next sc, [sc in next $5 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next sc$] 5$ times; join with slip st in first sc-42 sc.
Round 6: *Ch 9, sc in 2nd ch from hook, hdc in next ch, dc in next ch, tr in next 5 ch (beginning of first leaf), skip

3 sc in next sc (tip of leaf); work 8 sc evenly spaced across opposite side of ch-9, slip st in st at base of ch-9, TURN, skip slip st just made, sc in next sc, hdc in next 2 sc , dc in next $5 \mathrm{sc}, 5 \mathrm{dc}$ in next sc, dc in next 5 sc , hdc in next 2 sc , sc in next sc, slip st in last sc of leaf, slip st in next 2 sc of Round 5; repeat from * 2 more times. Fasten off.

## Flower Center

With A, ch 2.
Round 1 (Right Side): Work 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook; do not join, work in a continuous spiral-6 sc.
Round 2: Work 2 sc in each sc around-12 sc.
Round 3: [Sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc] 6 times- 18 sc .
Round 4: *Slip st in next sc, ch 10, 3 sc in 2nd ch from hook and in next 8 ch, skip next sc of Round 2; repeat from * around. Fasten off.

FINISHING
With Right Side facing, arrange petals in a circle, with lower ends of petals together and sides of petals overlapping. With A, sew petals together. Place petals in center of leaves. Place flower center in center of petals. With A, sew leaves and flower center in place. Weave in ends.


## WHITE FLOWER

Front Petals
With B, ch 2.
Round 1 (Right Side): Work 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook; do not join, work in a continuous spiral-6 sc.
Round 2: Work 2 sc in each sc around-12 sc.
Rounds 3 and 4: Working in back loops only, sc in each sc around. Fasten off B.
hdc in same st, hdc in next st, ch 1, [(slip st, ch 1, hdc) in next st, hdc in next st, ch 1] 5 times ( 6 petals made); working in unworked front loops of Round 3, [(slip st, ch $2,2 \mathrm{dc}$ ) in next st, 2 dc in next st, ch 2] 6 times ( 6 more petals made); working in front loops only of Round 4, [(slip st, ch 3, 2 tr) in next st, 2 tr in next st, ch 3] 6 times, slip st in next st. Fasten off.

## First Layer of Leaves

With Right Side of front petals facing, fold petals forward to work in unworked back loops of Round 4. Join B with sc in first unworked back loop.
Round 1 (Right Side): Working in unworked back loops of Round 4, sc in same st as joining, 2 sc in each of remaining $11 \mathrm{sc}-24 \mathrm{sc}$.
Round 2: [Sc in next $3 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next sc] 6 times- 30 sc . Round 3: *(Slip st, ch 1, hdc) in next sc, 2 dc in next sc, (2 tr, ch 2, sc in 2nd ch from hook, 2 tr) in next sc, 2 dc in next sc, (hdc, ch 1, slip st) in next sc; repeat from * around-6 leaves.

## Back Petals (make 6)

With C, ch 5.
Row 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook, hdc in next ch, dc in next ch, 6 dc in last ch; working across opposite side of foundation ch, dc in next ch, hdc in next ch, sc in last ch, turn-12 sts.
Row 2: Ch 1 , sc in first 4 sts, 2 sc in next 4 sts, sc in last 4 sts-16 sts. Fasten off.

## Second Layer of Leaves

With B, ch 2.
Round 1 (Right Side): Work 6 sc in 2 nd ch from hook; do not join, work in a continuous spiral-6 sc.
Round 2: Work 2 sc in each sc around-12 sc.
Round 3: [Sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc] 6 times- 18 sc .
Round 4: Work 2 sc in each sc around- 36 sc .
Round 5: [Sc in next 5 sc, 2 sc in next sc] 6 times-42 sc.
Round 6: *Slip st in next sc, (sc, ch 1, hdc) in next sc, 2 dc in next sc, ( $2 \mathrm{tr}, \mathrm{ch} 2$, sc in 2nd ch from hook, 2 tr ) in next sc, 2 dc in next sc, (hdc, ch 1, sc) in next sc, slip st in next sc; repeat from * around-6 leaves.
Round 7: *Skip next slip st, sc in each st and ch to next ch-2 space, 3 sc in next ch-2 space (tip of leaf), sc in each st and ch to next slip st, skip next slip st; repeat from * around. Fasten off.

## FINISHING

With Right Side facing, arrange back petals in a circle, evenly spaced between front petals and first layer of leaves. With C, sew back petals in place. Place assembled flower into second layer of leaves, arranging the leaves of the second layer between leaves of the first layer. With B, sew second layer of leaves to flower. Weave in ends.


## YELLOW FLOWER

## First Layer of Petals

With D, ch 5; taking care not to twist ch, join with slip st in first ch to form a ring.
Round 1 (Right Side): Ch 1, work 12 sc in ring; join with slip st in first sc-12 sc.
Round 2: Ch 1, 2 sc in same sc as join, 2 sc in each remaining sc around; join with slip st in first sc-24 sc.
Round 3: Ch 1, sc in same sc as join, 2 sc in next sc, [sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc] 11 times- 36 sc.
Round 4: Ch 1, sc in same sc as join, sc in each sc around; join with slip st in first sc.
Round 5: Ch 1, hdc in same sc as join, (dc, tr) in next $\mathrm{sc},(\mathrm{tr}, \mathrm{dc})$ in next sc, hdc in next sc, ch 1, *(slip st, ch 1, hdc) in next sc, (dc, tr) in next sc, (tr, dc) in next sc, hdc in next sc, ch 1; join with slip st in same sc as beginning-9 petals. Fasten off.

## Second Layer of Petals

Work same as first layer of petals through Round 3-36 sc.
Round 4: Work same as Round 5 of first layer of petals-9 petals. Fasten off.

## Third Layer of Petals

Work same as first layer of petals through Round 2—24 sc.
Round 3: Ch 1, hdc in same sc as join, *[hdc in next sc, ch 1, slip st in next sc, ch 1, hdc in next sc] twice, hdc in next sc, ch 1, (slip st, ch 1, hdc) in next sc; repeat from * once more, [hdc in next sc, ch 1, slip st in next sc, ch 1, hdc in next sc] twice, hdc in next sc, ch 1, slip st in same sc as join-9 petals. Fasten off.

## Fourth Layer of Petals

Work same as first layer of petals through Round 1-12 sc.
Round 2: *Ch 1, 3 hdc in next sc, slip st in next sc; repeat from * around- 6 petals. Fasten off.

Fifth Layer of Petals
With $\mathbf{D}$, ch 2.
Round 1 (Right Side): Work 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook; do not join, work in a continuous spiral- 6 sc .
Round 2: Work 2 sc in each sc around-12 sc.
Round 3: *Slip st in next sc, ch 1, hdc in next sc; repeat from * around- 6 petals. Fasten off.

## Leaves

With B, ch 12; taking care not to twist ch, join with slip st in first ch to form a ring.
Round 1 (Right Side): Ch 3 (counts as first dc here and throughout), work 23 dc in ring; join with slip st in top of beginning ch-3-24 dc.
Round 2: Ch 3, dc in same ch as join, dc in next dc, [2 dc in next dc, dc in next dc] 11 times; join with slip st in top of beginning ch-3-36 dc.
Round 3: Ch 1, sc in same ch as join, sc in next $4 \mathrm{dc}, 2$ sc in next dc, [sc in next $5 \mathrm{dc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next dc] 5 times; join with slip st in first sc-42 sc.
Round 4: Ch 1, sc in same sc as join, *hdc in next sc, dc in next sc, 3 tr in next sc, dc in next sc, hdc in next sc, sc in next sc, ch 6, 3 sc in 2 nd ch from hook, 3 sc in remaining 4 ch $^{* *}$, sc in next sc of Round 3; repeat from * around, ending last repeat at **; join with slip st in first sc-6 leaves and 6 spirals. Fasten off.

## FINISHING

Stack petals from first layer upwards. With D, sew petals together through center. With B, sew leaves to back of flower. Weave in ends.

AUNT LYDIA'S® "Bamboo Ice ${ }^{\text {TM }} 96 \%$ Viscose from Bamboo/4\% Metallic" Size 3, Art 147M available in 100 yd (147m) balls.

ABBREVIATIONS: A, B, C, D = Color A, Color B, Color C, Color D; ch = ch; dc = double crochet; hdc = half double crochet; sc = single crochet; $\mathbf{s t}(\mathbf{s})=$ stitch(es); $\mathbf{t r}=$ treble crochet; [ ] = work directions in brackets the number of times specified; * or ** $=$ repeat whatever follows the * or ** as indicated.
