MATERIALS

Aunt Lydia's® Baby Shower™ (170 yds/155 m)

Contrast A Crayon Blue (4160) 1 ball Contrast B Yellow (7330) 1 ball

Size U.S. D/3 (3.25 mm) crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge. Yarn needle.





ABBREVIATIONS

Approx = Approximately **Beg** = Beginning Ch = Chain(s)**Rem** = Remaining Rnd(s) = Round(s)

RS = Right side **Sc** = Single crochet **WS** = Wrong side **Yoh** = Yarn over hook

SIZE

To fit infant 0-3 mos. **Sole:** Approx 31/4" [8.5 cm].

GAUGE

22 sc and 24 rows = 4" [10 cm]

INSTRUCTIONS

Notes:

- Each bootie is made from a flat piece that is folded and seamed to form bootie.
- Surface slip stitch trim is worked around top opening of each bootie.

BOOTIE (make 2) With A, ch 19, leaving long end of yarn for sewing.

First Side

1st row: 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook and each ch to end of chain. 18 sc. Turn.

2nd to 18th rows: Ch 1. 1 sc in each sc to end of row. Turn. **Do not** fasten off at end of last row.

Toe

1st row: Ch 1. 1 sc in each of first 9 sc. Turn. Leave rem sts unworked, 9 sc.

2nd to 9th rows: Ch 1.1 sc in each of next 9 sc. Turn. **Do not** fasten off at end of last row.





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Second Side

1st row: Ch 10. 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook and each of next 8 ch. 1 sc in each of next 9 sc. 18 sc.

each sc to end of row. Turn. Fasten off, leaving 18-20" [45.5-51 cm] end of yarn for sewing.

FINISHING

Fold Bootie in half. With beginning tail, sew heel seam. With ending tail, sew sole seam. Continue with ending tail, weave tail through ends of rows at toe and pull tightly to form toe and close opening. Weave in ends.

Surface Slip Stitch Trim

With B, work surface slip stitch trim around top opening of each bootie, as follows:

2nd to 18th rows: Ch 1. 1 sc in With RS facing, beg at heel end of bootie, hold yarn on WS. Leaving a long beg end of yarn, insert hook from RS to WS in top edge of bootie. Yoh and draw loop through fabric to RS (1 loop on hook). *Insert hook in next stitch along top edge of bootie. Yoh and draw loop through fabric and through loop on hook. Rep from * around top edge of bootie. Fasten off.

Weave in ends.
