MATERIALS

Aunt Lydia's® Baby Shower ™ (170 yds/155 m)

Lavender Bliss (3620)

1 ball

Size U.S. D/3 (3.25 mm) crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge. Yarn needle.





ABBREVIATIONS

Approx = Approximately

Beg = Beginning

Ch = Chain(s)

Hdc = Half double crochet

Hdc-slip (half double crochet **slip stitch)** = Yoh and draw up a

loop in indicated st and through

all loops on hook

Rem = Remaining

RS = Right side

Sc = Single crochet

Sp(s) = Space(s)

St(s) = Stitch(es)

WS = Wrong side

Yoh = Yarn over hook

SIZE

To fit infant 0-3 mos.

Sole: Approx 31/4" [8.5 cm].

GAUGE

22 sc and 24 rows = 4" [10 cm]

INSTRUCTIONS

Notes:

- Each bootie is made from a flat piece that is folded and seamed to form bootie.
- The toe inset of the piece is worked in hdc-slip (half double crochet slip stitch). Take care not to work the hdc-slip stitches too tightly.

BOOTIE (make 2)

Ch 19, leaving a long tail for sewing.

First Side

1st row: (RS). 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook and each ch to end of row. Turn, 18 sc.

2nd to 18th rows: Ch 1, 1 sc in each sc to end of row. Turn.

Do not fasten off at end of last row.






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Toe Inset

of first 9 sts. **Turn.** Leave rem sts unworked. 9 hdc.

2nd to 11th rows: Ch 1. *1 hdc-slip into horizontal bar created below st in previous row (bar is below loops normally worked on WS – see diagram). Rep from * to end of row. Turn.



Do not fasten off at end of last row.

Second Side

1st row: (RS). Ch 10. 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each of next 8 ch. 1 sc in in each of next 9 sc. 18 sc. **2nd to 18th rows:** Ch 1. 1 sc in each sc to end of row. Turn. Fasten off, leaving an 18-20" [45.5-51 cm] tail for seaming.

FINISHING

1st row: (RS). Ch 1. 1 hdc in each Fold Bootie in half. With beg tail, sew heel seam. With ending tail, sew sole seam then (continuing with ending tail), weave tail through ends of rows at toe and pull tightly to form toe and close opening.

Weave in ends
