

## MATERIALS

Aunt Lydia's ${ }^{\circledR}$ Classic Crochet Size 10 ( 400 yds; 365.76 m)

## Main Color (MC) Natural (0226) 1 ball

Aunt Lydia's ${ }^{\circledR}$ Metallic Crochet Size 10 ( $100 \mathrm{yds} ; 91.4$ m)
Contrast A White/Silver (0015) 1 ball
Note: 1 ball of MC will make 10-12 Pigs.
Susan Bates ${ }^{\circledR}$ Steelite ${ }^{\circledR}$ crochet hook U.S. 7-8 (1.5-1.6 mm) or size needed to obtain gauge. Beads or black floss for eyes. Small amount of poly fiberfill to stuff. Yarn needle.

Note: This toy contains small parts and is not suitable for children under 8 years of age.

## MEASUREMENTS

Approx $214^{\prime \prime} \times 13 / 4$ " $[5.5 \times 4.5 \mathrm{~cm}$ ]

## GAUGE

$38 \mathrm{sc} \times 40$ rows $=4$ " $[10 \mathrm{~cm}$ ]

## INSTRUCTIONS

## TIP from designer:

Use the trick quilters use to bury their knots when hand quilting. Make a knot close to the surface of the work and pull the knot into the interior and out the other side. Trim thread close to exit point.
$\mathbf{S c}=$ Single crochet
$\mathbf{S c 2 t o g}=$ Draw up a loop in each of next 2 sc . Yoh and draw through all 3 loops on hook
$\mathbf{S c b l}=$ Single crochet in back loop only
Sl st = Slip stitch
Sp(s) = Space(s)
St(s) = Stitch(es)

## Notes:

- Nose, head and body are worked in one piece.
- Join all rnds with sl st to first st.

Beg at Nose, with A, make Magic Loop.
1st rnd: 6 sc in magic loop. Join. 6 sc .
2nd rnd: Ch 1. 2 sc in each sc around. Join. 12 sc . Fasten off A.
3rd rnd: Join MC with sl st to back loop of any sc. Ch 1.1 scbl in same sp as sl st and each sc around. Join. 12 sc .
4th rnd: Ch 1. Working in both loops, 1 sc in each sc around. Join.

5th rnd: Ch 1. Working in front loops only, 1 sc in each of first 2 sc . ${ }^{*} 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next sc. 1 sc in each of next 2 sc . Rep from * to last sc. 2 sc in last sc. Join. 16 sc .
6th rnd: Ch 1.1 sc in each of first 3 sc . 2 sc in next sc. 1 sc in each of next 3 sc . Rep from * to last sc. 2 sc in last sc. Join. 20 sc .
7th rnd: Ch 1.1 sc in each of first 4 sc . ${ }^{*} 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next sc. 1 sc in each of next 4 sc . Rep from * to last sc. 2 sc in last sc. Join. 24 sc .
8th rnd: Ch 1.1 sc in each of first 3 sc . 2 sc in next sc. 1 sc in each of next 3 sc . Rep from * to last sc. 2 sc in last sc. Join. 30 sc .
9th to 19th rnds: Ch 1.1 sc in each sc around. Join. 30 sc.
20th rnd: Ch 1. Working in front loops only, 1 sc in each of first 3 sc . *Sc2tog. 1 sc in each of next 3 sc . Rep from * to last 2 sc. Sc2tog. Join. 24 sts.
Stuff Body.
21 st rnd: Ch 1.1 sc in each of first 2 sc. *Sc2tog. 1 sc in each of next 2 sc . Rep from * to last 2 sts. Sc2tog. Join. 18 sts.
22nd rnd: Ch 1.1 sc in first sc. *Sc2tog. 1 sc in next sc. Rep from * to last 2 sts. Sc2tog. Join. 12 sts. Finish stuffing.

23rd rnd: Ch 1. *Sc2tog. Rep from * around. Join. 6 sts. Fasten off, leaving an end 12-18" [30.545.5 cm ] long. Thread end through front loops of rem sts. Pull tightly. Fasten securely.

## TAIL

With MC, ch 9 .
1 st row: 1 sc in 2 nd ch from hook and each ch to end of chain. 8 sc . Fasten off.

## EARS (Make 2)

With MC, ch 5 .
1st row: 1 sc in 2 nd ch from hook and each ch to end of chain. Turn. 4 sc .
2nd row: Ch 1. Sc2tog. 1 sc in each of last 2 sc . Turn. 3 sts.
3rd row: Ch 1. Sc2tog. 1 sc in last sc. Turn. 2 sts.
4th row: Ch 2. Skip first sc. 1 hdc in next sc. Fasten off.

Sew Ears to head as shown in picture.

## LEGS (make 4)

Note: Ch 2 at beg of rnd does not count as st.

Beg at bottom, with A, make Magic Loop.
1st rnd: 8 sc in magic loop. Join. 8 sc . Fasten off A.
2nd rnd: Join MC with sl st to back loop of any sc. Ch 2. Working in back loops only, 1 hdc in same sp as sl st and each sc around. Join. 8 hdc. Fasten off, leaving an end 12-18" [ $30.5-45.5 \mathrm{~cm}$ ] long for sewing Legs to Body.
Stuff Legs.

## WINGS (make 2)

With $A, c h 6$, leaving a long end.
1st row: 1 sc in 2 nd ch from hook and each ch to end of chain. Turn. 5 sc .
2nd row: Ch 1.2 sc in first sc. Skip next sc. 5 dc in next sc. Skip next sc. 2 sc in last sc. Turn. 9 sts.
3rd row: Picot. Skip first sc. *Sl st in next sc. Picot. Skip next st. Rep from * to last sc. SI st in last sc. Fasten off.

## TIPS from designer:

- Remove the metallic wrap from the Tail to make threading the needle and sewing easier.


## FINISHING

Sew Tail as shown in picture.
Sew Legs as shown in picture.
Sew Wings to Back as shown in picture.
Sew on 2 black beads for eyes as shown in picture.
Optional: With black embroidery floss embroider eyes using French Knot.
