## MATERIALS

**Aunt Lydia's® Classic™ Crochet Thread size 10** (350 yds/320 m)

### MICRO BEAR

**Main Color MC** Wasabi (0397) **1 ball**

**Contrast A** Aqua (0450) **1 ball**

**Note:** 1 ball of MC will make 10-12 Micro Bears

**Aunt Lydia's® Classic™ Crochet Thread size 3** (150 yds/137 m)

### MINI BEAR

**Main Color MC** Silver (0435) **1 ball**

**Contrast A** Natural (0226) **1 ball**

**Contrast B** Atom Red (2160) **1 ball**

**Note:** 1 ball of MC will make 5-6 Mini Bears

Size U.S. C/2 (2.75 mm) Susan Bates® Silvalume® crochet hook **or size needed to obtain gauge.** Sewing thread and needle. Polyester fiberfill. Tiny Buttons for dress. Size 3 (6/0) beads for eyes

**Note: These toys contain small parts and are not suitable for children under 8 years of age.**

## MEASUREMENTS

**Micro Bear:** Approx 2½" x 1¾" x ¾" [ 6 x 4.5 x 2 cm]

**Mini Bear:** 3¼" x 2¼" [8.5 x 5.5 cm]

## GAUGES

36 sc and 40 rows = 4" [10 cm] with U.S. 7 (1.5 mm) crochet hook and Aunt Lydia's® Classic 10 Crochet Thread

26 sc and 28 rows = 4" [10 cm] with U.S. C/2 (2.75 mm) crochet hook and Aunt Lydia's® Classic 3 Crochet Thread

## INSTRUCTIONS

**Note:** The instructions are written for both Versions.

**Designer Tip:** Use the trick quilters use to bury their knots when hand quilting. Make a knot close to the surface of the work and pull the knot into the interior and out the other side. Trim thread close to the exit point.

**Note:** Join all rnds with sl st to first st.

## HEAD

Make Magic loop. Video [here](#).

**1st rnd:** Ch 1. 6 sc in magic loop. Join. PM for beg of rnd. 6 sc.

**2nd rnd:** Ch 1. 2 sc in each sc around. Join. 12 sc.

**3rd rnd:** Ch 1. 2 sc in same sp as sl st. \*1 sc in next sc. 2 sc in next sc. Rep from \* to last sc. 1 sc in last sc. Join. 18 sc.

**4th rnd:** Ch 1. 1 sc in same sp as sl st. 1 sc in next sc. \*2 sc in next sc. 1 sc in each of next 2 sc. Rep from \* to last sc. 2 sc in last sc. Join. 24 sc.

**5th to 7th rnds:** Ch 1. 1 sc in each sc around. Join.

**8th rnd:** Ch 1. 1 sc in same sp as sl st. 1 sc in next sc. \*Sc2tog. 1 sc in each of next 2 sc. Rep from \* to last 2 sc. Sc2tog. Join. 18 sts.

**9th rnd:** Ch 1. 1 sc in same sp as sl st. \*Sc2tog. 1 sc in next sc. Rep from \* to last 2 sc. Sc2tog. Join. 12 sts.

Stuff Head.

**10th rnd:** Ch 1. \*Sc2tog. Rep from \* around. Join. 6 sts. Fasten off, leaving a long end.

## LEGS (make 2)

Make Magic loop.

**1st rnd:** Ch 1. 4 sc in magic loop. Join. PM for beg of rnd. 4 sc.

**2nd rnd:** Ch 1. 2 sc in each sc around. Join. 8 sc.

**3rd to 5th rnds:** Ch 1. 1 sc in each sc around. Join. Fasten off at end of last rnd, leaving a long end of First Leg. **Do not** fasten off at end of Second Leg. Stuff legs.

## BODY

Cont working around legs as follows:

**1st rnd:** Ch 1. 1 sc in each of next 8 sc of Second Leg. 1 sc in each of next 8 sc of First Leg. Join. PM for beg of rnd. 16 sc.

**2nd rnd:** Ch 1. 1 sc in each sc around. Join.

**3rd rnd:** Ch 1. 1 sc in same sp as sl st. 1 sc in next sc. \*Sc2tog. 1 sc in each of next 2 sc. Rep from \* to last 2 sc. Sc2tog. Join. 12 sts.

**4th and 5th rnds:** Ch 1. 1 sc in each st around. Join.

**6th rnd:** Ch 1. 1 sc in same sp as sl st. 1 sc in next st. \*Sc2tog. 1 sc in each of next 2 sts. Rep from \* to last 2 sts. Sc2tog. Join. Fasten off, leaving a long end. 9 sts.

Stuff Body.

## ARMS (make 2)

Make Magic loop.

**1st rnd:** Ch 1. 4 sc in magic loop. Join. PM for beg of rnd. 4 sc.

**2nd rnd:** Ch 1. 1 sc in same sp as sl st. 2 sc in next sc. 1 sc in next sc. 2 sc in last sc. Join. 6 sc.

**3rd to 5th rnds:** Ch 1. 1 sc in each sc around. Join. Fasten off at end of last rnd, leaving a long end.

## EARS (make 2)

Make Magic loop.

**1st rnd:** Ch 1. 6 sc in magic loop. Join. Fasten off, leaving a long end. Using a needle with the tail from the center, pull through the SC at the edge opposite of fasten off tail.

## SNOUT

Make Magic loop.

**1st rnd:** Ch 1. 12 sc in magic loop. Join. Fasten off, leaving a long end. Sew snout to head using the picture as a guide, make a knot close to the surface and pull to the inside of the head. Embroider nose with black floss.

Sew on bead eyes and ears using the picture as a guide for placement.

## SCARF for Mini Bear

**Note:** To change color, work to last 2 loops on hook and draw new color through last 2 loops, then proceed in new color.

## Stripe pat

B – 2 rows. A – 2 rows.

These 4 rows form Stripe pat.

## Scarf

With B, ch 9.

**1st row:** (RS). 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook and each ch to end of chain. Turn. 8 sc.

**2nd row:** Ch 1. 1 sc in each sc to end of row. Turn.

First 2 rows of Stripe pat are complete.

Cont in Stripe pat, rep last row until work from beg measures approx 4" [10 cm], ending with 2 rows of B. Fasten off.
