



CROCHET | SKILL LEVEL: EASY

MATERIALS

MICRO MOUSE

Aunt Lydia's® Classic™ Crochet Thread size 10 (350 yds/320 m)

Main Color MC Silver (0435) **1 ball**

Contrast A Atom Red (2160) **1 ball**

Note: 1 ball of MC will make 10-12 Micro Mice

Size U.S. 7 (1.5 mm) Susan Bates® Steelite® crochet hook **or size needed to obtain gauge.** Sewing thread and needle. Polyester fiberfill. Tiny Buttons for dress and Vest. Seed Beads for eyes.

MINI MOUSE

Aunt Lydia's® Fashion™ Crochet Thread size 3 (150 yds/137 m)

Main Color MC Silver (0435) **1 ball**

Aunt Lydia's® Classic™ Crochet Thread size 10 (350 yds/320 m)

Contrast A Atom Red (2160) **1 ball**

Note: 1 ball of MC will make 5-6 Mini Mice

Size U.S. C/2 (2.75 mm) Susan Bates® Silvalume® crochet hook for Mini Mouse/Bunny. Size U.S. 7 (1.5 mm) Susan Bates® Steelite® crochet hook for Dress or Vest **or size needed to obtain gauge.** Sewing thread and needle. Polyester fiberfill. Tiny Buttons for Dress and Vest. Size 3 (6/0) beads for eyes.

Note: These toys contain small parts and are not suitable for children under 8 years of age.

MEASUREMENTS

Micro Mouse: Approx 1" x ¾" [2.5 x 2 cm]

Mini Mouse: Approx 2¼" x 1" [3 x 2.5 cm]

GAUGES

36 sc and 40 rows = 4" [10 cm] with U.S. 7 (1.5 mm) crochet hook and Aunt Lydia's® Classic 10 Crochet Thread

26 sc and 28 rows = 4" [10 cm] with U.S. C/2 (2.75 mm) crochet hook and Aunt Lydia's

INSTRUCTIONS

Note: The same instructions apply to both sizes of crochet thread.

Designer Tip: Do not fully tighten the Magic Loop until after working Rnd 2. It will make it easier to get your hook into the stitches.

HEAD

Notes: Head is worked from back to tip of Nose.

Join all rnds with sl st to first st.

Make Magic loop. Video [here](#).

1st rnd: Ch 1. 6 sc in Magic loop. Join. PM for beg of rnd. 6 sc.

2nd rnd: Ch 1. 2 sc in each sc around. Join. 12 sc.

3rd rnd: Ch 1. 1 scbl in each sc around. Join.

4th rnd: Ch 1. (1 sc in each of next 4 sc. Sc2tog) twice. Join. 10 sts.

5th rnd: Ch 1. 1 sc in each st around. Join.

6th rnd: Ch 1. (1 sc in each of next 3 sc. Sc2tog) twice. Join. 8 sts.

7th rnd: Ch 1. (1 sc in next sc. Sc2tog) twice. Join. 6 sts. Fasten off, leaving a long end.

Coil and stuff beg tail into head, add additional fiberfill if needed.

BODY

Make Magic loop, leaving long end of yarn.

1st rnd: Ch 1. 8 sc in Magic loop. Join. PM for beg of rnd. 8 sc.

2nd rnd: Ch 1. 2 sc in each sc around. Join. 16 sc.

3rd rnd: Ch 1. 1 scbl in each sc around. Join.

4th rnd: Ch 1. (1 sc in each of next 6 sc. Sc2tog) twice. Join. 14 sts.

5th rnd: Ch 1. 1 sc in each st around. Join.

6th rnd: Ch 1. (1 sc in each of next 6 sc. Sc2tog) twice. Join. 12 sts.

7th rnd: Ch 1. (1 sc in each of next 4 sc. Sc2tog) twice. Join. 10 sts.

Coil beg tail and stuff it into Body add fiberfill stuff the body more firmly than Head.

8th rnd: Ch 1. (1 sc in each of next 3 sc. Sc2tog) twice. Join. 8 sts.

9th rnd: Ch 1. 1 sc in each st around. Join. Fasten off, leaving a long end.

Add additional stuffing if needed. Sew Head to Body and wrap the yarn tail around neck several times to hide seam. Fasten securely.

TAIL

Using end of yarn at bottom center back, ch 12. Fasten off. Secure end.

ARMS (make 2)

Cut 24" [61 cm] piece of thread. Make knot in one end and using a needle pull the knot into the body and out of right side below neck wrapping.

Ch 6.

1st row: 1 hdc in 2nd ch from hook. 1 sc in each ch to end of chain. Fasten off.

Rep for Left Arm.

Legs

Cut 24" [61 cm] piece of thread. Make knot in one end and using a needle pull the knot into the body and out of the right side below right arm approx ½" [1.5 cm] above base of Body.

Ch 7.

1st row: 1 hdc in 2nd ch from hook. 1 sc in each of next 2 ch. 1 hdc in each of last 3 ch. Fasten off.

Rep for left leg.

Designer Tip: I found it helps to pin the legs in place and stiffen them with a mixture of ¼ water and ¾ white glue. I paint it on and let it dry overnight. I also painted the arms and the ears.

Ears (Make 2)

Make Magic loop, leaving long end of yarn.

1st row: (WS). 5 sc in Magic loop. Turn. 5 sc.

2nd row: Ch 1. 2 sc in each of 5 sc. Fasten off, leaving a 6" [15.2 cm] tail.

Using long tails, sew Ears to Head using the picture as a guide for placement.

With pink floss, embroider Nose using the picture as a guide. With sewing thread, sew on eyes.

Mini Dress

With A and U.S. 7 (1.5 mm) crochet hook, ch 32.

1st row: (RS). 1 dc in 3rd ch from hook. 1 dc in each ch to end of chain. Turn. 30 dc.

2nd row: Ch 1. 1 sc in each dc to end of row. Turn. 30 dc.

3rd row: (Dec row-waistband). 1 sc in each of first 2 dc. (Sc2tog) 6 times. 1 sc in each of next 2 dc. (Sc2tog) 6 times. 1 sc in each of last 2 dc. Turn. 18 sts.

4th row: 1 dc in each of first 5 sc. Ch 2. Skip next 2 sc. 1 dc in each of next 5 sc. Ch 2. Skip next 2 sc. 1 dc in each of next 4 sc. Turn.

5th row: Ch 1. 1 sc in each of first 2 dc. Sc2tog. 2 sc in next ch-2 sp. 1 sc in each of next 2 dc. Sc2tog. 1 sc in next dc. 2 sc in next ch-2 sp. 1 sc in next dc. Sc2tog. 1 sc in each of last 2 dc. Turn. 15 sts.

Button Loop: Ch 6. Sl st to top of dc of 4th row. Fasten off.

Sew a tiny button to correspond to button loop.

Micro Dress

With A and U.S. 7 (1.5 mm) crochet hook, ch 22.

1st row: (RS). 1 dc in 3rd ch from hook. 1 dc in each ch to end of chain. Turn. 20 dc.

2nd row: (Dec row-waistband). 1 sc in each of first 2 dc. (Sc2tog) 8 times. 1 sc in each of last 2 dc. Turn. 12 sts.

3rd row: Ch 3 (counts as dc). 1 dc in next st. Ch 2. Skip next 2 sts. 1 dc in each of next 4 sts. Ch 2. Skip next 2 sts. 1 dc in each of last 2 sts. Turn.

4th row: Ch 1. 1 sc in each of first 2 dc. 2 sc in next ch-2 sp. 1 sc in each of next 4 dc. 2 sc in next ch-2 sp. 1 sc in each of last 2 dc. Turn.

Button loop: Ch 6. Sl st to top of dc of 3rd row. Fasten off.

Sew a tiny button to correspond to button loop.

Vest

With A and U.S. 7 (1.5 mm) crochet hook, ch 18.

1st row: (RS). 1 dc in 3rd ch from hook. 1 dc in each ch to end of chain. Turn. 16 dc.

2nd row: Ch 3 (counts as dc). 1 dc in each of next 2 dc. Ch 2. Skip next 2 dc. 1 dc in each of next 6 dc. Ch 2. Skip next 2 dc. 1 dc in each of last 3 dc. Turn.

3rd row: Ch 3. 1 dc in first dc. 2 dc in each of next 2 dc. 1 dc in next ch-2 sp. 1 dc in next dc. (Dc2tog) twice. 1 dc in next dc. 1 dc in next ch-2 sp. 2 dc in each of last 3 dc. **Do not** turn.

Working down side of front edge, Ch 1. 3 sc down side of front edge. Ch 5 (button loop). Sl st to top of last sc. Fasten off.

Sew a tiny button to correspond to button loop.

Micro Scarf

With A and U.S. 7 (1.5 mm) crochet hook, work Foundation sc as follows:

Foundation Single Crochet (fsc):

First stitch: Ch 2 (does not count as sc), insert hook into 2nd ch from hook, Yoh and draw up a loop, Yoh and draw through 1 loop on hook (this forms a chain, optional note: placing a stitch marker can help see the chain in the next stitch), Yoh and draw through 2 loops on hook (this forms single crochet). ***Next stitch:** Insert hook into bottom of previous stitch (in the "chain" space), Yoh and pull up a loop, Yoh and draw through 1 loop on hook (forming a chain), Yoh and draw through 2 loops on hook (forming next single crochet). Rep from * until work from beg measures 3" [7.5 cm]. Fasten off.
