

MATERIALS
Aunt Lydia's ${ }^{\circledR}$ Classic ${ }^{\text {Tm }}$ Crochet Thread Size 10 (White: $400 \mathrm{yds} / 366 \mathrm{~m}$; Colors: 350 yds/320 m)

Hot Pink (0332)
1 ball or 25 yds/22 m
Size U.S. B/1 ( 2.25 mm ) Susan Bates ${ }^{\circledR}$ crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge. Susan Bates ${ }^{\circledR}$ Steel yarn needle. Button $1 / 4$ " $[6 \mathrm{~mm}]$.

To fit doll chest measurement: 5" [12.5 cm ]

## GAUGE

26 sc and 28 rows $=4$ " $[10 \mathrm{~cm}$ ]

## INSTRUCTIONS

## Notes:

- Cardigan is worked top down.
- Ch 2 at beg of rows does not count as st.

Ch 23 loosely. See Diagram on page 2.
1st row: (RS). 1 hdc in 7th ch from hook (counts as button loop). 1 hdc in each ch to end of chain. Turn.

2nd row: Ch 2.1 dc in first hdc 3 dc in next hdc. *[Ch 1. Skip next hdc. (3 dc. Ch 2.3 dc ) in next hdc] twice.* (Ch 1. Skip next hdc. 3 dc in next hdc) twice. Rep from * to * once more. Ch 1. Skip next hdc. 3 dc in next hdc. 1 dc in last hdc Turn.
3rd row: Ch 2.3 dc in first dc. [Ch 1.3 dc in next ch-1 sp. Ch 1. ( 3 dc . Ch 2.3 dc ) in next ch-2 sp] twice. (Ch 1.3 dc in next ch-1 sp) 3 times. [Ch 1. (3 dc. Ch 2.3 dc ) in next ch-2 sp. Ch 1.3 dc in next ch-1 sp] twice. Ch 1 . Skip next 3 dc .3 dc in last dc. Turn.

## Yarnspirations <br> spark your inspiration!

4th row: Ch 2.1 dc in first dc. Skip next 2 dc . [(3 dc in next ch-1 sp. Ch 1) twice. ( 3 dc . Ch 2.3 dc ) in next ch-2 sp] twice. (Ch 1.3 dc in next ch-1 sp) 4 times. [Ch 1 . (3 dc. Ch 2.3 dc ) in next ch-2 sp. (Ch 1. 3 dc in next ch-1 sp) twice] twice. Skip next 2 dc . 1 dc in last dc. Turn.

## Shape armholes and Body:

 1st row: (RS). Ch 2.3 dc in first dc (Ch 1.3 dc in next ch-1 sp) twice. Ch 1. (3 dc. Ch 2.3 dc ) in next ch-2 sp. PM to ch-2 sp just made. (Ch 1. 3 dc in next ch-1 sp) 3 times. Ch 1. ( 3 dc . Ch 1 . Sl st to marked ch-2 sp. Ch 1.3 dc ) in next ch-2 sp. (Ch 1. 3 dc in next ch-1 sp) 5 times. Ch 1. ( 3 dc . Ch 2.3 dc ) in next ch-2 sp. PM to ch-2 sp just made. (Ch 1.3 dc in next ch-1 sp) 3 times. Ch 1 . (3 dc. Ch 1. SI st to last marked ch-2 sp. Ch 1.3 dc ) in next ch-2 sp. (Ch 1. 3 dc in next ch-1 sp) twice. Ch 1. Skip next 2 dc . 3 dc in last dc. Turn.Body: 2nd row: Ch 2.1 dc in first dc. Skip next 2 dc. [(3 dc in next ch-1 sp. Ch 1) 3 times. 3 dc in next sl st. Skip next 3 dc . (Ch 1.3 dc in next ch-1 sp) 6 times. Ch 1.3 dc in next sl st. Skip next 3 dc. (Ch 1.3 dc in next ch-1 sp) 3 times. Skip next 2 dc .1 dc in last dc. Turn.
3rd row: Ch 2.3 dc in first dc. * 3 dc in next ch-1 sp. Rep from * to last dc. 3 dc in last dc.
4th rnd: Ch 1. Working from left to right, instead of from right to left, as usual, work 1 reverse sc in each dc across bottom of Cardigan. Join with sl st to first sc. Fasten off.

Sew button to correspond to buttonhole.
