### What you will need:

AUNT LYDIA'S® Baker's Cotton: 1 ball 900 Red or 700 Pink

Susan Bates® Crochet Hook: 3.5mm [US E-4]

2" (5 cm) foam ball for Small jar cover, 2½" (6.5 cm) foam ball for Large jar cover, two 6" (15 cm) felt squares in white or color to match yarn, white glue, straight pins, yarn needle, ½" (12.7 mm) or ½" (15.9 mm) button (optional)

GAUGE: 21 sc = 4" (10 cm); 26 rows sc = 4" (10 cm). CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size needles/hook to obtain the gauge given.

# Pin-Cushion Jar Topper

Here's the perfect way to store buttons or sewing supplies with a handy pincushion on top. Crochet this jar topper to give with sewing needs or make it for yourself to keep pins, needles and thread handy and ready for a quick sew!

Pin Cushion fits lid of Small 16-oz pint Mason jar or Large 32-oz wide-mouth quart Mason jar.

Directions are for size Small unless otherwise noted.

#### **Special Abbreviations**

hdc2tog = [Yarn over, insert hook in next stitch, yarn over and pull up loop] twice, yarn over and draw through all loops on hook.

#### **PIN CUSHION**

#### **Cushion Top**

Ch 4, join with a slip st to form a ring. **Round 1 (Right side):** Ch 1, 6 sc in ring; slip st in first sc to join—6 sc.

**Round 2:** Ch 1, [2 sc in next sc] 6 times; slip st in first sc to join—12 sc.

**Round 3:** Ch 1, [2 sc in next sc, sc in next sc] 6 times; slip st in first sc to join—18 sc.

**Round 4:** Ch 1, [2 sc in next sc, sc in each of next 2 sc] 6 times; slip st in first sc to join—24 sc.

**Round 5:** Ch 1, [2 sc in next sc, sc in each of next 3 sc] 6 times; slip st in first sc to join—30 sc

**Round 6:** Ch 1, [2 sc in next sc, sc in each of next 4 sc] 6 times; slip st in first sc to join—36 sc.

Round 7: Ch 1, [2 sc in next sc, sc in each of next 5 sc] 6 times; slip st in first sc to join—42 sc. Do not fasten off.

Round 8 (Large size only): Ch 1, [2 sc in next sc, sc in each of next 6 sc] 6 times; slip st in first sc to join—48 sc. Do not fasten off.

#### **Cushion Side for size Small**

Continue working into last Round of Top. **Rounds 9-11:** Ch 1, sc in each sc around; slip st in first sc to join—42 sc.

Round 12: Ch 1, 2 sc in first sc, sc in each of next 5 sc, [2 sc in next sc, sc in each of next 3 sc] 9 times; slip st in first sc to join—52 sc. Fasten off and weave in ends.

#### **Cushion Side for size Large**

Continue working into last Round of Top. **Rounds 9-12:** Ch 1, sc in each sc around; slip st in first sc to join—48 sc

Round 13: Ch 2 (counts as a hdc), hdc in same st as joining, hdc in each of next 3 sc, [2 hdc in next sc, hdc in each of next 3 sc] 11 times; slip st in top of beginning ch-2 to join—60 hdc. Fasten off and weave in ends.

## **Lid Side Band** (Instructions for size Large are in parentheses)

Ch 60 (72); being careful not to twist, join with a slip st to form a ring.

Round 1: Ch 2 (counts as a hdc), hdc in each ch around; slip st in top of beginning ch-2 to join—60 (72) hdc.

Round 2: Ch 3 (counts as hdc and ch-1), [skip next hdc, hdc in next hdc, ch 1] around until 1 hdc remains, skip last hdc; slip st in 2nd ch of beginning ch-3 to join—30 (36) hdc and 30 (36) ch-1 spaces.

Round 3: Ch 2, hdc in each hdc and ch-1 space around; slip st in top of beginning ch-2 to join—60 (72) hdc. Fasten off and weave in ends.

#### Flower

Ch 4, join with a slip st to form a ring.

Round 1 (Right side): Ch 2 (counts as a hdc),

11 hdc in ring; slip st in top of beginning ch-2 to join—12 hdc.

Continued...



Round 2: Ch 2, dc in same st as joining, (tr, dc) in next hdc, ch 2, [(slip st, ch 2, dc) in next hdc, (tr, dc) in next hdc, ch 2] 5 times; join with slip st in base of beginning ch-2—6 petals. Fasten off and weave in ends.

#### **Assembly**

- 1. Carefully cut the foam ball in half.
- 2. Slightly stretch a felt square to cover the top of the ball (you may need to cut a few slits in order to keep it smooth). Fold the felt under the ball about ½". Glue the ends of the felt down, but do not glue the felt on the round part of the ball, as it will make it difficult to pin into. Do not use hot glue, as this can melt the foam. Place a few pins in the ball to hold everything together while it dries. Let it dry upside down so it does not stick to your surface.
- Cut a piece of felt to cover the bottom cut edge of the ball and glue it on. Place a few pins in the ball to hold everything together while it dries. Let it dry upside down so it does not stick to your surface.
- 4. Sew a Flower and button on top of the Pin Cushion (optional).
- Place the felt-covered foam ball half inside the Pin Cushion cover, then glue the bottom of the ball to the top of the Mason jar lid. When the glue is dry, slip the outer piece of the jar lid into place.
- 6. Cut 5 strands of yarn each 20" (51 cm) long. Thread the strands through Round 2 of the Lid Side Band, referring to photo for placement. Place the Lid Side Band around the outer piece of the jar lid and tie the strands of yarn together, then clip the ends. Slide the tied strings around until the knot is inside the Band, or sew a Flower and button over the knot.

#### **ABBREVIATIONS**

ch = chain; cm = centimeters; dc = double crochet; hdc = half double crochet; mm = millimeters; sc = single crochet; st(s) = stitch(es); tr = treble crochet; [] = work directions in brackets the number of times specified; \* or \*\* = repeat whatever follows the \* or \*\* as indicated.
