What you will need:
AUNT LYDIA'S ${ }^{\circledR}$ Extra Fine Crochet Thread, Size 30: 1 ball 226 Natural (for smaller sun catcher)

AUNT LYDIA'S ${ }^{\text { }}$ Fine Crochet Thread, Size 20: 1 ball 226 Natural (for larger sun catcher)

GAUGE: Rounds 1-4 of smaller sun catcher $=11 / 2{ }^{\prime \prime}[4 \mathrm{~cm}]$; Rounds 1-4 of larger sun catcher $=15 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ [ 4 cm ]. CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size hook to obtain the gauge given

## Suncatcher Mini-Doilies

Here's a fun way to enjoy little crochet doilies-hang them in a window so they can catch the sun's rays and you can view their pretty patterning! These mini-size doilies are crocheted with finer threads and displayed
in 3 " and 5 " metal rings.

## What you will need:

Susan Bates ${ }^{\circledR}$ Steel Crochet Hooks: 1 mm [US 12] (for smaller sun catcher) and 1.25 mm [US 9] (for larger sun catcher)

- $3^{\prime \prime}$ [7.5 cm] metal ring for smaller sun catcher
- 5" [12.5 cm] metal ring for larger sun catcher
- Thread needle

Directions are for smaller sun catcher. Changes for larger sun catcher are in parentheses.
Finished Circumference 3½ (5½)" [9 (14) cm]

## Note

Beginning ch-2 counts as first dc throughout pattern unless otherwise indicated.

## Special Stitches

ch-3 picot = Ch 3, slip st in top of last stitch made.
dtr (double treble crochet) = Yarn over 3 times, insert hook in indicated stitch or space, yarn over and pull up a loop (5 loops on hook), [yarn over and draw through 2 loops on hook] 4 times. dtr2tog (double treble crochet 2 together) $=$ Holding the last loop of each stitch on the hook, 2 dtr in indicated stitch or space, yarn over, draw through all 3 loops on hook. beg 4-dtr cl (beginning 4-double treble crochet cluster) $=$ Ch 4, holding the last loop of each stitch on the hook, 3 dtr in indicated stitch or space, yarn over, draw through all 4 loops on hook. 4-dtr cl (4-double treble crochet cluster) $=$ Holding the last loop of each stitch on the hook, 4 dtr in indicated stitch or space, yarn over, draw through all 5 loops on hook.
2-dtr joining = Holding the last loop of each stitch on the hook, [dtr in indicated space or stitch] 2 times, yarn over, draw through all 3 loops on hook.
(Stitches are skipped between legs of joining.)
beg 4-tr cl (beginning 4-treble crochet cluster) $=$ Ch 3 , holding the last loop of each stitch on the hook, 3 tr in indicated stitch or space, yarn over, draw through all 4 loops on hook.

## 4-tr cl (4-treble crochet cluster) =

Holding the last loop of each stitch on the hook, 4 tr in indicated stitch or space, yarn over, draw through all 5 loops on hook
Triple picot $=$ Ch 4, slip st in first ch; ch 5, slip st in first ch of same ch-5; ch 4, slip st in first ch of same ch-4; slip st in top of last (dc) st made.
Join with slip st = Insert hook in indicated stitch, place a slipknot on hook and draw the slipknot through stitch.


## SMALLER SUN CATCHER

With size 30 thread and smaller hook, ch 5 , slip st in first ch to form ring.
Round 1: Ch 1, 8 sc in ring, slip st in first sc to join.
Round 2: Ch 5, (counts as first dc and ch-3 space), *dc in next sc, ch 3; repeat from * around, slip st in 2 nd ch of beginning ch-5 to join-8 dc and $8 \mathrm{ch}-3$ spaces.
Round 3: Ch 1, sc in same st, *2 sc in next ch-3 space, ch-3 picot, sc in same space,** sc in next dc; repeat from * 6 times, then from * to ${ }^{* *}$ once, slip st in first sc to join-32 sc and 8 ch-3 picot.
continued.

Round 4: Beg 4-dtr cl, ch 7, *4 dtr cl in sc above next dc on Round 2, ch 7; repeat from * around, slip st in top of beg cl to join-8 cl and $8 \mathrm{ch}-7$ spaces.
Round 5: Ch 1, sc in same st, *ch 5, tr in next ch-7 space, ch $5,{ }^{* *}$ sc in top of next cl; repeat from * 6 times, then from * to
${ }^{* *}$ once, slip st in first sc to join-8 tr, 8 sc , and 16 ch- 5 spaces.
Round 6: Ch 1, sc in same st, *2 sc in next ch-5 space, ch-3 picot, 4 sc in same space, ch-3 picot, sc in same space, sc in next tr, 2 sc in next ch-5 space, ch-3 picot, 4 sc in same space, ch-3 picot, sc in same space,** sc in next sc; repeat from * 6 times, then from * to ** once, slip st in first sc to join-128 sc and 32 ch-3 picot.
Round 7: Slip st up to and in 2nd sc between first and 2nd picots, ch 11 (counts as part of first dtr join and $1 \mathrm{ch}-7$ space), *skip next picot, 4-tr cl in 2nd sc between picots, ch 7,** work dtr joining above sc on Round 5 by inserting hook in 2 nd sc after 1st picot and 2nd sc after 3rd picot, ch 7; repeat from * 6 times, then from * to ${ }^{* *}$ once; dtr in 2 nd sc between picots, slip st in 4th ch of beginning ch-11 to join (completing first dtr join) -8 dtr join and $16 \mathrm{ch}-7$ spaces.
Round 8: Holding metal ring behind work, ch 1, working in same st, *sc between legs of dtr joining and over ring, work 17 sc in ch-7 space and over ring, $s c$ in top of next cl and over ring, work 17 sc in ch-7 space and over ring; repeat from * around; slip st in first sc to join.
Round 9: Ch 2, 2 dc in same sc, [skip 2 sc, sc in next sc, skip 2 sc, 5 dc in next sc] 2 times, skip 2 sc, sc in next sc, skip $2 \mathrm{sc}, 3 \mathrm{dc}$ in next sc above cl, ch 5 , slip st in first ch to form ring, 10 sc in ring, slip st in top of last dc made, 2 dc in
same sc above cl, *skip 2 sc, sc in next sc, skip 2 sc,** 5 dc in next sc; repeat from * around to last $5 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{dc}$ in first sc; slip st in first dc to join.
Fasten off and weave in ends. Block to open up lace sts.


## LARGER SUN CATCHER

With size 20 thread and larger hook, ch 5 , slip st in first ch to form ring.
Round 1: Ch 2, 23 dc in ring, slip st in top of ch-2 to join.
Round 2: Ch 1, sc in same dc, ch 3, *skip 1 dc , sc in next dc, ch 3; repeat from * around, slip st in first sc to join-12 dc and 12 ch- 3 spaces.
Round 3: Slip st in first ch-3 space, beg 4-tr cl, ch 4, *4-tr cl in next ch-3 space, ch 4; repeat from * around, slip st in top of first cl to join-12 cl and $12 \mathrm{ch}-4$ spaces.
Round 4: (Slip st, ch 1, 5 sc) in first ch-4 space, *5 sc in next ch-4 space; repeat from * around, slip st in first sc to join60 sc.

Round 5: Slip st in 2nd sc of Round 4 (slip st, ch 1, sc) in next sc, *ch 5, skip next $4 \mathrm{sc},{ }^{* *}$ sc in next sc; repeat from * 10 times, then from * to ** once, slip st in first sc to join-12 sc and 12 ch-5 spaces. Round 6: Ch 1, sc in same sc, *ch 3, dc in next ch-5 space, triple picot, slip st around base of picot, ch $3,{ }^{* *}$ sc in next sc; repeat from * 10 times, then from * to * once, slip st in first sc to join-12 dc, 12 sc, 12 triple picot and 24 ch-3 spaces. Fasten off and weave in ends.
Round 7: Attach thread in center picot of any triple picot on Round 6; ch 1, sc in same st, ch 9, *sc in next center picot, ch 9; repeat from * around, slip st in first sc to join-12 sc and 12 ch-9 spaces.
Round 8: Slip st up to and in 3rd ch of first ch-9 space, ch 4, (counts as first dc and ch-2), *(dc, ch 3, dc, ch 2, dc) in same space,** dc in next ch-9 space, ch 2; repeat from * 10 times, then from * to ** once, slip st in top of first ch-2 to join. Round 9: (Slip st, ch 1, 3 sc) in first ch-2 space, *ch 5, dtr2tog in next ch-5 space, ch 5,3 sc in next ch-2 space, skip 2 dc ,** 3 sc in next ch-2 space; repeat from * 10 times, then from * to ** once, slip st in first sc to join.
Round 10: (Slip st, ch 1, sc) in next sc *ch 3, (sc, ch 3, sc) in next ch-5 space, ch 3 , (sc, ch 4, sc) in top of dtr2tog, ch 3, (sc, ch 3, sc) in next ch-5 space, ch 3 , skip next sc, sc in next sc, skip next 2 sc,** sc in next sc; repeat from 10 times, then from * to ** once, slip st in first sc to join. Fasten off and weave in ends. Round 11: Join thread with a slip st in any ch-4 loop on Round 10, ch 1; holding metal ring behind work, sc in same ch-4 loop and over ring, work 26 sc over ring, sc in next ch-4 loop and over ring, work 26 sc over ring; repeat from * around, slip st in first sc to join.

Round 12: Ch 1, (sc, ch 5, sc) in same sc, *ch 3, skip 2 sc,** sc in next sc; repeat from * around to last 2 sc , then from * to ** once, slip st in first sc to join.
Round 13: (Slip st, ch 1, 9 sc) in ch-5 space, *(sc, ch 2, sc) in next ch-3 space; repeat from * around to last ch-3 space, sc, ch 2, slip st in first sc to join.
Fasten off and weave in ends. Block to open up lace sts.
