## What you will need:

AUNT LYDIA'S ${ }^{\circledR}$ Fine Crochet Thread, Size 20: 1 ball 201 White

Susan Bates ${ }^{\star}$ Steel Crochet Hook: 1.40 mm [US 8]

FINISHED SIZE: 3.5" (8 cm), not including hanger. CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size hook to obtain the finished size.
aunt lydia's* Fine Crochet Thread, Size 20 100\% Mercerized Cotton, Art 181 available in white and natural 400 yd balls


## Beautiful Lacy Snowflake Ornaments

Crocheted snowflakes are a wonderful way to add beauty to your tree. This pretty design will look just as nice crocheted in size 3,10 or 20 weight crochet thread!

## What you will need (continued):

AUNT LYDIA'S ${ }^{\circledR}$ Classic Crochet Thread, Size 10: 1 ball 001 White

Susan Bates ${ }^{\text {® }}$ Steel Crochet Hook: 1.50 mm [US 7]

FINISHED SIZE: 5.25" (14 cm), not including hanger. CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size hook to obtain the finished size.

AUNT LYDIA'S ${ }^{\circledR}$ Classic Crochet Thread, Size 10, 100\% Mercerized Cotton, Art. 154 available in white, ecru \& natural 400 yd; solid color 350 yd; shaded color 300 yd balls

AUNT LYDIA'S ${ }^{8}$ Fashion Crochet Size 3: 1 ball 201 White

Susan Bates ${ }^{\text {® }}$ Steel Crochet Hook: 1.50 mm [US 7]

FINISHED SIZE: 3.75" ( 9.5 cm ), not including hanger. CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size hook to obtain the finished size.

AUNT LYDIA'S ${ }^{\circledR}$ Fashion Crochet Size 3, 100\% Mercerized Cotton, Art. 182 available in solid color 150 yd, shaded color 100 yd balls


## Note

If using Epsom* salts, use a mixture of equal amounts of water and Epsom ${ }^{\circ}$ salts. Bring water to boil, add equal amount of Epsom* salts and stir until dissolved, let cool.

## Special Stitches

3-tr cluster = *Yarn over 2 times, insert hook in indicated stitch or space, yarn over, draw up a loop, [yarn over, draw through 2 loops] 2 times; repeat from * 2 times, yarn over, draw through all 4 loops on hook.
Triple picot $=$ Ch 4, slip st into the front loop at the top of the last stitch made and the front strand of the actual stitch of the same stitch, ch 5 , slip st into the same st again catching the front loop of the first ch-4 loop where you slip stitched into the top of the stitch, ch 4, slip st into the same st again catching the front loop of the first ch-4 loop and ch-5 loop where you slip stitched into the top of the stitch.
Ch-3 picot $=$ Ch 3, slip st in top of indicated st.

Tapestry needle, fabric stiffener or Epsom salts

Decorative ornament hanger (optional)

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## SNOWFLAKE \#3 (All sizes)

With selected thread and hook, ch 5, slip st in first ch to form ring.
Round 1 (Right Side): Ch 1 (does not count as a stitch now and throughout), 12 sc in ring, slip st in first sc of round-12 sc.
Round 2: Ch 3, (counts as first dc and ch-1 space), *dc in next sc, ch 1; repeat from * around, slip st in 2nd ch of beginning ch-3-12 dc, $12 \mathrm{ch}-1$ spaces. Round 3: Slip st in first ch-1 space, ch 2, (counts as first dc), (dc, ch 3, 2 dc) in same ch-1 space, ch 3, *skip next ch-1 space, (2 dc, ch 3, 2 dc ) in next ch-1 space, ch 3; repeat from * around, slip st in top of beginning ch-2-24 dc, $12 \mathrm{ch}-3$ loops.
Round 4: Slip st in next dc and first ch-3 space, ch 3 , (counts as first tr), (tr, ch 3 , 2 tr ) in same ch-3 space, ch 3, sc in next ch-3 space, ch 3, *( 2 tr , ch $3,2 \mathrm{tr}$ ) in next ch-3 space, ch 3 , sc in next ch-3 space, ch 3; repeat from * around, slip st in top of beginning ch-3-24 tr, $18 \mathrm{ch}-3$ spaces Round 5: Ch 1, *sc in 2 tr, slip st in next ch-3 space, ch 5 , slip st in 4 th ch from hook (picot made), 3-tr cluster in same ch-3 space (see Special Stitches)**; Triple picot (see Special Stitches) in top of cluster just made, slip st around base of Triple picot; ch 5, slip st in 4th ch from hook, ch 1, slip st in same ch-3 space, sc in next 2 tr , [ (2 sc, Ch-3 picot in last sc made (see Special Stitches), sc) in next ch-3 space] 2 times; repeat from * 4 times then from * to ** once; turn, ch 7, slip st in 7th ch from hook to form ring; (turn, ch 1, 11 sc ) in ring just made, slip st around base of ring; ch 5, slip st in 4 th ch from hook, ch 1 , slip st in same ch-3 space, sc in next 2 tr, [ (2 sc, Ch-3 picot in last sc made, sc) in next
ch-3 space] 2 times; slip st in first sc of round. Fasten off and weave in ends. Block and stiffen with stiffener of choice (see Note).
