What you will need:

AUNT LYDIA'S® Classic Crochet Thread, Size 10: 1 ball each 431 Pumpkin A, 1 ball 001 White B, 1 ball 012 Black C

Susan Bates® Steel Crochet Hook: 1.5mm [US 7]

Stitch markers, tapestry needle, Artificial pumpkins: 6½" (16.5 cm) white, 9" (23 cm) black, 13" (33 cm) orange

WARNING: This product is FLAMMABLE. Keep away from heat or flame, use LED candles only. For indoor decorative use only.

GAUGE: 32 tr = 4" [10 cm]; 8 rounds tr = 4" [10 cm]. CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.

Haunting Lace Pumpkins

Create elegant, spellbinding covers for faux pumpkins from your craft store. The nice thing is, your hours of work can be enjoyed this year and for many years to come.

Fits decorative pumpkins sizes 6½" (16.5 cm), 9" (23 cm), and 13" (33 cm) tall.

Special Stitches

dtr = Yarn over 3 times, insert hook in indicated stitch or space and draw up a loop, [yarn over and draw through 2 loops] 4 times.
2-tr-cluster = [Yarn over twice, insert hook in indicated stitch or space and draw up a loop, (yarn over and pull through 2 loops on hook) twice] twice, yarn over hook and pull through all 3 loops on hook.

Shell = (2 dc, ch 3, 2 dc) in same stitch or space.

Beginning Shell = [Ch 3 (count as dc), dc, ch 3, 2 dc] in the same stitch or space.

COVER FOR 6½" PUMPKIN

With A, ch 40; being careful not to twist, slip st in top of beginning ch to join into a ring.

Round 1 (Right side): Work Beginning Shell in first ch, [ch 3, skip next 4 chs, work Shell in next ch] 7 times, ch 3, skip next 4 chs; slip st in top of ch-3 to join—8 Shells and 8 additional ch-3 spaces.

Round 2: Slip st in the next dc and ch-3 space, work Beginning Shell in same ch-3 space, * ch 3, skip next 2 dc and next ch, work Shell in next ch, ch 3**, skip next ch and 2 dc, work Shell in next ch-3 space; repeat from * around, ending last repeat at **; slip st in top of ch-3 to join—16 Shells and 16 additional ch-3 spaces.

Round 3: Slip st in the next dc and ch-3 space, work Beginning Shell in same ch-3 space, * ch 3; skip next 2 dc, 3 chs and 2 dc**; work Shell in next ch-3 space; repeat from * around, ending last repeat at **; slip st in top of ch-3 to join—16 Shells and 16 additional ch-3 spaces.

Rounds 4-11: Slip st in the next dc and ch-3 space, work Beginning Shell in same ch-3 space, * ch 5; skip next 2 dc, 3 chs and 2 dc**; work Shell in next ch-3 space; repeat from * around, ending last repeat at ***; slip st in top of ch-3 to join—16 Shells and 16 ch-5 spaces.

Rounds 12-13: Slip st in the next dc and ch-3 space, work Beginning Shell in same ch-3 space, * ch 3; skip next 2 dc, 5 chs and 2 dc**; work Shell in next ch-3 space; repeat from * around, ending last repeat at **; slip st in top of ch-3 to join—16 Shells and 16 additional ch-3 spaces.

Round 14: Slip st in the next dc and ch-3 space, ch 1, sc in same space, * ch 5; skip next 2 dc, 3 chs, and 2 dc**; sc in next ch-3 space; repeat from * around, ending last repeat at **; slip st in first sc to join—16 sc and 16 ch-5 spaces. Place the Pumpkin inside the crocheted piece.

Round 15: Slip st in the next 3 chs, ch 1, sc in same ch, * ch 3, skip next sc, sc in the next ch-5-space; repeat from * around, ch 3, slip st in first sc to join—16 sc and 16 ch-3 spaces. Fasten off: weave in ends.

COVER FOR 9" PUMPKIN

With **B**, ch 40; being careful not to twist, slip st in top of beginning ch to join into a ring. **Round 1 (Right side):** Ch 1, work 45 sc in ring; slip st in first sc to join—45 sc.

Round 2: [Ch 15, skip next 2 sc, sc in next sc] 14 times, ch 7, skip last 2 sc, dtr in first ch to join—15 loops.

Round 3: Ch 1, sc in same st, [ch 7, sc in next ch-15-space] 14 times, ch 7, slip st first sc to join—15 ch-7 loops.

Round 4: Ch 1, sc in same st, [ch 8, sc in next sc] 14 times, ch 8, slip st in first sc to join—15 ch-8 loops.

Round 5: Ch 13, [tr into next sc, ch 9] 14 times, slip st in 4th ch of beginning ch-13 to join—15 ch-9 loops.

Round 6: Ch 1, sc in same st, [ch 10, sc in next tr] 14 times, ch 10, slip st in first sc to join—15 ch-10 loops.

Round 7: Ch 15, [tr into next sc, ch 11] 14 times, slip st in 4th ch of beginning ch-15 to join—15 ch-11 loops.

Round 8: Ch 1, sc in same st, [ch 12, sc in next tr] 14 times, ch 12, slip st in first sc to join—15 ch-12 loops.

Round 9: Ch 16, [tr into next sc, ch 12] 14 times, slip st in 4th ch of beginning ch-16 to join—15 ch-12 loops.

Round 10: Ch 1, sc in same st, [ch 13, sc in next tr] 14 times, ch 13, slip st in first sc to join—15 ch-13 loops.

Rounds 11-22: Repeat Rounds 9-10. Place the Pumpkin inside the crocheted piece.

Round 23: Ch 10, *insert hook underneath the next space created by both ch-13 loops from Rounds 21 and 22, ch 6**, tr in next sc, ch 6; repeat from * around, ending last repeat at **, slip st in 4th ch of beginning ch-10 to join—15 ch-6 loops.

Round 24: Ch 1, sc in same st, [ch 8, sc in next tr] 14 times, ch 8, slip st in first sc to join—15 ch-8 loops.

Round 25: Ch 1, sc in same st, [ch 6, sc in next sc] 14 times, ch 6, slip st in first sc to join—15 ch-6 loops. Fasten off; weave in ends.

COVER FOR 13" PUMPKIN

With C, ch 40; being careful not to twist, slip st in top of beginning ch to join into a ring. **Round 1 (Right side):** Ch 4, 2 tr in same st, [ch 5, skip next 4 chs, 3 tr in next ch] 7 times, ch 5, skip next 4 chs; slip st in top of ch-4 to join—8 3-tr groups and 8 ch-5 spaces.

Round 2: Ch 4, tr in each of next 2 tr, *ch 9, skip next 5 chs**, tr in each of the next 3 tr; repeat from * around, ending last repeat at **; slip st in top of ch-4 to join—8 3-tr groups and 8 ch-9 spaces.

Round 3: Ch 4, tr in same st, *tr in next tr, 2 tr in next tr, ch 11, skip next 9 chs**, 2 tr in next tr; repeat from * around, ending last repeat at **; slip st in top of ch-4 to join—8 5-tr groups and 8 ch-11 spaces.

Round 4: Ch 4, tr in same st,* tr in each of next 3 tr, 2 tr in next tr, ch 13, skip next 11 chs**, 2 tr in next tr; repeat from * around, ending last repeat at **; slip st in top of ch-4 to join—8 7-tr groups and 8 ch-13 spaces.

Round 5: Ch 4, tr in same st, * tr in each of next 5 tr, 2 tr in next tr, ch 15, skip next 13 chs**, 2 tr in next tr; repeat from * around, ending last repeat at **; slip st in top of ch-4 to join—8 9-tr groups and 8 ch-15 spaces.

Rounds 6-7: Ch 4, tr in each of next 8 tr, * ch 15, skip next 15 chs**, tr in each of next 9 tr; repeat from * around, ending last repeat at **; slip st in top of ch-4 to join—8 9-tr groups and 8 ch-15 spaces.

Round 8: Ch 4, tr in same st, * tr in each of next 7 tr, 2 tr in next tr, ch 17, skip next 15 chs**, 2 tr in next tr; repeat from * around, ending last repeat at **; slip st in top of ch-4 to join—8 11-tr groups and 8 ch-17 spaces.

Rounds 9- 23: Ch 4, tr in each of next 10 tr, * ch 17, skip next 17 chs**, tr in each of next 11 tr; repeat from * around, ending last repeat at **; slip st in top of ch-4 to join—8 11-tr groups and 8 ch-17 spaces. Place the Pumpkin inside the cover.

Round 24: Ch 4, *2-tr-cluster in next 2 tr, tr in each of next 5 tr, 2-tr-cluster in next 2 tr, tr in next tr, ch 15, skip next 17 chs**, tr in next tr; repeat from * around, ending last repeat at **; slip st in top of ch-4 to join—8 9-tr groups and 8 ch-15 spaces.

Round 25: Ch 4, *2-tr-cluster in next 2 tr, tr in each of next 3 tr, 2-tr-cluster in next 2 tr, tr in next tr, ch 13, skip next 15 chs**, tr in next tr; repeat from * around, ending last repeat at **; slip st in top of ch-4 to join—8 7-tr groups and 8 ch-13 spaces.

Round 26: Ch 9, skip 5 trs, *tr in last tr of the group, ch 5, tr in the center of next ch-13-space, ch 5**, tr in the first tr of the next group, ch 5; repeat from * around, ending last repeat at **; slip st in 4th ch of beginning ch-9 to join—24 ch-5 spaces.

Round 27: *Ch 7; skip next ch-5 space, tr, and ch-5 space**; slip st in next tr; repeat from * around, ending last repeat at **; slip st in first ch to join—12 ch-7 spaces. Fasten off; weave in ends.

A, B, C = Color A, Color B, Color C etc; ch = chain; dc = double crochet; mm = millimeters; sc = single crochet; st(s) = stitch(es); tr = treble (triple) crochet; [] = work directions in brackets the number of times specified; * or ** = repeat whatever follows the * or ** as indicated.
