## What you will need:

AUNT LYDIA’®® Classic Crochet Thread, Size 10: 1 ball 001 White

Susan Bates ${ }^{\circledR}$ Steel Crochet Hook: 1.5 mm [US 7]

Tapestry needle; 5 " ( 12.7 cm ) high glass vase, item \#88632, The Anchor Hocking $\mathrm{Co}^{\text {TM }}, 11 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ $(3.8 \mathrm{~cm})$ ribbon

GAUGE: Rounds $1-7=41 / 2 "$ across CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.

AUNT LYDIA'S ${ }^{\circledR}$ Classic Crochet Thread, Size 10, Art. 154 available in white \& ecru 400 yd ( 365 m ); solid color 350 yd ( 320 m ); shaded color $300 \mathrm{yd}(274 \mathrm{~m})$ balls


## Doily-ed Vase

Use a very traditional doily in a very nontraditional way! Wrap a simple glass vase with the doily to create a unique accent for your home.

## Doily measures 16" (40.6 cm) in diameter.

## Special Abbreviations

v -st $=(\mathrm{tr}, \mathrm{ch} 3, \mathrm{tr})$ all in st or ch specified. end round = join with a slip st to 4th ch of beginning ch-7.
start round = slip st in next ch, slip st in chspace, ch 7, tr in same space
cl group (cluster group) $=(5 \mathrm{tr}, \mathrm{ch} 3, \mathrm{dtr}, \mathrm{ch} 3$, 5 tr all in specified st.
v-st over v-st = v-st in ch-3 space of v-st. cl (cluster) = * [yo] twice, draw up a loop in next tr, [yo and draw through 2 loops] twice; repeat from * 4 more times; yo and draw through all 6 loops on hook.
picot $=$ ch 6, slip st in 5th ch from hook.

## DOILY

Ch 8; join with a slip st in first ch to form a ring. Round 1: Ch 3, 23 dc in ring; join with a slip st to top of ch-3-24 sts.

Round 2: Ch 1, sc in joining, [ch 5, skip next 2 dc, sc in next dc] 7 times; ch 2, dc in first sc to join and form last loop.

Round 3: Ch 1, sc over dc, [ch 7, sc in next ch-5 loop] 7 times; ch 3, tr in first sc to join and form last loop.

Round 4: Ch 3 , 2 dc in joining tr, [ch 3, 5 dc in 4th ch of next ch-7 loop] 7 times; ch 3, 2 dc in joining tr; join with a slip st to top of ch-3.

Round 5: Ch 1, sc in joining, * ch 5, sc in ch-3 space **, ch 5 , skip next 2 dc , sc in next dc; repeat from * around, end at **; ch 2, dc in first sc to join and form last loop.

Round 6: Ch 1, sc over dc, [ch 7, sc in next ch-5 loop] 15 times; ch 3, tr in first sc to join and form last loop.

Round 7: Ch 7, tr in joining tr, * ch 5, tr in 4th ch of next ch-7 loop, ch 5 **, v-st in 4th ch of next ch-7 loop; repeat from * around, end at **; end round.

Round 8: Start round, * ch 4, skip next tr, cl group in next tr, ch $4{ }^{* *}$, v-st over v-st; repeat from * around, end at **; end round.

Rounds 9 and 10: Start round, * ch 4, cl, ch 3, cl group in dtr, ch 3, cl, ch $4{ }^{* *}$, v-st over v-st; repeat from * around, end at **; end round.

Round 11: Start round, * ch 5, cl, ch 3, cl group in dtr, ch $3, \mathrm{cl}$, ch $5^{* *}$, v-st over v-st; repeat from * around, end at **; end round.

Round 12: Start round, * (ch 3, tr) all in same ch-space, ch 5 , cl, ch 3, cl group in dtr, ch 3 , cl, ch 5 **, v-st over v-st; repeat from * around, end at **; end round.

Round 13: Start round, * ch 3, v-st in next ch-3 space, ch 5 , cl, ch 3 , ( 5 tr , ch 2 , tr, ch $2,5 \mathrm{tr}$ ) all in dtr, ch 3, cl, ch 5 **, v-st in next ch-3 space; repeat from * around, end at **; end round.

Round 14: Start round, * (ch 3, v-st] twice) all in next ch-3 space, ch 3, v-st over v-st, ch 6, cl, ch $3,5 \mathrm{tr}$ in tr , ch 3 , cl, ch $6{ }^{* *}$, v-st over v-st; repeat from * around, end at **; end round.

Round 15: Start round, * [ch 3, v-st over v-st] 3 times, ch 7, sc in next tr, ch 4, work cl over 5 tr including same tr as sc was made, ch 4 , sc in same tr as last leg of cl, ch 7 **, v-st over v-st; repeat from * around, end at **; end round.

Round 16: Start round, * [v-st in next ch-3 space] 6 times, ch 7 , sc in top of cl, ch 7 **, v-st over v-st; repeat from * around, end at **; end round.

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Round 17: Slip st in next ch, slip st in chspace, ch 11, slip st in 5th ch from hook, ch 2, dtr in same ch-space, * [dtr in next ch-3 space, picot, ch 2, dtr in same ch-space] 6 times, ch 6 , sc in sc, ch $6{ }^{* *}$, (dtr, picot, ch 2, dtr) all in next ch-3 space; repeat from * around, end at ${ }^{* *}$; slip st in 5th ch of ch-11. Fasten off. Weave in ends.

## FINISHING

With the ribbon, run in and out of every other stitch of the Doily until you have made it all the way around. Lay the doily flat and place the vase in the center. Evenly wrap the Doily around the vase and tie ribbon in a bow to hold it in place.
