Towel 1: Soft Mauve (1040)
1 ball
Towel 2: Silver (0435)
1 ball
Towel 3: Aqua (0450)
1 ball
Size U.S. 7 ( 1.5 mm ) Susan Bates ${ }^{\circledR}$ Steelite ${ }^{\circledR}$ crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge. Yarn needle. Sewing Needle and Dual Duty XP ${ }^{\circledR}$ thread in colors to match: 550 Dark Silver, 5845 Seafoam and 1040 Soft Mauve. Purchased guest towels.

## MEASUREMENT

Approx 3.5" [9 cm] wide

## GAUGE

Hook size 7/1.5 mm hook 36 SC x 40 rows $=4$ " $[10 \mathrm{~cm}$ ]

## INSTRUCTIONS

See Diagram on page 3,
Start at one narrow edge.

## Ch 27.

1st row: (RS). 1 dc in 4th ch from hook (3 skipped ch count as dc). 1 dc in each of next 2 ch . (Ch 2. Skip next 2 ch .1 dc in next ch) 6 times. 1 dc in next 2 ch . ( 1 dc . Ch 2.1 tr) in last ch. Turn. 1 tr. 13 dc . and $7 \mathrm{ch}-2 \mathrm{sps}$.

2nd row: Ch 6 (counts as tr, ch 2 here and throughout). 3 dc in first ch-2 sp. 1 dc in next dc. Ch 2. Skip next 2 dc .1 dc in next dc. 2 dc in next ch-2 sp. 1 dc in next dc. (Ch 2. Skip next ch-2 sp. 1 dc in next dc) 5 times. Ch 2 . Skip next 2 dc .1 dc in top of beg ch-3. Turn. $1 \mathrm{tr}, 14 \mathrm{dc}$ and $8 \mathrm{ch}-2 \mathrm{sps}$.
3rd row: Ch 3 (counts as dc here and throughout). 2 dc in first ch-2 sp. 1 dc in next dc. (Ch 2. Skip next ch-2 sp. 1 dc in next dc) 4 times. 2 dc in next ch-2 sp. 1 dc in next dc. Ch 3 . Skip next 3 dc 1 tr in next ch-2 sp. Ch 3. Skip next 3 dc .1 dc in next dc. ( 3 dc . Ch 2.1 tr) in last ch-6 sp. Turn. 2 tr. 15 dc. 5 ch- 2 sps and $2 \mathrm{ch}-3 \mathrm{sps}$.

4th row: Ch 6.3 dc in first ch-2 sp. 1 dc in next dc. Ch 3.1 sc in next ch- 3 sp .1 sc in next tr. 1 sc in next ch-3 sp. Ch 3 . Skip next 3 dc. 1 dc in next dc. 2 dc in next ch-2 sp. 1 dc in next dc. (Ch 2. Skip next ch-2 sp. 1 dc in next dc) 3 times. Ch 2. Skip next 2 dc .1 dc in top of beg ch-3. Turn. 1 tr. 12 dc. 3 sc. 5 ch- 2 sps, and $2 \mathrm{ch}-3 \mathrm{sps}$.
5th row: Ch 3.2 dc in first ch-2 sp. 1 dc in next dc. (Ch 2. Skip next ch-2 sp. 1 dc in next dc) twice. 2 dc in next ch-2 sp. 1 dc in next dc. Ch 4. Skip next 3 dc. 1 sc in next ch-3 sp. 1 sc in next 3 sc .1 sc in next ch-3 sp. Ch 4 . Skip next 3 dc .1 dc in next dc. (3 dc. Ch 2.1 tr ) in last ch-6 sp. Turn. 1 tr. 13 dc. 5 sc. 3 ch- 2 sps and $2 \mathrm{ch}-4 \mathrm{sps}$.
6th row: Ch 3. Skip first ch-2 sp. 1 dc in each of next 4 dc . Ch 5. Skip next ch-4 sp. 1 sc in each of next 5 sc. Ch 5 . Skip next ch-4 sp. 1 dc in each of next 4 dc . (Ch 2. Skip next ch-2 sp. 1 dc in next dc) twice. Ch 2. Skip next 2 dc .1 dc in top of beg ch-3. Turn. 12 dc. 5 sc. $3 \mathrm{ch}-2 \mathrm{sps}$ and 2 ch-5 sps.

7th row: Ch 3.2 dc in first ch-2 sp. (Ch 2. Skip next ch-2 sp. 1 dc in next dc) twice. Ch 2 . Skip next 2 dc .1 dc in next dc. 3 dc in next ch-5 sp. Ch 4. Skip next sc. 1 sc in next 3 sc . Ch 4. Skip next sc. 3 dc in next ch-5 sp. 1 dc in next dc. Skip next 2 dc .1 tr in top of beg ch-3. Turn. 1 tr .14 dc . $3 \mathrm{sc} .3 \mathrm{ch}-2$ sps and $2 \mathrm{ch}-4 \mathrm{sps}$.
8th row: Ch 3 . Skip first 4 sts. 1 dc in next dc. 3 dc in next ch-4 sp. Ch 3. Skip next sc. 1 tr in next sc. Ch 3. Skip next sc. 3 dc in next ch-4 sp. 1 dc in next dc. Ch 2 . Skip next 2 dc . 1 dc in next dc. (Ch 2. Skip next ch-2 sp. 1 dc in next dc) 3 times. Ch 2. Skip next 2 dc .1 dc in top of beg ch-3. Turn. 1 tr. $14 \mathrm{dc} .5 \mathrm{ch}-2$ sps and $2 \mathrm{ch}-3 \mathrm{sps}$.
9th row: Ch 3.2 dc in first ch-2 sp. 1 dc in next dc. (Ch 2. Skip next ch-2 sp. 1 dc in next dc) 4 times. Ch 2. Skip next 2 dc .1 dc in next dc. 3 dc in next ch-3 sp. Ch 2 . Skip next tr. 3 dc in next ch-3 sp. 1 dc in next dc. Skip next 2 dc .1 tr in top of beg ch-3. Turn. 1 tr. 16 dc and 6 ch- 2 sps.

10th row: Ch 3 . Skip first 4 sts. 1 dc in next dc. 2 dc in next ch-2 sp. 1 dc in next dc. Ch 2. Skip next 2 dc .1 dc in next dc. (Ch 2. Skip next ch-2 sp. 1 dc in next dc) 5 times. Ch 2. Skip next 2 dc .1 dc in top of beg ch-3. Turn. 12 dc and $7 \mathrm{ch}-2 \mathrm{sps}$.
11th row: Ch 3.2 dc in first ch-2 sp. 1 dc in next dc. (Ch 2. Skip next ch-2 sp .1 dc in next dc) 6 times. 1 dc in next 2 dc . ( 1 dc . Ch 2.1 tr ) in last dc. Turn. Leave rem ch-3 unworked. Turn. 1 tr. 13 dc and $7 \mathrm{ch}-2 \mathrm{sps}$.
Rep Rows 2nd to 11th rows until piece measures desired length to fit across short end of guest towel, ending on a 10th row. Fasten off.

## FINISHING

Trim
With RS facing, join thread at beg of shaped edge. Ch 1. * 3 sc in each of next 5 sps. Ch 2.3 sc in each of next 5 sps. Rep from * across. SI st in end of shaped edge. Fasten off.
Weave in ends.
Hand sew lace to towel.
