

## Sweet Clover Table Runner

Add a note of softness to a table top or dresser with this beautifully lacy runner. This classic crocheted piece will be loved and passed down for generations.

Runner measures $14^{\prime \prime} \times 32^{\prime \prime}$ including edging.
Aunt Lydia's ${ }^{\circledR}$ Classic Crochet size 10: 2 Balls 001
White or 805 Blue Hawaii.
Steel Crochet Hook: 1.5mm [US 7].
GAUGE: Motif = $3^{\prime \prime} \times 3^{\prime \prime}$ square. CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size hook to obtain the gauge given.

NOTE: After the First Motif, all others are joined while working Round 2.

FIRST MOTIF: Ch 20.
Row 1: Dc in 8th ch from hook, [ch 2, skip next 2 ch, dc in next ch] 4 times; turn - 5 spaces.
Rows 2-4: Ch 5, skip first dc, [dc in next dc, ch 2, skip 2 ch] 4 times, dc in 3rd ch of ch-5; turn.
Row 5: Ch 5, skip first dc, [dc in next dc, ch 2, skip 2 ch] 3 times, dc in next dc, ch 1, skip next 2 ch, tr in 3rd ch of ch-5 to form last space.

## Now work in rounds as follows:

Round 1: Ch 1, 6 sc over tr, * sc in next st, 2 sc in next space, sc in next st, sc in next space; [ch 5, sc in 5th ch from hook - picot made] 5 times; sc in sc made in space, sc in same space, sc in next st, 2 sc in next space, sc in next st **, 7 sc in next corner space; repeat from * around, end at **; sc in next space; join with a slip st to first sc.
Round 2: Slip st in next 4 sc, * ch 7, skip next picot, sc in next picot, ch 11 for corner, skip next picot, sc in next picot, ch 7, skip next picot, skip next 6 sc **, slip st in next 5 sc; repeat from * around, end at **; join with a slip st to first slip st. Fasten off. Weave in ends.

SECOND MOTIF: Work same as for First Motif until Round 1 has been completed. When working the joining, insert the hook from the wrong side into the appropriate loop on finished motif. Motifs are joined with slip sts in 4 corresponding loops along each side. Where corners meet, join corner loops by working the slip st into the slip st of a previous joining.
Round 2-Joining Round: Slip st in next 4 sc, ch 7, skip next picot, sc in next picot, ch 5, slip st in any ch-11 loop on First Motif, ch 5, skip next picot on 2nd Motif, sc in next picot, ch 3, slip st in next ch-7 loop on First Motif, ch 3, skip next picot and next 6 sc on 2nd Motif, slip st in next 5 sc, ch 3, slip st in next ch-7 loop on First Motif, ch 3, skip next picot on 2nd Motif, sc in next picot, ch 5, slip st in next ch-11 loop on First Motif, ch 5, skip next picot on 2nd Motif, sc in next picot, ch 7, skip next picot and next 6 sc on 2nd Motif, slip st in next 5 sc; complete same as for First Motif begin at *.

Join 4 strips of 10 squares, joining on 2 sides where required after the first strip.

EDGING-Round 1: With right side facing, join thread in corner loop; ch 1, sc in corner loop, * ch 5, sc in next loop, ch 5, skip next 2 slip sts, dc in next slip st, [ch 5, sc in next loop] twice **, ch 2, dc in joining, ch 2, sc in next loop; repeat from * to next corner loop, end at **; work 4 more sc in corner loop; repeat from * around; join with a slip st to first sc.

## SWEET CLOVER TABLE RUNNER | CROCHET

Round 2: Ch 1, sc in same sc as joining, * [5 sc in next ch-5 loop, sc in next st] 4 times ${ }^{* *}, 2$ sc in next ch-2 loop, sc in next dc, 2 sc in next ch-2 loop, sc in next sc; repeat from * to corner, end at **; sc in next sc, 3 sc in next sc ***, sc in next 2 sc ; repeat from * around, end at ***; sc in last sc; join to first sc.
Round 3: Slip st in next 2 sc, ch 3, dc in next 2 sc, * ch 5, skip next 3 sc **, dc in next 3 sc; repeat from * to corner, end at **; dc in next sc, 3 dc in next sc, dc in next sc; repeat from * around; ch 2, tr in top of ch-3 to join and form last loop.
Round 4: Ch 1, sc over tr, * skip next dc, 3 tr in next dc, skip next dc, sc in next ch-5 loop; repeat from * to corner; skip next dc, [3 tr in next dc] 3 times, skip next dc **, sc in next ch-5 loop; repeat from * around, end at **; join to first sc.
Round 5: Ch 1, sc in same sc as joining, * ch 1, skip next tr; (2 dc, ch 3, slip st in top of last dc, dc) all in next tr group made; ch 1, skip next tr, sc in next sc; repeat from * to corner; ch 1, skip next tr, [group in next tr, skip next tr] 4 times, ch $1^{* *}$, sc in next sc; repeat from * around, end at **; join to first sc. Fasten off. Weave in ends.

AUNT LYDIA’S ${ }^{\circledR}$ Classic Crochet Thread, Size 10, Art. 154 available in white \& ecru 400 yd; solid color 250 yd; shaded color 300 yd balls.

ABBREVIATIONS: $\mathbf{c h}=$ chain; $\mathbf{d c}=$ double crochet; $\mathbf{m m}$ = millimeters; sc = single crochet; st(s) = stitch (es); tr = treble crochet; * or ** $=$ repeat whatever follows the * or ** as indicated; [] = work directions in brackets the number of times specified.
