What you will need:

Aunt Lydia's® Baker's Cotton™: 1 ball Red 900

Headband, one Button, 5/8" (15.88 mm) diameter, Hot glue gun

AUNT LYDIA'S® Baker's Cotton™, Art 159 available 100% cotton, 150 yd (147 m) balls




Pompom Headband

Adding a pompom with a button is a sweet crafty addition to a child's headband. Make one in every color for a fun wardrobe of headbands!


Pompom Trim

- 1. Using a piece of stiff cardboard that is about 1½" (3.8 cm) wide, wrap twine around it. The more you wrap the fuller your pompom will be.
- 2. Cut a separate piece of twine, thread onto yarn needle. Using doubled twine, slip it under the wraps; tie as tightly as you can.
- 3. Cut the loops on side of cardboard without tie; shake the pompom.





4. Trim the ends so that they are even and ball shaped.



- Sew button to center of pompom leaving ends of twine on top; tie securely and trim ends.
- 6. Glue pompom to headband with hot glue.
