

## Crafty Spider

This spider is a fun Halloween decoration. It's a quick project and an easy one for kids.

Finished Measurements: 4 " high X 14" wide.
Aunt Lydia's Classic Crochet 10: 1 ball 12 Black.

## Materials

4" Styrofoam ${ }^{\text {TM }}$ ball, 8 black chenille stems, nine $1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ yellow pom poms, two 15 mm yellow/black shank eyes, white glue, knitting needle, elastic cord or nylon thread.

## SPIDER

Wind thread around ball covering it completely. Glue as you go as needed to keep threads in place.

For Eyes, push point of knitting needle between threads into ball for approximately 1 "; repeat $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " away. Put glue on shanks of eyes and push into holes.

Make four more holes on each side for legs; glue and insert chenille stems for legs. Bend legs to form "knees". Bend again $1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ from ends to form feet. Glue a pom pom to each foot and one for the nose.

Slip elastic cord or thread under threads at top to hang and tie securely.
