2" Hoop Earrings	Large Eye Needle
Charcoal Gray Felt	Scissors
White Craft Glue	

✂️ MACRAME | SKILL LEVEL: **EASY**

Featuring Aunt Lydia's® Classic Crochet Thread

These cute little bats are hanging from hoops! Aunt Lydia's Classic 10 Crochet thread ties neatly into macramé knots for attaching to hoop earrings and the ends can be cut to shape without fraying.

MEASUREMENTS

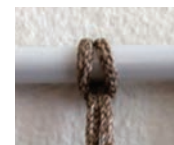
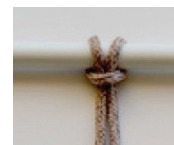
Approximately 4"

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Cut 50 strands of Black thread, 5 inches long.



2. Tie strands to the earring hoop, using a Larks Head Knot.



3. Keep knotting strands to the earrings until the bottom of the hoops are filled with thread strands. Cut more strands of thread if needed.



4. Place the earrings on a piece of paper and cut through the thread and the paper at the same time, to keep the thread still and straight while cutting.

5. Cut thread into scallop shapes to look similar to batwings.



6. Cut two simple bat body shapes (see photo) out of the felt.



7. Sew French knots (shown right) into the felt with White Thread, to create eyes.



8. Glue the felt bat body shapes onto the earrings with white craft glue.



9. Allow to dry completely.
