



## MATERIALS

### Aunt Lydia's® Crochet Thread Classic™ 10: Myrtle Green, Wasabi

Votive Candles (*battery operated*)  
Cardstock  
Tape  
Waxed Paper  
White Craft Glue  
18 ga. Florist Wire

Hot Glue Gun/Glue Sticks  
Long Bladed Knife  
Wire Cutters  
Spray Bottle  
Scissors  
Water

## Featuring Aunt Lydia's® Crochet Thread Classic™ 10

### MEASUREMENTS

8-10 inches tall

### ASSEMBLY

1. Roll cardstock into cones from 8-inches to 10-inches tall, with the base equal to the diameter of the votive candle. Tape to hold in place.



2. Roll waxed paper around the cone and tape to hold in place.
3. Wind thread around the waxed paper covered cone, gluing in place if necessary. Continue until the cone is thoroughly cover with thread.



4. Pour white craft glue into a spray bottle with equal parts of water and glue to make fabric stiffener. Shake until the glue is completely dissolved into the water. Place the thread-covered cone on a waxed paper surface, and spray the entire cone with stiffener. Let dry completely, overnight if necessary.



5. When the cone is completely dry, use the blade of a knife to run around the inside of the cone between the thread and the waxed paper to release.



7. Insert the votive candle and wire into the base of the cone, to assure the cone stands erect. Apply hot glue around the edge of the votive and inside the cone to hold in place.



6. Cut florist wire 1-inch longer than the height of the cone. Bend one end of the wire into a 1-inch loop.



8. Repeat the process to create several Christmas Tree Votives to display in a cluster for a simple and pretty centerpiece.
