## **MATERIALS**

**Aunt Lydia's® Classic Crochet Thread Size 10** (350 yds/320m)

Contrast A Atom Red (2160)1 ballContrast B Golden Yellow (422)1 ballContrast C Navy (486)1 ball

Size U.S. 7 (1.5 mm) steel crochet hook Susan Bates® Steelite® **or size needed to obtain gauge.** 3 cotton dish towels in blue plaids or stripes. Sewing needle. Coats & Clark All Purpose thread in matching colors. Yarn needle.





# CROCHET I SKILL LEVEL: INTERMEDIATE

#### ABBREVIATIONS

**Approx** = Approximately

**Beg** = Beginning

Ch = Chain(s)

**Dc** = Double crochet

**Dtr** = (Double treble crochet). (Yoh) 3 times. Insert hook in next stitch and pull up a loop. (Yoh and draw up a loop through 2 loops on hook) 4 times **Rep** = Repeat

**Rem** = Remaining

**RS** = Right side

**Sc** = Single crochet

**SI st** = Slip stitch

Sp(s) = Space(s)

**St(s)** = Stitch(es)

**WS** = Wrong side

#### **MEASUREMENTS**

Red Edging: Approx 2" [5 cm]

wide.

Yellow Insertion: Approx 21/8"

[7.5 cm] wide.

Navy Edging: Approx 2<sup>3</sup>/<sub>8</sub>" [6 cm]

wide.

### **GAUGE**

**Red Edging** = 2" [5 cm] wide **Yellow Insertion** = 27/8" [7.5 cm] wide

Navy Edging = 2%" [6 cm] wide.

# **INSTRUCTIONS**







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## **Red Edging**

Starting at one narrow edge with A. Ch 14.

**1st row:** (RS). 1 dc in 6th ch from hook. (Ch 1. Skip next ch. 1 dc in next ch) 4 times. Turn. 5 dc. 4 ch-1 sps. beg ch-5 sp.

2nd row: Ch 4 (counts as dc and ch 1). Skip first ch-1 sp. 1 dc in next dc. (Ch 1. Skip next ch-1 sp. 1 dc in next dc) 3 times. Turn. Leave rem ch-5 sp unworked. 5 dc and 4 ch-1 sps.

3rd row: Ch 5. 1 dc in first dc. (Ch 1. 1 dc in next dc) 3 times. Ch 1. Skip next ch. 1 dc in next ch. 5 dc. 4 ch-1 sps and beg ch-5 sp.

Rep 2nd and 3rd rows until piece measures desired length, ending on a 3rd row.

**Do not** fasten off.

### Top edge:

**Do not** turn, working along long side edge, ch 1. 3 sc in first sp. \*Ch 3. 1 dc in last sc made. Skip next sp. 3 sc in next sp. Rep from \* across. Fasten off.

Lower Trim

1st row: (RS). With WS facing, attach thread in first ch-5 sp on opposite long edge. Ch 1. 1 sc in same ch-5 sp. \*Ch 2. (2 dc. Ch 3. 2 dc) all in next sp. Ch 2. 1 sc in next ch-5 sp. Rep from \* across. Turn.

2nd row: Ch 1. \*1 sc in next ch-2 sp. Skip next dc. 1 dc in next dc. Ch 3. 2 dc in next ch-3 sp. (Ch 3. 2 dc in same ch-3 sp) twice. Ch 3. 1 dc in next dc. 1 sc in next ch-2 sp. Rep from \* across. SI st to last sc. Fasten off.

### **FINISHING**

Weave in ends.

Pin Edging to measurements. Cover with a damp cloth leaving cloth to dry.

Hand sew edging to edge of Towel.



#### **Yellow Insertion**

with B, ch 32.

**1st row:** (RS). 1 dc in 8th ch from hook (7 skipped ch count as 2 base ch, 1 dc. Ch 2). 1 dc in each of next 6 ch. (Ch 2. Skip next 2 ch. 1 dc in next ch) 3 times. 1 dc in each of next 6 ch. Ch 2. Skip next 2 ch. 1 dc in next ch. 18 dc and 5 ch-2 sps. Turn.

2nd row: Ch 5 (counts as dc and ch 2 here and throughout). Skip first ch-2 sp. 1 dc in each of next 7 dc. (Ch 2. Skip next ch-2 sp. 1 dc in next dc) 3 times. 1 dc in each of next 6 dc. Ch 2. Skip next 2 ch. 1 dc in next ch. Turn.

3rd row: Ch 5. Skip first ch-2 sp. 1 dc in each of next 4 dc. Ch 2. Skip next 2 dc. 1 dc in next dc. (2 dc in next ch-2 sp. 1 dc in next dc) 3 times. Ch 2. Skip next 2 dc. 1 dc in each of next 4 dc. Ch 2. Skip next 2 ch. 1 dc in next ch. 20 dc and 4 ch-2 sps. Turn.

4th and 5th rows: Ch 5. Skip first ch-2 sp. 1 dc in each of next 4 dc. Ch 2. Skip next ch-2 sp. 1 dc in each of next 10 dc. Ch 2. Skip next ch-2 sp. 1 dc in each of next 4 dc. Ch 2. Skip next 2 ch. 1 dc in next ch. Turn.

**6th row:** Ch 5. Skip first ch-2 sp. 1 dc Starting at one narrow edge in each of next 4 dc. 2 dc in next ch-2 sp. 1 dc in next dc. (Ch 2. Skip next 2 dc. 1 dc in next dc) 3 times. 2 dc in next ch-2 sp. 1 dc in each of next 4 dc. Ch 2. Skip next 2 ch. 1 dc in next ch. Turn. 18 dc and 5 ch-2 sps.

> Rep 2nd to 6th rows until piece measures desired length, ending on a 5th row. Fasten off.

#### **FINISHING**

Weave in ends.

Pin Edging to measurements. Cover with a damp cloth leaving cloth to drv.

Hand sew insertion to Towel.



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# **Navy Edging**

Starting at one narrow edge with C, ch 26.

1st row: (RS). 1 dc in 8th ch from hook (7 skipped ch count as 2 base ch. 1 dc. Ch 2). 1 dc in each of next 9 ch. Ch 2. Skip next 2 ch. 1 dc in each of next 4 ch. Ch 2. Skip next 2 ch. 1 dc in next ch. 16 dc and 3 ch-2 sps. Turn.

2nd row: Ch 5 (counts as dc. Ch 2 here and throughout). Skip first ch-2 sp. 1 dc in each of next 4 dc. Ch 2. Skip next ch-2 sp. 1 dc in each of next 10 dc. Ch 2. Skip next 2 ch. (1 dc. Ch 2. 1 dtr) in next ch. Turn. 1 dtr. 16 dc. and 4 ch-2 sps.

**3rd row:** Ch 7 (counts as dtr and ch 2 here and throughout). 1 dc in first dtr. (2 dc in next ch-2 sp. 1 dc in next dc) twice. (Ch 2. Skip next 2 dc. 1 dc in next dc) 3 times. 2 dc in next ch-2 sp. 1 dc in each of next 4 dc. Ch 2. Skip next 2 ch. 1 dc in next ch. Turn. 1 dtr. 17 dc and 5 ch-2 sps.

4th row: Ch 5. Skip first ch-2 sp. 1 dc in each of next 7 dc. (Ch 2. Skip next ch-2 sp. 1 dc in next dc) 3 times. 1 dc in each of next 6 dc. Ch 2. Skip next 2 ch. 1 dc in next ch. Turn.

**5th row:** SI st in next 2 ch. SI st in next dc. Ch 5 (counts as dc. Ch 2). Skip next 2 dc. 1 dc in next dc. Ch 2. Skip next 2 dc. 1 dc in next dc. (2 dc in next ch-2 sp. 1 dc in next dc) 3 times. Ch 2. Skip next 2 dc. 1 dc in each of next 4 dc. Ch 2. Skip next 2 ch. 1 dc in next ch. Turn. 17 dc and 4 ch-2 sps.

6th row: Ch 5. Skip first ch-2 sp. 1 dc in each of next 4 dc. Ch 2. Skip next ch-2 sp. 1 dc in each of next 10 dc. Ch 2. Skip next ch-2 sp. 1 dc in next dc. Turn. Leave rem sp unworked. 16 dc and 3 ch-2 sps.

7th row: Ch 7. 1 dc in first dc. Ch 2. Skip next ch-2 sp. 1 dc in each of next 10 dc. Ch 2. Skip next ch-2 sp. 1 dc in each of next 4 dc. Ch 2. Skip next 2 ch. 1 dc in next ch. Turn.1 dtr. 16 dc and 4 ch-2 sps.

8th row: Ch 5. Skip first ch-2 sp. 1 dc in each of next 4 dc. 2 dc in next ch-2 sp. 1 dc in next dc. (Ch 2. Skip next 2 dc. 1 dc in next dc) 3 times. 2 dc in next ch-2 sp. 1 dc in next dc. 2 dc in beg ch-sp. (1 dc. Ch 2. 1 dtr) in 5th ch of beg ch-7. Turn. 1 dtr. 17 dc and 5 ch-2 sps.

9th row: Ch 5. Skip first ch-2 sp. 1 dc in next 7 dc. (Ch 2. Skip next ch-2 sp. 1 dc in next dc) 3 times. 1 dc in each of next 6 dc. Ch 2. Skip next 2 ch. 1 dc in next ch. Turn. 18 dc and 5 ch-2 sps.

10th row: Ch 5. Skip first ch-2 sp. 1 dc in each of next 4 dc. Ch 2. Skip next 2 dc. 1 dc in next dc. (2 dc in next ch-2 sp. 1 dc in next dc) 3 times. (Ch 2. Skip next 2 dc. 1 dc in next dc) twice. Turn. Leave rem sp unworked. 17 dc and 4 ch-2 sps. Turn.

11th row: SI st in next 2 ch. SI st in next dc. Ch 5 (counts as dc and ch 2). Skip next ch-2 sp. 1 dc in each of next 10 dc. Ch 2. Skip next ch-2 sp. 1 dc in each of next 4 dc. Ch 2. Skip next 2 ch. 1 dc in next ch. Turn. 16 dc and 3 ch-2 sps. Rep 2nd to 11th rows until piece

Rep 2nd to 11th rows until piece measures desired length, ending on a 6th row.

**Trim: Do not** turn, working along scalloped edge. Ch 1. 2 sc in first sp. \* 5 sc in each of next 4 sps. 2 sc in next sp. Rep from \* across. Fasten off.

#### **FINISHING**

Weave in ends.

Pin Edging to measurements. Cover with a damp cloth leaving cloth to dry.

Hand sew edging to edge of Towel.





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
