Aunt Lydia's ${ }^{\circledR}$ Classic Crochet Thread Size 10 (350 yds/320m)
Contrast A Natural (0226) 1 ball
Contrast B Taupe Clair (8550) 1 ball
Contrast C Soft Mauve (1040) 1 ball
Size U.S. $5(1.7 \mathrm{~mm})$ steel crochet hook. Size U.S. B/1 $(2.25 \mathrm{~mm})$ crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge. Sewing needle and matching thread or transparent thread. Yarn needle.

 crochet cluster) $=$ [Yoh] 3 times, insert hook in indicated stitch, Yoh and pull up loop, [Yoh and draw through 2 loops on hook] 3 times (2 loops remain on hook); [Yoh] 3 times, insert hook in same stitch, Yoh and pull up loop, [Yoh and draw through 2 loops on hook] 3 times; Yoh and draw through all 5 loops on hook. 4-dtr Cl (4 double treble crochet cluster) $=$ [Yoh] 3 times, insert hook in indicated stitch, Yoh and pull up loop, [Yoh and draw through 2 loops on hook] 3 times (2 loops remain on hook); * [Yoh] 3 times, insert hook in same stitch, Yoh and pull up loop, [Yoh and draw through 2 loops on hook] 3 times; repeat from * 2 more times, Yoh and draw through all 5 loops on hook.
## 4-tr cl (4 treble crochet cluster)

= [Yoh] twice, insert hook in indicated stitch, Yoh and pull up loop, [Yoh and draw through 2 loops on hook] twice (2 loops remain on hook); * [Yoh] twice, insert hook in same stitch, Yoh and pull up loop, [Yoh and draw through 2 loops on hook] twice; repeat from * 2 more times, Yoh and draw through all 5 loops on hook.
beg 2-dc Cl (beginning 2 double crochet Cl) $=$ Ch 3, Yoh, insert hook in indicated stitch, Yoh and pull up loop, [Yoh, draw through 2 loops on hook] twice.
beg 3-dc Cl (beginning 3 double crochet Cl) $=$ Ch 3, Yoh, insert hook in indicated stitch, Yoh and pull up loop, Yoh, draw through 2 loops on hook, insert hook in same stitch, Yoh and pull up loop, Yoh, draw through all 3 loops on hook.

## beg 4-dtr Cl (beginning 4

 double treble crochet cluster)= Ch 4, [Yoh] 3 times, insert hook in indicated stitch, Yoh and pull up loop, [Yoh and draw through 2 loops on hook] 3 times (2 loops remain on hook); * [Yoh] 3 times, insert hook in same stitch, Yoh and pull up loop, [Yoh and draw through 2 loops on hook] 3 times; repeat from * once more, Yoh and draw through all 4 loops on hook.
beg dc4tog (beginning double crochet 4 together) = Ch 2, [Yoh, insert hook in next stitch, Yoh and pull up loop, Yoh, draw through 2 loops] 3 times, Yoh, draw through all 4 loops on hook. beg V-st (beginning V-stitch) = Ch 4, dc in indicated stitch.
dc2tog-over-ch-spaces (double crochet 2 together - worked over ch-spaces) $=$ [Yoh, insert hook in next ch-3 space, Yoh and pull up loop, Yoh, draw through 2 loops] twice, Yoh, draw through all 3 loops on hook.
dc4tog (double crochet 4 together) $=$ [Yoh, insert hook in next stitch, Yoh and pull up loop, Yoh, draw through 2 loops] 4 times, Yoh, draw through all 5 loops on hook.

## dtr (double treble crochet)

= [Yoh] 3 times, insert hook in indicated stitch, Yoh and draw up a loop, [Yoh and draw through 2 loops on hook] 4 times.
dtr-joining = [Yoh] 3 times, insert hook in FIRST indicated stitch, Yoh and pull up loop, [Yoh and draw through 2 loops on hook] 3 times (2 loops remain on hook); [Yoh] 3 times, insert hook in SECOND indicated stitch (stitches are skipped between legs of joining) Yoh and pull up loop, [Yoh and draw through 2 loops on hook] 3 times, Yoh and draw through remaining 3 loops on hook. picot $=$ Ch 3, slip st in 3rd ch from hook.
picot-in-st $=$ Ch 3, slip st in top of last stitch made.
triple picot $=$ Ch 4, slip st in 4th ch from hook; ch 5, slip st in 5th ch from hook; ch 4, slip st in 4th ch from hook; slip st in top of last stitch (dc) made.

## MEASUREMENTS

Runner measures approximately 23 " [71 cm ] long and 13 " [ 33 cm ] wide.
Doily \#1 worked with smaller hook measures approximately 23/4" [7 cm].
Doily \#2 worked with larger hook measures approximately 43/4" [12 cm].
Doily \#3 worked with larger hook measures approximately $51 / 4$ " $[13.5 \mathrm{~cm}]$.
Doily \#4 worked with larger hook measures approximately 514" [13.5 cm].
Doily \#5 worked with larger hook measures approximately $71 / 4$ " $[18.5 \mathrm{~cm}$ ].
Doily \#6 worked with larger hook measures approximately $73 / 4$ " $[19.5 \mathrm{~cm}$ ].
Doily \#7 worked with larger hook measures approximately $71 / 2$ " $[19 \mathrm{~cm}]$.

Note: All measurements are after blocking

## INSTRUCTIONS

## Notes

- Runner is made from 15 doilies. 4 Doily \#1, 3 Doily \#2, 3 Doily \#3, 1 Doily \#4, 2 Doily \#5, 1 Doily \#6, and 1 Doily \#7 are sewn together, following Layout Diagram, to form runner.
- To change color, work to last 2 loops on hook. Draw loop of next color through 2 loops on hook to complete st and proceed in next color.
- Ch 3 at beg of rnd counts as dc.
- Join all rnds with sl st to first st.

DOILY \#1 (make 4)
Make 4 doilies following Doily \#1 instructions, using thread colors and hook sizes listed below.
Piece 1: Use A and smaller hook.
Piece 8: Use B and larger hook.
Piece 9: Use B and smaller hook.
Piece 12: Use C and smaller hook.
Ch 5 ; join with slip st in first ch to form a ring.
1st rnd: Ch 3, dc in ring, *ch 2, 2 dc in ring; repeat from * 4 times, ch 2 ; join with slip st-12 dc and 6 ch-2 spaces.

2nd rnd: Slip st in next dc and first ch-2 space, ch 5 (counts as first dc and ch-2 space), dc in same ch-2 space, ch $2,{ }^{*}(\mathrm{dc}, \mathrm{ch} 2, \mathrm{dc})$ in next ch-2 space, ch 2; repeat from * around; join with slip st in 3rd ch of beginning ch-12 dc and $12 \mathrm{ch}-2$ spaces.
3rd rnd: (Beg 2-dc Cl, ch 3, 2-dc Cl) same st as join, ch 3, dc in next dc, ch $3, *(2-d c \mathrm{Cl}$, ch 3, 2-dc Cl) in next dc, ch 3, dc in next dc, ch 3; repeat from * around; join-Twelve 2-dc Cl, 6 dc, and 18 ch-3 spaces.
4th rnd: Slip st in next dc and first ch-3 space, (beg 3-dc Cl, picot, 3-dc Cl) in same ch-3 space, ch 3, (3-dc Cl, picot, 3-dc Cl) in next dc, *ch 3, skip next ch-3 space, (3-dc Cl, picot, $3-\mathrm{dc} \mathrm{Cl}$ ) in next ch-3 space, ch 3,(3-dc Cl, picot, 3-dc Cl) in next dc; repeat from * around, ch 3; join-Twenty-four 3-dc Cl, 12 picots, and 12 ch-3 spaces. Fasten off.

## DOILY \#2 (make 3)

Make 3 doilies following doily \#2 instructions, using thread colors and hook sizes listed below.
Piece 3: Use B and larger hook.
Piece 5: Use A and larger hook.
Piece 10: Use C and larger hook.
Ch 5; join with slip st in first ch to form a ring.
1st rnd: Ch 1, sc in ring, * ${ }^{*}$ ch 4, sc in ring; repeat from * 4 times; join with ch 1, dc in first sc (joining ch 1, dc count as last ch-4 sp) - 6 sc and 6 ch-4 spaces.
2nd rnd: Beg V-st in last ch-4 space (space formed by the joining ch 1 , dc of previous rnd), ch 4, *V-st next ch-4 space, ch 4; repeat from * around; join with slip st in 3rd ch of beg V-st- 6 V -sts and 6 ch- 4 spaces. 3rd rnd: Slip st in ch-1 space of first V-st, ch 3, 4 dc in same space, ch 3 , *5 dc in ch-1 space of next V-st, ch 3; repeat from * around; join30 dc and $6 \mathrm{ch}-3$ spaces.
4th rnd: Ch $1,2-\mathrm{sc} \mathrm{Cl}$ in same st as join, [ch 1, sc in next dc] 3 times, ch $1,2-\mathrm{sc} \mathrm{Cl}$ in next dc, ch $3, * 2-\mathrm{sc} \mathrm{Cl}$ in next dc, [ch 1, sc in next dc] 3 times, ch 1, 2-sc Cl in next dc, ch 3; repeat from * around; change to B ; join-Twelve 2 -sc Cls, 18 sc , $6 \mathrm{ch}-3$ spaces, and $24 \mathrm{ch}-1$ spaces.

5th rnd: Ch 1, sc in first ch-1 space, [ch 3 , sc in next ch-1 space] 3 times, ch 4, *sc in next ch-1 space, [ch 3, sc in next ch-1 space] 3 times, ch 4; repeat from * around; join- 24 sc , 18 ch-3 spaces, and 6 ch -4 spaces.
6th rnd: Ch 1, sc in first ch-3 space, [ch 3, sc in next ch-3 space] twice, ch 8 , *sc in next ch-3 space, [ch 3, sc in next ch-3 space] twice, ch 8; repeat from * around; join- 18 sc, 12 ch- 3 spaces, and 6 ch- 8 spaces. 7th rnd: Ch 1 , sc in first ch-3 space, ch 3 , sc in next ch-3 space, ch 3, (3 dc, [picot, 3 dc$]$ twice) in next ch-8 space, *[ch 3, sc in next ch-3 space] twice, ch 3, (3 dc, [picot, 3 dc] twice) in next ch-8 space; repeat from * around, ch 3; join$12 \mathrm{sc}, 54 \mathrm{dc}$, and $18 \mathrm{ch}-3$ spaces. Fasten off.

DOILY \#3 (make 3)
Make 3 doilies following doily \#3 instructions, using thread colors and hook sizes listed below.
Piece 2: Use C and larger hook.
Piece 13: Use B and larger hook.
Piece 14: Use A and larger hook.
Ch 7; join with slip st in first ch to form a ring.
1st rnd: Ch 3, 23 dc in ring; join24 dc .
2nd rnd: Ch 3, dc in first dc, *ch 3, skip next dc, 2 dc next dc; repeat from * to last dc, ch 3, skip last dc; join- 24 dc and 12 ch-3 spaces.
3rd rnd: Slip st in next dc and first ch-3 space, ch 3, 4 dc in same ch-3 space, [ch $1,5 \mathrm{dc}$ in nextch-3 space] 11 times, ch 1 ; join-60 dc and 12 ch- 1 spaces.
4th rnd: (Slip st, ch 1, sc) in last ch-1 space, ch 6, *sc in next ch-1 space, ch 6; repeat from * around; join-12 sc and 12 ch-6 spaces. Fasten off.
5th rnd: Join yarn with slip st in any ch-6 space, (beg 3-dc Cl, ch 3, 3-dc Cl) in same ch-6 space, ch 3, *(3-dc Cl, ch 3, 3-dc Cl) in next ch-6 space, ch 3; rep from * around; join- Twenty-four 3-dc Cl and $24 \mathrm{ch}-3$ spaces.

6th rnd: SI st in next ch-3 sp. Ch 1. 1 sc in same sp as sl st. *Ch 6.1 sc in next ch-3 sp. Rep from * around. Ch 6. Join. 24 Ch-6 sps.
7th rnd: *(8 dc. picot-in st. 8 dc) in next ch- 6 sp . ( 1 sc in next ch- 6 sp . Ch 6) twice. 1 sc in next ch- 6 sp . Rep from * around. Join. Six ( 8 dc . picotin st. 8 dc) groups. 12 Ch-6 sps. Fasten off.

DOILY \#4 (make 1)
Make 1 doily following doily \#4 instructions, using thread color and hook size listed below.
Piece 15: Use C and smaller hook.
Ch 5, slip st in first ch to form ring.
1st rnd: Ch 1, 8 sc in ring; join- 8 sc . 2nd rnd: Ch 5 (counts as first dc and ch-3 space), *dc in next sc, ch 3; repeat from * around; join with slip st in 2 nd ch of beginning ch-8 dc and $8 \mathrm{ch}-3$ spaces.
3rd rnd: Ch 1, sc in same st, (2 sc, picot-in-st, sc) in next ch-3 space, * sc in next dc, (2 sc, picot-in-st, sc) in next ch-3 space; repeat from * around; join- 32 sc and 8 picot.
4th rnd: Beg 4-dtr Cl, ch 7, *4 dtrCl in sc above next dc on 2nd rnd, ch 7; repeat from * around; join with slip st in top of beg cl-8 Cl and $8 \mathrm{ch}-7$ spaces.

5th rnd: Ch 1 , sc in same st, ch 5, tr in next ch-7 space, ch 5 , *sc in next Cl, ch 5, tr in next ch-7 space, ch 5; repeat from * around; join-8 tr, 8 sc , and $16 \mathrm{ch}-5$ spaces.
6th rnd: Ch 1, sc in same st, (2 sc, picot-in-st, 4 sc , picot-in-st, sc) in next ch-5 space, sc in next tr, ( 2 sc, picot-in-st, 4 sc , picot-in-st, sc) in next ch-5 space, *sc in next sc,(2 sc, picot-in-st, 4 sc, picot-inst, sc) in next ch-5 space, sc in next tr,(2 sc, picot-in-st, 4 sc , picot-in-st, sc) in next ch-5 space; repeat from * around; join- 128 sc and 32 picot. 7th rnd: Slip st up to and in 2nd sc between first and 2nd picots, ch 11 (counts as part of first dtr join and 1 ch-7 space), *skip next picot, 4-tr Cl in sc above next tr on 5th rnd (between picots), ch 7, * work dtrjoining inserting hook in 2nd sc after 1st picot and in 2nd sc after 3rd picot, ch 7, skip next picot, 4-tr Cl in sc above next tr on 5th rnd, ch 7; repeat from * around, dtr in 2nd sc after 1st picot; join with slip st in 4th ch of beginning ch-11 (completing first dtr join)-8 dtrjoining, 8 Cl , and $16 \mathrm{ch}-7$ spaces.

8th rnd: Ch 1, working in same st, *sc between legs of dtr-joining, 17 sc in next ch-7 space, sc in next Cl, 17 sc in next ch-7 space; repeat from * around; join-288 sc. Fasten off.

DOILY \#5 (make 2)
Make 2 doilies following doily \#5 instructions, using the thread colors and hook sizes listed below.
Piece 4: Use A and larger hook.
Piece 7: Use B and smaller hook.
Ch 5, slip st in first ch to form ring.
1st rnd: Ch 3, 23 dc in ring; join with, slip-24 dc.
2nd rnd: Ch 1, sc in same st as join, ch 3, *skip 1 dc, sc in next dc, ch 3; repeat from * around; join-12 dc and 12 ch- 3 spaces.
3rd rnd: Slip st in first ch-3 space, beg 4-tr Cl, ch 4, *4-tr Cl in next ch-3 space, ch 4; repeat from * around; join- 12 Cl and $12 \mathrm{ch}-4$ spaces.
4th rnd: (Slip st, ch 1, 5 sc) in first ch-4 space, 5 sc in each remaining ch-4 space around; join- 60 sc (twelve 5-sc groups).
5th rnd: Slip st in next sc, (slip st, ch $1, \mathrm{sc}$ ) in next sc (center sc of first 5 -sc group), ch 5 , skip next 4 sc , * sc in next sc, ch 5 , skip next 4 sc; repeat from * around; join with12 sc and 12 ch- 5 spaces.

6th rnd: Ch 1, sc in same sc, ch 3, dc in next ch-5 space, triple picot, slip st around base of picot, ch 3, * sc in next sc, ch 3, dc in next ch-5 space, triple picot, slip st around base of picot, ch; repeat from * around; join-12 dc, $12 \mathrm{sc}, 12$ triple picot and $24 \mathrm{ch}-3$ spaces. Fasten off and weave in ends.
7th rnd: Join thread in center picot of any triple picot on 6th rnd; ch 1, sc in same st, ch 9, *sc in next center picot, ch 9; repeat from * around; join- 12 sc and 12 ch- 9 spaces.
8th rnd: Slip st up to and in 3rd ch of first ch-9 space, ch 4 (counts as first dc and ch-2 pace), *(dc, ch 3, dc, ch 2, dc) in same ch-9 space, * (dc, ch 2, dc, ch 3, dc, ch 2, dc) in next ch-9 space; repeat from * around; join with slip st in 2nd ch of beg ch-48 dc, 24 ch- 2 spaces, and $12 \mathrm{ch}-3$ spaces.
9th rnd: (Slip st, ch 1, 3 sc ) in first ch-2 space, ch 5, 2-dtr Cl in next ch-5 space, ch 5,3 sc in next ch-2 space, skip $2 \mathrm{dc},{ }^{* 3}$ sc in next ch-2 space, ch 5,2 -dtr Cl in next ch-5 space, ch 5 , 3 sc in next ch-2 space, skip 2 dc; repeat from * around; join- 12 Cl , 72 sc, and 24 ch- 5 spaces.

10th rnd: (Slip st, ch 1, sc) in next sc, *ch 3, (sc, ch 3, sc) in next ch-5 space, ch 3, (sc, ch 4, sc) in top of next Cl , ch 3 , (sc, ch $3, \mathrm{sc}$ ) in next ch-5 space, ch 3, skip next sc, sc in next sc, skip next 2 sc **, sc in next sc; repeat from * around ending last repeat at ${ }^{* *}$; join. Fasten off.

DOILY \#6 (make 1)
Make 1 doily following doily \#6 instructions, using thread color and hook size listed below.
Piece 6: Use C and larger hook.
Ch 5; join with slip st in first ch to form a ring.
1st rnd (right side): [Ch 10, slip st in ring] 5 times; join with ch 5 , dtr in base of beginning ch-10-6 ch-10 spaces (ch 5 and dtr count as ch-10 space).
2nd rnd: Ch 3, (2 dc, ch 3, 3 dc ) in first ch-10 space (formed by joining ch 5, dtr), [ch 2, (3 dc, ch 3, 3 dc ) in next ch-10 space] 5 times, ch 2 ; join- $36 \mathrm{dc}, 6$ ch-3 spaces, and $6 \mathrm{ch}-2$ spaces.
3rd rnd: Ch 3, dc in next 2 dc , ch 3, sc in next ch-3 space, ch 3 , dc in next 3 dc, [ch 2, dc in next 3 dc, ch 3 , sc in next ch-3 space, ch 3 , dc in next 3 dc] 5 times, ch 2; join$36 \mathrm{dc}, 6 \mathrm{sc}$, and $12 \mathrm{ch}-3$ spaces.

4th rnd: Ch 3, dc in next 2 dc , ch 3, dc2tog-over-ch-spaces, ch 3, dc in next 3 dc , [ch 1, dc in next 3 dc , ch 3, dc2tog-over ch-spaces, ch 3, dc in next $3 \mathrm{dc]} 5$ times, ch 1 ; join- 42 dc , $12 \mathrm{ch}-3$ spaces, and 6 ch- 1 spaces.
5th rnd: Ch 3, dc in next 2 dc , ch 3 , (dc, ch 1, dc) in next dc2tog, [ch 3, dc in next 6 dc (skipping the ch-1 space), ch 3, (dc, ch $1, d c$ ) in next dc] 5 times, ch 3, dc in last 3 dc ; join- $48 \mathrm{dc}, 12 \mathrm{ch}-3$ spaces, and 6 ch- 1 spaces.
6th rnd: Ch 3, dc in next 2 dc , ch 1 , sc in next ch-3 space, ch 3 , sc in next ch-1 space, ch 3 , sc in next ch-3 space, ch $1, \mathrm{dc}$ in next 3 dc , [ch 2, dc in next 3 dc , ch 1 , sc in next ch-3 space, ch 3 , sc in next ch-1 space, ch 3 , sc in next ch-3 space, ch $1, \mathrm{dc}$ in next 3 dc ] 5 times, ch 2; join-36 dc, 18 sc , $12 \mathrm{ch}-3$ spaces, and $6 \mathrm{ch}-2$ spaces. 7th rnd: Ch 3, dc in next 2 dc , ch 1, skip next ch-1 space, sc in next ch-3 space, ch 3, sc in next ch-3 space, ch 1 , skip next ch-1 space, dc in next 3 dc, [ch 4, dc in next 3 dc , ch 1, skip next ch-1 space, sc in next ch-3 space, ch 3 , sc in next ch-3 space, ch 1, skip next ch-1 space, dc in next $3 \mathrm{dc]} 5$ times, ch 4; join- $36 \mathrm{dc}, 12 \mathrm{sc}, 6$ ch- 4 spaces, 6 ch -3 spaces, and 12 ch -1 spaces.

8th rnd: Ch 3, dc in next 2 dc ch 1 , skip next ch-1 space, dc in next ch-3 space, ch 1, skip next ch-1 space, dc in next 3 dc , ch 2 , wide $V$-st in next ch-4 space, [ch $2, \mathrm{dc}$ in next 3 dc , ch 1 , skip next ch-1 space, dc in next ch-3 space, ch 1, skip next ch-1 space, dc in next 3 dc , ch 2 , wide V-st in next ch-4 space] 5 times, ch 2; join-42 dc (not including dc in V-sts), 6 wide V-sts, 12 ch- 2 spaces, and $12 \mathrm{ch}-1$ spaces.
9th rnd: Ch 3, dc in next 6 dc (skipping the ch-1 spaces), ch 2, 9 dc in ch-3 space of next V-st, [ch 2, dc in next 7 dc (skipping the ch-1 spaces), ch $2,9 \mathrm{dc}$ in ch-3 space of next V-st) 5 times, ch 2; join-96 dc and $12 \mathrm{ch}-2$ spaces.
10th rnd: Ch 3, dc in next dc, skip next 3 dc , dc in next $2 \mathrm{dc}, \mathrm{ch} 2, \mathrm{dc}$ in next dc, [ch 1, dc in next dc] 8 times *ch 2 , dc in next 2 dc , skip next 3 dc , dc in next $2 \mathrm{dc}, \mathrm{ch} 2$, dc in next dc, [ch 1 , dc in next dc] 8 times; repeat from * 4 more times, ch 2 ; join$78 \mathrm{dc}, 12 \mathrm{ch}-2$ spaces, and $48 \mathrm{ch}-1$ spaces.

11th rnd: Beg dc4tog, ch 2, skip next ch-2 space, dc in next dc, [ch 2, dc in next dc] 3 times, ch 2, wide V-st in next dc, [ch 2, dc in next dc] 4 times, *ch 2, skip next ch-2 space, dc4tog, ch 2, skip next ch-2 space, dc in next dc, [ch 2, dc in next dc] 3 times, ch 2, wide V-st in next dc, [ch 2, dc in next dc] 4 times; repeat from * 3 more times, ch 2; join6 V -sts. Fasten off.

DOILY \#7 (make 1)
Make 1 doily following doily \#7 instructions, using the thread color and hook size listed below.
Piece 11: Use A and larger hook.
Ch 10; join with a slip st in first ch to form a ring.
1st rnd: Ch 3, 20 dc in ring; join21 dc.
2nd rnd: Ch 6 (counts as tr, ch 2), [tr in next dc, ch 2] 20 times; join with slip st in 4th ch of beginning ch-21 tr and $21 \mathrm{ch}-2$ spaces.
3rd rnd: Ch 7 (counts as tr, ch 3), [tr in next tr, ch 3] 20 times; join with slip st in 4th ch of beginning ch-21 tr and 21 ch-3 spaces.

4th rnd: Ch 1, sc in same st as join [ch 7, sc in next tr] 20 times, ch 7; join-21 sc and 21 ch- 7 spaces.
5th rnd: Ch 1, (4 sc, ch 3, 4 sc ) in each ch-7 space around; join168 sc and 21 ch- 3 spaces.
6th rnd: Slip st in each st to first ch-3 space, slip st in ch-3 space, ch 12, slip st in 9th ch from hook (first ch-9 loop made), ch 10, slip st in 7th ch from hook, [ch 7, slip st in last slip st made] twice, sc in last 3 ch of ch-10, ch 9 , slip st in same slip st that closed first ch-9 loop, sc in last 3 ch of ch-12, ch 5, slip st in next ch-3 space of 5th rnd, * ch 7, slip st in last ch-9 space made, ch 4, slip st in 4th ch of ch-7 (ch-9 loops joined), ch 10, slip st in 7th ch from hook, [ch 7, slip st in last slip st made] twice, sc in last 3 ch of ch-10**, ch 9 , slip st in same slip st that closed previous joined ch-9 loop, sc in last 3 ch of ch-7, ch 5, slip st in next ch-3 space of 5th rnd; repeat from * around ending last repeat at **; ch 4, slip st in first ch-9 loop, ch 4, slip st in same slip st that closed previous ch-9 loop, sc in last 3 ch of ch-7, ch 5; join. Fasten off.

## FINISHING

Weave in ends.
Arrange doilies following Layout Diagram. With sewing needle and matching sewing thread or transparent thread, sew doilies together.
