Featuring Anchor® Embroidery Floss Spools

This fat little bird is quite content sitting on his branch. Combining felt applique and embroidery stitches with Anchor® Embroidery Floss on Spools gives a three dimensional affect.

MATERIALS Anchor® Embroidery Floss Spools: 1 of each color 5975 0360 0403 0341 0226 0227 0262 0340 1024 0398 0246 0242 0390

Anchor® Embroidery Hoop. Embroidery or Crewel needle, size 7 or 8. Cotton or Linen fabric. Coats & Clark™ All-Purpose thread for basting. Fabric marker for transferring design. Small pieces of gray, black and white felt.



MEASUREMENT

Finished design is approximately 8" (20cm) in diameter

INSTRUCTIONS

Note: All elements use 6 strands of Anchor® Floss

- 1. Transfer your design to the embroidery fabric.
- 2. Trace the pattern pieces above onto the gray, white and brown felt.
- 3. Using Coats & Clark™ All-Purpose thread, baste the gray and brown felt pieces onto the embroidery fabric. Wait on the white (beak) felt. It will be done later.



- 4. Stitch the bird first. Begin at the bottom, work your way up. Then do the top. Fill in the center leaving some of the brown felt showing through.
- 5. Baste the beak in place after the bird is stitched.
- 6. Finish stitching the beak
- 7. Stitch the wings blending in the colors.
- 8. Finally, stitch the branch. Begin with the lines you transferred to your fabric.



9. Then fill in with the remaining colors as shown using the photo of the finished design for reference.








In the diagram, the letter refers to the stitch and the number refers to the color. For example, A1 means to the split stitch with Anchor Floss 5975 brick dark.

- A Split stitch
- B Satin stitch
- C Straight (spoke) stitch
- D Long and short stitch
- 1. 5975 Brick dark
- 2. 0226 Emerald medium light
- 3. 0227 Emerald medium
- 4. 0262 Loden green medium
- 5. 0360 Coffee dark
- 6. 0403 Black
- 7. 0340 Terra cotta medium dark
- 8. 0341 Terra cotta dark
- 9. 1024 Peoni medium dark

- 10. 0398 Grey
- 11. 0246 Grass green very dark
- 12. 0242 Grass green medium light
- 13. 0390 Linen light






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STITCHES

TIP: To separate the floss into strands, cut an 18" length. Hold one end and run the finger of your opposite hand between the strands allowing them to untwist. Thread the needle.
