

BERNAT FROSTBITE COWL | CROCHET

Cowl is worked lengthwise using a simple 1 row repeat pattern with sc3tog and chain spaces. Zipper tape is pre-marked and sewn with yarn for extra contrast.



MATERIALS

Bernat® Wool Up Bulky™ (6 oz/170 g; 121 yds/110 m)

Aran (50008) 2 balls

Size U.S. N/15 (10 mm) crochet hook **or size needed to obtain gauge.** 16" [40.5 cm] long separating zipper. Fabric marking pen. Large eye, sharp tipped needle.

ABBREVIATIONS:

Approx = Approximately **Beg** = Beginning Ch = Chain(s)

Cont = Continue(ity) **Rem** = Remain(ing)

Rep = Repeat

Sc3tog = Draw up a loop in each of next 3 indicated spaces. Yoh and draw

Sc = Single crochet

RS = Right side

Rnd = Round

through all loops on hook.

SI st = Slip stitch

Sp = Space

St(s) = Stitch(es) **WS** = Wrong side

Yoh = Yarn over hook

CROCHET | SKILL LEVEL: EASY

MEASUREMENTS

Approx 16" [40.5 cm] high x 27" [68.5 cm] around.

GAUGE

7 sc and 8 rows = 4'' [10 cm].

INSTRUCTIONS

Ch 29.

1st row: (RS). 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook. Ch 1. Sc3tog, drawing up first loop in same ch as previous sc, then in each of next 2 ch. *Ch 1. Sc3tog, drawing up first loop in same ch as last leg of previous st, then in each of next 2 ch. Rep from * to end of row. 1 sc in same sp as last leg of previous st. Turn.


2nd row: Ch 1. 1 sc in first sc. Sc3tog, drawing up first loop in same sp as last sc, 2nd loop in top of next sc3tog, and 3rd loop in next ch-1 sp. *Ch 1. Sc3tog, drawing up first loop in same sp as last leg of previous sc3tog, 2nd loop in top of next sc3tog, and 3rd loop in next ch-1 sp. Rep from * to end of row. 1 sc in same sp as last leg of previous sc3tog. Turn.

Rep last row until work from beg measures approx 27" [68.5 cm], ending on a WS row. Turn.

Edging rnd: (RS). Ch 1. 1 sc in each st and ch sp to end of row, working 3 sc in last sc. **Do not** turn. Rotate Cowl and cont working sc evenly across rem 3 sides, working 3 sc in each corner. Join with sl st to first sc. Fasten off.

Zipper

Using fabric marking pen and working along center of zipper tape, mark both sides of zipper tape with dots at ½" [1.5] cm] intervals. Pin zipper in position. Using large-eyed, sharp-tipped needle and length of yarn, sew zipper in position with whip stitch through each marked dot.



STITCH KEY = chain (ch) + = single crochet (sc)

= single crochet 3 together (sc3tog)

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
