## SIZE

One size to fit average Adult's head.

## GAUGE:

13 hdc and 10 rows $=4^{\prime \prime}[10 \mathrm{~cm}$ ].

## INSTRUCTIONS

Solid Version (not shown)
Note: Ch 2 at beg of rnd does not count as st.

Ch 4. Join with sl st to first ch to form a ring.
1st rnd: Ch 2. 8 hdc in ring. Join with sl st to first hdc.
2nd rnd: Ch 2. 2 hdc in each hdc around. Join with sl st to first hdc. 16 hdc.
3rd rnd: Ch 2. (2 hdc in next hdc.
1 hdc in next hdc) 8 times. Join with sl st to first sc. 24 hdc.

4th rnd: Ch 2. (2 hdc in next hdc. 1 hdc in each of next 2 hdc ) 8 times. Join with sl st to first hdc. 32 hdc. 5th rnd: Ch 2. (2 hdc in next hdc. 1 hdc in each of next 3 hdc) 8 times. Join with sl st to first sc. 40 hdc.

6th rnd: Ch 2. (2 hdc in next hdc. 1 hdc in each of next 4 hdc) 8 times. Join with sl st to first sc. 48 hdc.
7th rnd: Ch 2. 1 hdc in each hdc around. Join with sl st to first hdc.
8th rnd: Ch 2. ( 2 hdc in next hdc. 1 hdc in each of next 5 hdc$) 8$ times. Join with sl st to first sc. 56 hdc. 9th rnd: As 7th rnd.
10th rnd: Ch 2. (2 hdc in next hdc. 1 hdc in each of next 6 hdc$) 8$ times. Join with sl st to first sc. 64 hdc.
11th to 22nd rnds: As 7th rnd. Fasten off.

## Striped Version 1

Stripe Pat 1: With A - 8 rnds. With B - 7 rnds. With C-7 rnds.
Proceed in Stripe Pat I, work as given for Solid Version.

## Striped Version 2

Stripe Pat 2: With A - 3 rnds. With B - 1 rnd. With A - 5 rnds. With C - 1 rnd. With A - 5 rnds. With B 1 rnd. With A - 5 rnds. With C 1 rnd.

Proceed in Stripe Pat 2, work as given for Solid Version.

## Striped Version 3

Stripe Pat 3: With A - 1 rnd. With B-1 rnd. With C - 1 rnd. These 3 rnds form Stripe Pat 3. Proceed in Stripe Pat 3, work as given for Solid Version, working 2 extra rnds to end on 3rd rnd of Stripe Pat 3.

## Striped Version 4

Stripe Pat 4: With A - 16 rnds. With B - 2 rnds. With A - 1 rnd.
 With C - 2 rnds. With A - 1 rnd. Proceed in Stripe Pat 4, work as given for Solid Version.

## Striped Version 5

Stripe Pat 5: With A - 7 rnds.
With C - 1 rnd. With A - 6 rnds.
With B-1 rnd. With C-1 rnd.
With B - 6 rnds.
Proceed in Stripe Pat 5, work as given for Solid Version.
