



KNIT I SKILL LEVEL: **INTERMEDIATE**

ABBREVIATIONS

Approx = Approximately

Beg = Beginning

Ch = Chain(s)

Cont = Continue(ity)

Dc = Double crochet

Hdc = Half double crochet

Hdc2(3)tog = (Yoh and draw up a loop in next st) twice (3 times).

Yoh and draw through all loops on hook

Dcbp = Yoh and draw up a loop around post of next st at back of work inserting hook from right to left. (Yoh and draw through 2 loops on hook) twice

Dcfp = Yoh and draw up a loop around post of next st at front of work inserting hook from right to left. (Yoh and draw through 2 loops on hook) twice

Inc'd = Increased

PM = Place marker

Rep = Repeat

RS = Right side

Sc = Single crochet

Sl st = Slip stitch

Sp(s) = Space(s)

St(s) = Stitch(es)

WS = Wrong side

Yoh = Yarn over hook

MEASUREMENTS

Approx 28" x 66" [73.5 x 167.5 cm]

GAUGE

9 sc and 10 rows = 4" [10 cm].

INSTRUCTIONS

Notes:

- Ch 2 at beg of row **does not** count as hdc.
- Ch 3 at beg of row counts as dc.
- Move marker to every center ch-3 sp.
- Shawl is worked from 2 ends of ball to achieve color-shifting effect; colors are changed at center of Shawl

MATERIALS

Bernat® Plentiful™ (10.6 oz/300 g; 952 yds/871 m)

Dragonfly (19009)

1 ball

Size U.S. L/11 (8 mm) crochet hook **or size needed to obtain gauge.**

Triangle (see diagram on page 3).
With first end as A, ch 4.

1st row: (WS). (3 dc. Ch 2. With 2nd end as B, 4 dc) in 4th ch from hook. Turn. 8 dc and ch-2 sp. Turn.

2nd row: With second end as B, ch 3. 1 hdc in first dc. 1 hdc each dc to ch-2 sp. (2 hdc. With A, ch 2. 2 hdc) in next ch-2 sp. PM on ch-2 sp for center. 1 hdc in each hdc to last dc. (1 hdc. 1 dc) in top of ch 3. Turn. 6 sts inc'd.

3rd row: With A, ch 3. 1 hdc in first dc. 1 hdc in each hdc to center ch-2 sp. (2 hdc. Ch 2. With B, 2 hdc) in center ch-2 sp. 1 hdc in each hdc to last dc. (1 hdc. 1 dc) in last dc. Turn. 6 sts inc'd.

4th row: With B, ch 3. 1 hdc in first dc. 1 dcbp around each hdc to center ch-2 sp. (2 hdc. With A, ch 2. 2 hdc) in center ch-2 sp. 1 dcbp around each hdc to last dc. (1 hdc. 1 dc) in last dc. Turn. 6 sts inc'd.

5th row: With A, ch 3. 1 hdc in first st. 1 hdc in each st to center ch-2 sp. (2 hdc. Ch 2. With B, 2 hdc) in center ch-2 sp. 1 hdc in each st to last dc. (1 hdc. 1 dc) in last st. Turn. 6 sts inc'd.

6th row: With B, ch 3. 1 hdc in first dc. 1 hdc each hdc to ch-2 sp. (2 hdc. With A, ch 2. 2 hdc) in next ch-2 sp. 1 hdc in each hdc to last dc. (1 hdc. 1 dc) in last dc. Turn. 6 sts inc'd.

7th row: With A, ch 3. 1 hdc in first dc. 1 dcfp around each hdc to center ch-2 sp. (2 hdc. With B, ch 2. 2 hdc) in center ch-2 sp. 1 dcfp around each hdc to last dc. (1 hdc. 1 dc) in last dc. Turn. 6 sts inc'd.

8th row: With B, ch 3. 1 hdc in first dc. 1 hdc each st to ch-2 sp. (2 hdc. With A, ch 2. 2 hdc) in next ch-2 sp. 1 hdc in each st to last dc. (1 hdc. 1 dc) in last st. Turn. 6 sts inc'd.

Rep 3rd to 8th rows, until work from beg, along center measures approx 28" [73.5 cm], ending on 7th row.

Shape Right Side of Shawl:

Note: Work with second end as B only.

1st row: (RS). Ch 3. 1 hdc in first st. 1 hdc in each st to last st before center ch-2 sp. Hdc2tog. **Turn.** Leave rem sts unworked.

2nd row: Ch 2. Hdc2tog. 1 hdc in each hdc to last dc. (1 hdc. 1 dc) in last dc. Turn.

3rd row: Ch 3. 1 hdc in first dc. 1 dcbp around each hdc to last 2 sts. Hdc2tog. Turn.

4th row: Ch 2. Hdc2tog. 1 hdc in each st to last dc. (1 hdc. 1 dc) in last dc. Turn.

5th row: Ch 3. 1 hdc in first dc. 1 hdc in each hdc to last 2 sts. Hdc2tog. Turn.

6th row: Ch 2. Hdc2tog. 1 dcfp around each hdc to last dc. (1 hdc. 1 dc) in last dc. Turn.

7th row: Ch 3. 1 hdc in first st. 1 hdc in each st to last 2 sts. Hdc2tog. Turn.

8th row: As 2nd row.

9th row: As 5th row.

**Rep 2nd to 9th rows for pat until longer side from foundation ch measures 33" [84 cm], ending on a WS row.

Keeping cont of pat, dec both sides as follows:

1st row: (RS). Ch 2. Hdc2tog. Pat to last 2 sts. Hdc2tog. Turn.

Rep last row until 3 sts rem.

Next row: Hdc3tog. Fasten off.**

Shape Left Side of Shawl:

Note: Work with first end as A only.

1st row: (RS). Join A with sl st to center ch-2 sp. Ch 2. Hdc2tog. 1 hdc in each st to last dc. (1 hdc. 1 dc) in last dc. Turn.

2nd row: Ch 3. 1 hdc in first dc. 1 hdc in each hdc to last 2 sts. Hdc2tog. Turn.

3rd row: Ch 2. Hdc2tog. 1 dcbp around each hdc to last dc. (1 hdc. 1 dc) in last dc. Turn.

4th row: Ch 3. 1 hdc in first dc. 1 hdc in each st to last 2 sts. Hdc2tog. Turn.

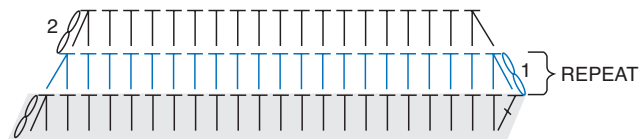
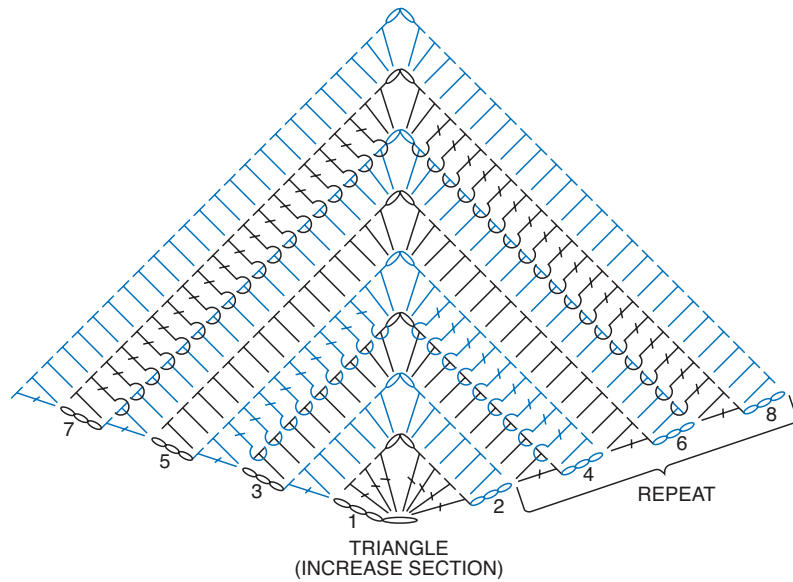
5th row: Ch 2. Hdc2tog. 1 hdc in each hdc to last dc. (1 hdc. 1 dc) in last dc. Turn.

6th row: Ch 3. 1 hdc in first dc. 1 dcfp around each hdc to last 2 sts. Hdc2tog. Turn.

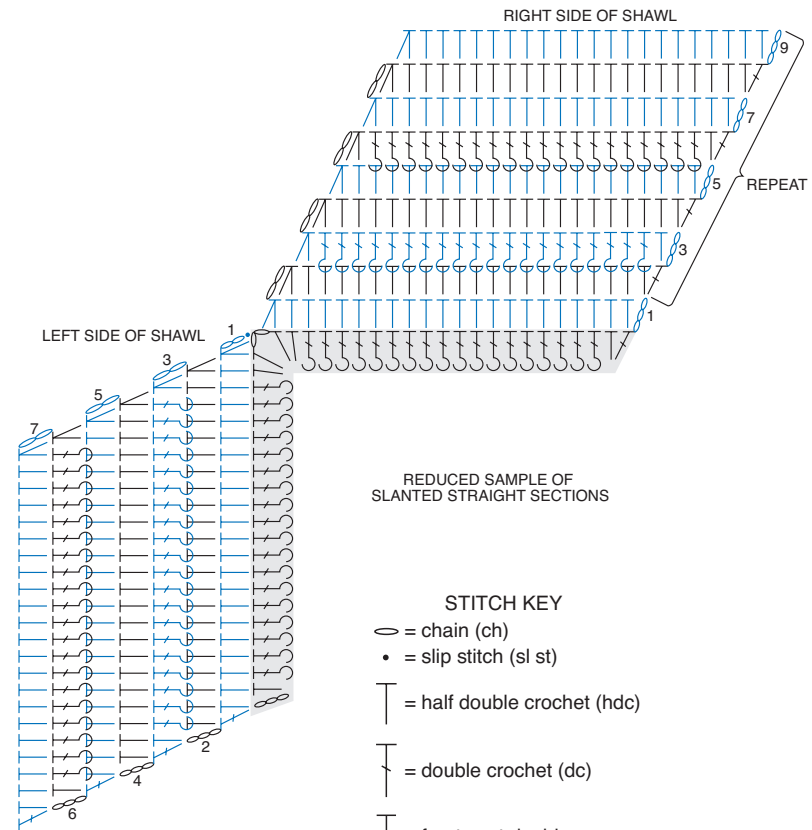
7th row: Ch 2. Hdc2tog. 1 hdc in each st to last dc. (1 hdc. 1 dc) in last dc. Turn.

8th row: As 2nd row.

9th row: As 5th row.
Rep from ** to ** as given for Right Side.

STITCH KEY

- ┆ = half double crochet 2 together (hdc2tog)
- ┆ = half double crochet 3 together (hdc3tog)
