



CROCHET | SKILL LEVEL: INTERMEDIATE

ABBREVIATIONS

Approx =

Approximately

Ch = Chain(s)

Dc = Double crochet

Dcbp = Yoh and draw up a loop around post of next stitch at back of work, inserting hook from right to left. (Yoh and draw through 2 loops on hook) twice.

Dcbp2tog = (Yoh

and draw up a loop around post of next dc at back of work, inserting hook from right to left. Yoh and draw through 2 loops on hook) twice. Yoh and draw through all 3 loops on hook

Pat = Pattern

Picot = Ch 3. Sl st in 3rd ch from hook

PM = Place marker

Rep = Repeat

Rnd(s) = Round(s)

Sc = Single crochet

Sp(s) = Space(s)

Tr = Treble crochet

V-st = (1 dc. Ch 1. 1 dc) in indicated stitch or space

Yoh = Yarn over hook

MEASUREMENTS

Approx 60" [152.5 cm] wide x 25" [63.5 cm] deep.

GAUGE

10 sc and 11 rows = 4" [10 cm].

INSTRUCTIONS

Note: See diagram on page 2.

Ch 6.

1st row: (RS). [(1 dc. Ch 1) twice. 1 tr] all in 6th ch from hook. Turn.

2nd row: Ch 4 (counts as tr). (1 dc. Ch 4. 1 dc) in next ch-1 sp. V-st in

next ch-1 sp. PM on ch-1 sp for center. (1 dc. Ch 4. 1 dc) in 6th ch of ch-6. 1 tr in 5th ch of turning ch-6. Turn.

3rd row: Ch 5 (counts as tr and ch 1). *Skip next dc. 9 dc in next ch-4 sp. Skip next dc.* V-st in center V-st. Rep from * to * once more. Ch 1. 1 tr in top of turning ch-4. Turn.

4th row: Ch 4 (counts as tr). *(1 dc in next dc. Picot) 8 times. 1 dc in next dc.* V-st in next V-st. Rep from * to * once more. 1 tr in 4th ch of turning ch-5. Turn.

MATERIALS

Bernat® Plentiful™ (10.6 oz/300 g; 952 yds/871 m

Surf (19008)

1 ball

Size U.S. K/10½ (6.5 mm) crochet hook **or size needed to obtain gauge.** Stitch marker.

5th row: Ch 4. *1 dcbp around next dc. (Ch 3. Skip next dc. 1 dcbp around next dc) 4 times.* V-st in next V-st. Rep from * to * once more. 1 tr in top of turning ch-4. Turn.

6th row: Ch 4. *(1 dc. Ch 4. 1 dc) in next dcbp. (1 sc in next ch-3 sp. Ch 3) 3 times. 1 sc in next ch-3 sp. (1 dc. Ch 4. 1 dc) in next dcbp.* V-st in next V-st. Rep from * to * once. 1 tr in top of turning ch. Turn.

7th row: Ch 4. *Skip next dc. 9 dc in next ch-4 sp. (1 sc in next ch-3 sp. Ch 3) twice. 1 sc in next ch-3 sp. 9 dc in next ch-4 sp. Skip next dc. * V-st in next V-st. Rep from * to * once more. 1 tr in top of turning ch-4. Turn.

8th row: Ch 4. *(1 dc in next dc. Picot) 8 times. 1 dc in next dc. 1 sc in next ch-3 sp. Ch 3. 1 sc in next ch-3 sp. (1 dc in next dc. Picot) 8 times. 1 dc in next dc.* V-st in next V-st. Rep from * to * once more. 1 tr in top of turning ch. Turn.

9th row: Ch 4. *1 dcbp around next dc. (Ch 3. Skip next dc. 1 dcbp around next dc) 3 times. Ch 3. Skip next dc. Dcbp2tog. (Ch 3. Skip next dc. 1 dcbp around next dc) 4 times.* V-st in next V-st. Skip next dc. Rep from * to * once more. 1 tr

in top of turning ch. Turn.

10th row: Ch 4. *(1 dc. Ch 4. 1 dc) in next dcbp. [(1 sc in next ch-3 sp. Ch 3) 3 times. 1 sc in next ch-3 sp. (1 dc. Ch 4. 1 dc) in next st (dcbp2tog or dc)] twice.* V-st in next V-st. Rep from * to * once more. 1 tr in top of turning ch. Turn.

11th row: Ch 4. *Skip next dc. [9 dc in next ch-4 sp. (1 sc in next ch-3 sp. Ch 3) twice. 1 sc in next ch-3 sp] twice. 9 dc in next ch-4 sp. Skip next dc.* V-st in next V-st. Rep from * to * once more. 1 tr in top of turning ch. Turn.

12th row: Ch 4. *[(1 dc in next dc. Picot) 8 times. 1 dc in next dc. 1 sc in next ch-3 sp. Ch 3. 1 sc in next ch-3 sp] twice. (1 dc in next dc. Picot) 8 times. 1 dc in next dc.* V-st in next V-st. Rep from * to * once more. 1 tr in top of turning ch. Turn.

13th row: Ch 4. *[1 dcbp around next dc. (Ch 3. Skip next dc. 1 dcbp around next dc) 3 times. Ch 3. Skip next dc. Dcbp2tog] twice. (Ch 3. Skip next dc. 1 dcbp around next dc) 4 times.* V-st in next V-st. Skip next dc. Rep from * to * once more. 1 tr in top of turning ch. Turn.

Rep 10th to 13th rows for pat, noting rep in [] will be repeated 1 more time in subsequent rows, until wider side of Shawl measures approx 60" [152.5 cm], ending on 13th row of pat. Fasten off.

STITCH KEY

- + = single crochet (sc)
- ┆ = double crochet (dc)
- ┆ = treble crochet (tr)
- ┆ = back post double crochet (dcbp)
- ┆ = back post double crochet 2 together (dcbp2tog)
