## MEASUREMENTS

Approx 15" x 72" [38 x 183 cm].

## GAUGES

21 sts and 8 rows = 4" [10 cm] in Shell and Broomstick Lace Pat with Bernat® Softee® Cotton.

42 sts and 10 rows = 4" [10 cm] in Shell and Broomstick Lace Pat with Aunt Lydia® Classic™ 10.

## INSTRUCTIONS

**Note:** Ch 3 at beg of row counts as dc.

With A, ch 82. See diagram on page 2.

**1st row:** (RS). 1 dc in 4th ch from hook (counts as 2 dc). 1 dc in each ch to end of ch. Turn. 80 dc.

**2nd row:** Ch 3. Skip next st. (1 dc. Ch 3. 1 dc) all in next st. Skip next 4 sts. \*(1 dc. Ch 3. 1 dc) all in next st. Rep from \* to last 2 sts. Skip next st. 1 dc in last st. Turn.

**3rd row:** Ch 3. 5 dc in each ch-3 sp to end of row. 1 dc in last st. Turn. 82 dc.

**4th row:** Ch 3. Skip next 2 dc. (1 dc. Ch 3. 1 dc) all in next dc. Skip next 4 dc. \*(1 dc. Ch 3. 1 dc) all in next dc. Rep from \* to last 3 dc. Skip next 2 dc. 1 dc in last dc. Turn.

**5th row:** As 3rd row.

**6th and 7th rows:** Rep 4th and 5th rows. **Do not** turn work at end of 7th row. Break A. Join B with sl st to top of ch-3 at beg of 7th row.

**8th row:** (RS). With B, ch 1. 1 sc in first dc. \*2 sc in next st. Rep from \* to last st. 1 sc in last st. Turn. 162 sts.

## MATERIALS

**Bernat® Softee® Cotton™** (4.2 oz/120 g; 254 yds/232 m)

**Contrast A** Seaside Blue (69011) **2 balls**

**Aunt Lydia® Crochet Thread Classic™ 10** (400 yds/366 m)

**Contrast B** White (154-0001) **1 ball**

Size U.S. G/6 (4 mm) crochet hook **or size needed to obtain gauge.**  
Yarn needle. Size U.S. 35 (19 mm) knitting needle for Broomstick Lace Pat.

**9th row:** Place loop from hook onto knitting needle. Working from left to right, \*Draw up a long loop in next sc and place on knitting needle. Rep from \* to end of row. 162 loops on needle. Break B.

Join A by inserting hook through first 11 loops on needle. Yoh and draw through 11 loops on hook. Ch 1.

**10th row:** 6 sc in top of group of 11 loops. \*Insert hook through next 10 loops on needle. Yoh and draw through 11 loops on hook (10 loops from needle, 1 loop already on hook). 5 sc in top of group of 10 loops. Rep from \* to last 11 loops. Insert hook through last 11 loops. Yoh and draw through 12 loops on hook. 6 sc in top of group of 11 loops. Turn. 82 sts.

**11th row:** Ch 3. Skip next 2 sc. (1 dc. Ch 3. 1 dc) all in next sc. Skip next 4 sc. \*(1 dc. Ch 3. 1 dc) all in next sc. Rep from \* to last 3 sc. Skip next 2 sc. 1 dc in last sc. Turn.

Rep 3rd to 11th rows for Shell and Broomstick Lace Pat until work from beg measures approx 70" [178 cm], ending on a 7th row. **Turn.**

**Next row:** With A, ch 2 (does not count as st). 1 dc in each st to end of row. Fasten off.
