Bernat $^{\oplus}$ Blanket $^{\text {TM }}$ Perfect Phasing ${ }^{\text {m }}$ ( $10.5 \mathrm{oz} / 300 \mathrm{~g} ; 220 \mathrm{yds} / 201 \mathrm{~m}$ )
Contrast A Crimson (43002)
1 ball or 55 yds/50 m
1 ball or 62 yds/57 m
Size U.S. K/10 $1 / 2$ [6.5 mm] Susan Bates ${ }^{\circledR}$ Silvalume ${ }^{\circledR}$ crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge. Susan Bates ${ }^{\circledR}$ yarn needle. Purchased headband. Hot glue gun and glue sticks.

## ABBREVIATIONS

Approx = Approximately
Beg $=$ Beginning
Ch = Chain(s)
Dc = Double crochet
Dsc2tog = Working vertically, draw up a loop in side of next sc. Draw up a loop in next unworked sc of previous round. Yoh and draw through all loops on hook. Hdc = Half double crochet
PM = Place marker
Rem = Remain(ing)
Rep $=$ Repeat
Rnd(s) = Round(s)
RS $=$ Right side
$\mathbf{S c}=$ Single crochet
Sc2tog = Draw up a loop in each of next 2 stitches. Yoh and draw through all loops on hook.
$\mathbf{S l} \mathbf{s t}=$ Slip stitch
Sp(s) = Space(s)
St(s) = Stitch(es)
Usc2tog = Draw up a loop in next sc. Working vertically, draw up a loop in side of next sc. Yoh and draw through all loops on hook. $\mathrm{Tr}=$ Treble crochet
WS = Wrong side
Yoh = Yarn over hook

## MEASUREMENTS

Horn: Approx 5 " [ 12.5 cm ] tall x 2½" [ 6.5 cm ] diameter at base.
Rose: Approx $31 / 2^{\prime \prime}[9 \mathrm{~cm}$ ] in diameter.

## GAUGE

9 sc and 10 rows $=4$ " $[10 \mathrm{~cm}$ ].

## INSTRUCTIONS

## HORNS

With $B$, beg using magic ring method, demonstrated here.
1st rnd: Ch 1.7 sc in ring. Join with sl st to first sc.
2nd rnd: Ch 1.2 sc in each sc around. Join with sl st to first sc. 14 sc .
3rd rnd: Ch 1. *2 sc in next sc. 1 sc in next sc. Rep from * around. Join with sl st to first sc. 21 sc .

## Yarnspirations <br> spark your inspiration!

4th rnd: Ch 1. Working in back loops only, 1 sc in each sc around. Join with $s l$ st to first sc.
5th row: (RS). Ch 1.1 sc in first sc. 1 sc in each of next 13 sc . Turn. Leave rem sts unworked.
6th row: (WS). Ch 1.1 sc in first sc. Sc2tog. 1 sc in each of next 8 sc . Sc2tog. 1 sc in next sc. Do not turn. 7th rnd: (WS). Ch 1. (Working vertically, draw up a loop in side of next sc. Draw up a loop in next unworked sc of previous rnd. Yoh and draw through all loops on hook Dsc2tog (downward sc2tog) made. PM on Dsc2tog. Sc2tog. 1 sc in next st. Sc2tog. Draw up a loop in next sc. (Working vertically, draw up a loop in side of nextsc. Yoh and draw through all loops on hook-Usc2tog (upward sc2tog) made. Working into rem sts of 6th row, 1 sc in each st to marked st. Join with sl st to marked st. Turn. 17 sts.
8th row: (RS) Ch 1. Skip first st. 1 sc in each of next 12 sc . Turn.
9th row: (WS). Ch 1.1 sc in first sc. Sc2tog. (1 sc in each of next 2 sc. Sc2tog) twice. 1 sc in next sc. Dsc2tog. PM on Dsc2tog. 1 sc in each of next 3 sc . Usc2tog. 1 sc in each sc to marked st. Join with sl st to marked st. Turn. 14 sts.

10th row: Ch 1. Skip first st. 1 sc in each of next 9 sc . Turn. Leave rem sts unworked.
11th rnd: Ch 1. (Sc2tog. 1 sc in next sc) 3 times. Dsc2tog. PM on Dsc2tog. 1 sc in next sc. Sc2tog. Usc2tog. 1 sc in each st to marked st. Join with sl st in marked st. Turn. 10 sts.
12th row: Ch 1 . Skip first st. 1 sc in each of next 6 sts. Turn.
13th rnd: Ch 1. (Sc2tog) 3 times. Dsc2tog. Sc2tog. Usc2tog. Join with sl st to first st. Turn. 6 sts.
14th and 15th rnds: Ch 1.1 sc in each st around. Join.
16th rnd: Ch 1. (Sc2tog. 1 sc in next st) twice. Fasten off.

Using hot glue, attach Horns to each side of Headband as shown in photo.

## ROSES (make 2).

With A, ch 14.
1st row: (1 dc. Ch 2.1 dc ) all in 3rd ch from hook. ( 1 dc . Ch 2.1 dc ) in each ch to end of ch. Turn.

2nd row: Sl st in first ch-2 sp. Ch 1. ( 1 sc .5 hdc .1 sc ) in same ch-2 sp. [ $(1 \mathrm{sc} .5$ hdc. 1 sc ) in next ch-2 sp] 3 times. [( 1 hdc .5 dc .1 hdc$)$ in next ch-2 sp] 4 times. [(1 dc. 5 tr. 1 dc ) in next ch-2 sp] 4 times. Fasten off.

Coil Roses into Rose shape and secure to Headband as shown in photo using hot glue.
