ABBREVIATIONS

Approx =

Approximately

Beg = Begin(ning)

Ch = Chain(s)

Cont = Continue

Dc = Double crochet

Pat = Pattern

Rep = Repeat

Rnd = Round

RS = Right side

Sc = Single crochet

Sl st = Slip stitch

St(s) = Stitch(es)

WS = Wrong side

MEASUREMENTS

Approx 30" x 34" [76 x 86.5 cm]

GAUGE

7 sc and 8 rows = 4" [10 cm]

INSTRUCTIONS

Stripe Pat

With A, work 1 row.

With B, work 1 row.

With MC, work 4 rows.

These 6 rows form Stripe Pat.

Notes:

- Ch 3 at beg of row counts as dc
- Carry MC only when not in use along side edge of work
- To change color, work to last 2 loops on hook and draw new color through last 2 loops, then proceed in new color

BLANKET

With MC, ch 53.

1st row: (RS). 1 dc in 4th ch from hook and each ch to end of chain. Turn. 51 dc.

2nd row: Ch 1. 1 sc in each dc to end of row. Join A. Turn.

3rd row: With A, ch 3. 1 dc in each sc to end of row. Join B. Turn.

4th row: With B, ch 1. 1 sc in each dc to end of row. Join MC. Turn.

First 2 rows of Stripe Pat are complete.

Cont in Stripe Pat, rep 3rd and 4th rows until work from beg measures approx 33" [84.5 cm], ending with 2 rows of MC. Fasten off.



MATERIALS

Bernat® Baby Blanket™ (10.5 oz/300 g; 220 yds/201 m)

Main Color (MC) White (04005) **1 ball or 215 yds/200 m**

Contrast A Cloudburst (04802) **1 ball or 105 yds/100 m**

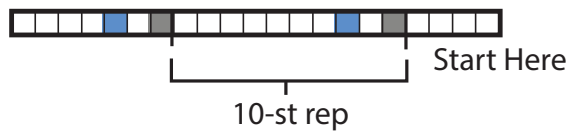
Contrast B Misty Cornflower (04805) **1 ball or 80 yds/75 m**

Size U.S. L/11 (8 mm) crochet hook **or size needed to obtain gauge.**

BERNAT® PLAID LOOK CROCHET BLANKET

With crochet hook, keeping yarn at WS, embroider chain st following Diagram:

With A, beg at 5th st at lower edge, chain vertically.



Key

□ = MC

■ = Chain st with A

■ = Chain st with B

Edging

1st rnd: (RS). Join MC with sl st to any corner. Ch 1. Work in sc around Blanket, having 3 sc in corners. Join with sl st to first sc.

2nd rnd: Ch 1. *Working from left to right, instead of from right to left, as usual,* work 1 reverse sc in each sc around. Join with sl st to first sc. Fasten off.
