MATERIALS

Bernat® Baby Blanket™ Frosting™ (10.5 oz/300 g; 220 yds/201 m)Main Color (MC) Cozy Rosie (61001)3 balls or 510 yds/465 m

Bernat[®] Baby Blanket[™] (10.5 oz/300 g; 220 yds/201 m)

Contrast A Vanilla (04008)

1 ball or 210 yds/191 m

Size U.S. N/15 (10 mm) Susan Bates[®] Silvalume[®] crochet hook **or size needed to obtain gauge.** Susan Bates[®] yarn needle. Small amount of stuffing for optional pompoms.

GAUGE

sc/ch-1 pattern.

INSTRUCTIONS

(See Diagram on page 2).

With MC, chain (ch) 76.

Turn. 75 stitches (sts).

Approximately (Approx) 38" x 43" [96.5 x 109 cm].

8 sts and 7 rows = 4" [10 cm] in

1st row: [Right Side (RS)]. 1 single

crochet (sc) in 2nd ch from hook.

*Ch 1. Skip next ch. 1 sc in next ch.

Repeat (Rep) from * to end of ch.

2nd row: Ch 1. 1 sc in first sc. *1 sc

in next ch-1 space (sp). Ch 1. Skip

next sc. Rep from * to last 2 sts. 1 sc

in next ch-1 sp. 1 sc in last sc. Turn.

3rd row: Ch 1. 1 sc in first sc. *Ch 1. Skip next sc. 1 sc in next ch-1 sp. Rep from * to last 2 sc. Ch 1. Skip next sc. 1 sc in last sc. Turn. **4th row:** As 2nd row. Break MC.

Establish Stripe Pat:

5th and 6th rows: With A, as 3rd and 4th rows. Break A. **7th to 10th rows:** With MC, as 3rd and 4th rows twice. Break MC Rep 5th to 10th rows for Stripe Pat until Blanket measures approx 43" [109 cm], ending on a 10th row of Stripe Pat. Fasten off.

Side edging: With RS facing, join MC with slip stitch (sl st) to bottom right corner. Ch 1. Work 1 row of sc evenly up side of Blanket. Fasten off. Rep for other side.



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Pompoms (make 4) With A, ch 9. 1st row: (RS). 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook. 1 sc in each ch to end of chain. Turn. 8 sc. 2nd to 10th rows: Ch 1. 1 sc in each sc to end of row. Turn. Fasten off at end of 10th row, leaving a long yarn tail. Thread yarn tail onto yarn needle and work running st around entire outer edge of piece. Gather up running stitches and fill pompom with stuffing. Fasten securely and sew one Pompom to each corner of Blanket.
