

## MATERIALS

Bernat ${ }^{\oplus}$ Blanket ${ }^{\text {Tm }} \mathbf{O}^{\prime}$ Go $^{\text {TM }}$ ( $10.5 \mathrm{oz} / 300 \mathrm{~g} ; 220 \mathrm{yds} / 201 \mathrm{~m}$ ) Milk and Honey (42005) $\mathbf{1 0}$ O'Go or approx 68 yds/ $62 \mathbf{m}$ per shade


Sizes U.S. $7(4.5 \mathrm{~mm})$ and U.S. K/10 $1 / 2(6.5 \mathrm{~mm})$ crochet hooks or size needed to obtain gauge. Yarn needle. Fiberfill stuffing. Approx $3 \mathrm{yds} / 2.5 \mathrm{~m}$ of black worsted weight yarn to embroider eyes. Approx $15 \mathrm{yds} / 14 \mathrm{~m}$ of pink worsted weight yarn for Cherry.

## MEASUREMENT

Approx 203/4" [52.5 cm] tall, excluding cherry.

## GAUGE

8 sc and 9 rows $=4$ " $[10 \mathrm{~cm}$ ] with larger hook.
$\mathbf{S c 2 t o g}=$ Draw up a loop in each of next 2 sc . Yoh and draw through all 3 loops on hook
SI st = Slip stitch
$\mathbf{S t}(\mathbf{s})=$ Stitch(es)
Tog = Together
Yoh = Yarn over hook

## INSTRUCTIONS

## Notes:

- To begin working with the O'Go format, carefully cut plastic tie where the ends of the O'Go meet.
- Pull tie to remove.
- For this pattern, colors can be easily separated by gently pulling apart and cutting at the color transition. Each color is ready to use. Follow color guide shown in Materials section (Contrast A, B and C). You may find it helpful to place each color section in its own resealable (zip lock) bag and label each bag $A, B$ and $C$.
- Join all rnds with sl st to first st.


## ICE CREAM TOY

Top Scoop: With B, ch 2.
1st rnd: 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook. Join. 6 sc
2nd rnd: Ch 1. 2 sc in each sc around. Join. 12 sc .
3rd rnd: Ch 1. *1 sc in next sc. 2 sc in next sc. Rep from * around. Join. 18 sc .
4th rnd: Ch 1. *1 sc in each of next 2 sc .2 sc in next sc. Rep from * around. Join. 24 sc.

5th rnd: Ch $1 .{ }^{*} 1$ sc in each of next 3 sc .2 sc in next sc. Rep from * around. Join. 30 sc.

6th rnd: Ch 1. *1 sc in each of next 4 sc .2 sc in next sc . Rep from * around. Join. 36 sc.

7th rnd: Ch 1. *1 sc in each of next 5 sc .2 sc in next sc. Rep from * around. Join. 42 sc.

8th to 15th rnds: Ch 1.1 sc in each sc around. Join.
16th rnd: Working in front loops only, *SI st in next sc. 3 hdc in next sc. Sl st in next sc. Rep from * around. Join.
17th rnd: Ch 1. Working in back loops only of 15 th rnd, *1 sc in each of next 5 sc. Sc2tog. Rep from * around. Break B. Join C. 36 sc.

Bottom Scoop: 18th rnd: With C, ch 1. Working in front loops only, 1 sc in each sc around. Join.
19th rnd: Ch $1 .{ }^{*} 1 \mathrm{sc}$ in each of next 5 sc .2 sc in next sc. Rep from * around. Join. 42 sc.

20th to 27th rnds: Ch 1.1 sc in each sc around. Join.
28th rnd: Working in front loops only, *SI st in next sc. 3 hdc in next sc. Sl st in next sc. Rep from * around. Join.
29th rnd: Ch 1. Working in back loops only of 27th rnd, *1 sc in each of next 5 sc . Sc2tog. Rep from * around. Break C. Join A. 36 sc.

Embroidery: With black yarn, embroider eyes using Satin St on Scoops as shown in photo.
With pink yarn, embroider blush lines below each eye using straight st, as shown in photo.


SATIN ST


STRAIGHT ST
Cone: 30th rnd: With A, ch 1. Working in front loops only, *1 sc in next sc. Ch 1. Rep from * around. Join.

31st rnd: Ch 1. Working in back loops only of 29th rnd, 1 sc in each sc around. Join.
32nd and 33rd rnds: Ch 1.1 sc in each sc around. Join.
34th rnd: Ch 1. *1 sc in each of next 4 sc. Sc2tog. Rep from * around. Join. 30 sc .
35th and 36th rnds: Ch 1.1 sc in each sc around. Join.
Stuff Scoops and Cone firmly.
37th rnd: Ch 1. ${ }^{*} 1 \mathrm{sc}$ in each of next 3 sc. Sc2tog. Rep from * around. Join. 24 sc .
38th and 39th rnds: Ch 1.1 sc in each sc around. Join.
40th rnd: Ch 1. *1 sc in each of next 2 sc. Sc2tog. Rep from * around. Join. 18 sc .
41 st and 42nd rnds: Ch 1.1 sc in each sc around. Join.
43rd rnd: Ch 1. *1 sc in next sc. Sc2tog. Rep from * around. Join. 12 sc .
44th and 45th rnds: Ch 1.1 sc in each sc around. Join.
Finish stuffing Cone firmly.
46th rnd: Ch 1. *Sc2tog. Rep from * around. Join. 6 sc.

47th and 48th rnds: Ch 1.1 sc in each sc around.
Fasten off, leaving long end. Drawn end tightly through rem sts.

## '̌arnspirations" <br> spark your inspiration!

Cherry: With smaller hook and pink yarn, ch 6.
1 st rnd: Working into horizontal "bump" at back of ch, sl st in 2nd ch from hook. Sl st in each of next 3 ch - Cherry Stem made. Working into front loop only, 6 sc in last ch. Hold Cherry Stem to front of work. Join last sc to first sc. 6 sc .
2nd rnd: Ch 1. 2 sc in each sc around. Join. 12 sc .
3rd rnd: Ch 1 . ( 1 sc in next sc. 2 sc in next sc) 6 times. Join. 18 sc.
4th rnd: Ch 1. (1 sc in each of next 2 sc .2 sc in next sc) 6 times. Join. 24 sc .
5th rnd: Ch 1. (1 sc in each of next 3 sc. 2 sc in next sc) 6 times. Join. 30 sc .
6th to 8th rnds: Ch 1.1 sc in each sc around. Join.
Fasten off, leaving long end. Stuff Cherry firmly. Using long end, sew Cherry onto Top Scoop, as shown in photo.
