## ABBREVIATIONS

## SIZES

**To fit chest measurement**

**2 yrs** 20-22" [51-56 cm]

**4 yrs** 22-24" [56-61 cm]

**6 yrs** 24-26" [61-66 cm]

**Finished measurements**

**2 yrs**

Approx 17½" [43 cm] wide x 26½"  
[66 cm] long

**4 yrs**

Approx 18¾" [47 cm] wide x 28½"  
[72.5 cm] long

**6 yrs**

Approx 20" [51 cm] wide x 30½"  
[77.5 cm] long

## GAUGE

9 sc and 12 rows = 4" [10 cm]

## INSTRUCTIONS

*The instructions are written for smallest size. If changes are necessary for larger sizes the instructions will be written **2** (4-6). Numbers for each size are shown in the same color throughout the pattern. When only one number is given in black, it applies to all sizes.*

**Note:** Ch 2 at beg of row **does not** count as st.

## MATERIALS

**Bernat® Pipsqueak™** (3.5 oz/100 g; 101 yds/92 m)

Sizes	2	4	6	yrs
Whitey White (59005)	4	4	5	balls
	364/333	390/356	416/380	yds/m

Size U.S. I/9 (5.5 mm) Susan Bates® Silvalume® crochet hook **or size needed to obtain gauge.** Susan Bates® stitch marker. 4 buttons 1" [2.5 cm] diameter

## PONCHO

Beg at lower front, ch **43 (45-47)**.

**1st row:** (RS). 1 hdc in 3rd ch from hook. 1 hdc in each ch to end of chain. Turn. **41 (43-45)** hdc.

**2nd row:** Ch 2. 1 hdc in each hdc to end of row. Turn.

Rep last row until work from beg measures **12 (13-14)" [30.5 (33-35.5) cm]**, ending on a WS row.

**Shape left neck: 1st row:** (RS). Ch 2. 1 hdc in each of next **17 (18-19)** hdc. Hdc2tog (neck edge). **Turn.** Leave rem sts unworked. **18 (19-20)** sts.

**2nd row:** Ch 2. Hdc2tog. 1 hdc in each hdc to end of row. Turn.

**3rd row:** Ch 2. 1 hdc in each hdc to last 2 sts. Hdc2tog. Turn.

Rep last 2 rows twice more. **12 (13-14)** sts.

Work 1 row even.

**Do not** fasten off.

**Shape right neck: 1st row:** (RS). Skip next center front 3 hdc. Join 2nd ball of yarn with sl st to next st. Ch 2 (**does not** count as st). Hdc2tog over same st as sl st and next st. 1 hdc in each hdc to end of row. Turn.

**2nd row:** Ch 2. 1 hdc in each hdc to last 2 sts. Hdc2tog. Turn.

**3rd row:** Ch 2. Hdc2tog. 1 hdc in each hdc to end of row. Turn.

Rep last 2 rows twice more. **12 (13-14)** sts.

Work 1 row even.

Fasten off.

**Back: Joining row:** (RS). Using yarn from left side, ch 2. 1 hdc in each of next **12 (13-14)** hdc from left shoulder. Ch 17 for back neck. 1 hdc in each of next **12 (13-14)** hdc from right shoulder. Turn. PM at end of row.

**Next row:** Ch 2. 1 hdc in each of next **12 (13-14)** hdc. 1 hdc in each of next 17 ch. 1 hdc in each of next **12 (13-14)** hdc. Turn. **41 (43-45)** sts.

Cont even until work from marker measures same length as Front to shoulder, ending on a WS row. Fasten off.

## HOOD

PM on each side of unworked 3 hdc at center front neck.

**1st row:** (RS). Join yarn with sl st at right front marker. Ch 1. Work **37 (37-41)** sc around neck edge to opposite marker. Turn.

**2nd row:** Ch 2. 1 hdc in first sc. 1 hdc in each of next **18 (18-20)** sc. PM on last hdc worked for center back. 1 hdc in each of next **18 (18-20)** sc. Turn.

## Shape back of Hood

**1st row:** (RS). Ch 2. 1 hdc in each of first **17 (17-19)** hdc. 2 hdc in next hdc. 1 hdc in next (marked) hdc. PM on last hdc worked for center back. 2 hdc in next hdc. 1 hdc in each of last **17 (17-19)** hdc. Turn. **39 (39-43)** hdc.

**2nd to 4th rows:** Ch 2. 1 hdc in each hdc to marked hdc. 1 hdc in next (marked) hdc. PM on last hdc worked for center back. 1 hdc in each hdc to end of row. Turn.

**5th row:** Ch 2. 1 hdc in each of first **18 (18-20)** hdc. 2 hdc in next hdc. 1 hdc in next (marked) hdc. PM on last hdc worked for center back. 2 hdc in next hdc. 1 hdc in each of last **18 (18-20)** hdc. Turn. **43 (43-47)** sts.

**6th to 8th rows:** As 2nd row.

**9th row:** Ch 2. 1 hdc in each of first **19 (19-21)** hdc. 2 hdc in next hdc. 1 hdc in next (marked) hdc. PM on last hdc worked for center back. 2 hdc in next hdc. 1 hdc in each of last **19 (19-21)** hdc. Turn. **43 (43-47)** sts.

**10th to 12th rows:** As 2nd row.

Cont even in hdc until Hood measures **9 (9½-10)" [23 (24-25.5) cm]** from neck edge, ending on a WS row. Fasten off. Fold Hood in half and sew top Hood seam.

## Ears (make 2)

Ch 4.

**1st rnd:** 11 dc in 4th ch from hook. Join with sl st to top of ch 3. 12 dc.

**2nd rnd:** Ch 3. 1 dc in same sp as last sl st. 2 dc in each dc around. Join with sl st to top of ch 3. 24 dc. Fold Ear in half.

**Joining row:** Ch 1. *Working through both thicknesses*, 2 sc in first dc. (1 sc in each of next 2 dc. 2 sc in next dc) 3 times. 1 sc in each of last 2 dc. Turn. 16 sc.

**Next row:** Ch 1. 1 sc in each sc to end of row. Fasten off.

Sew Ears in position as shown in photo.

Sew 2 buttons through all thicknesses on each side to create armholes.
