Sizes G/6 ( 4.00 mm ), H/8 ( 5.00 mm ) and K/10½ ( 6.50 mm ) crochet hooks or sizes needed for gauge. 5 (5-6) buttons for Girl's Cardigan. 4 buttons for Doll's Cardigan.

## Gauge

Cardigan: 12 dc and 8 rows $=4$ ins [ 10 cm ] with size $\mathrm{H} / 8$ hook.
Hat: 14 dc and 9 rows $=4$ ins [10 cm ] with size G/6 hook.

## Stitch Glossary

$\mathbf{C L}=$ (Yoh. Draw up a loop in next st) 3 times. Yoh and draw through all 7 loops on hook.

## Instructions

The instructions are written for smallest size. If changes are necessary for larger sizes, the instructions will be written thus ().

## Girl's Cardigan

Note: Cardigan is worked sideways.

## BACK

With size H/8 hook, ch 36 (4246).

1st row: (WS). 1 dc in 4th ch from hook (counts as first dc). 1 dc in each ch to end of ch. Turn. 34 (40-44) sts.
2nd row: Ch 3 (counts as first dc). Miss first dc. 1 dc in each dc to end of row. Turn.
Rep last row until work from beg measures 13 (14-15) ins [33 $(35.5-38) \mathrm{cm}]$. Fasten off.

## RIGHT FRONT

**With size $\mathrm{K} / 10 ½$ hook, ch 36 (42-46) loosely. (Front edge).
1st row: With size $\mathrm{H} / 8$ hook, 1 dc in 4th ch from hook. 1 dc in each of next 18 (23-26) ch. 1 hdc in next ch. 1 sc in each of next 2 (2-3) ch. Turn. Leave rem 11 (1212) ch unworked. 23 (28-32) sts. 2nd row: Ch 1.1 sc in each of first 2 (2-3) sc. 1 hdc in next st. 1 dc in each st to end of row. Turn. 3rd row: Ch 3. Miss first dc. 1 dc in each of next 22 (27-31) sts. 1 dc in each of next 3 ch of foundation ch. 1 hdc in next ch. 1 sc in each of next 2 ch . Turn. Leave rem 5 (6-6) ch unworked. 29 (3438) sts.

4th row: Ch 1. 1 sc in each of first 2 sc. 1 hdc in next st. 1 dc in each st to end of row. Turn.
5th row: Ch 3 . Miss first dc. 1 dc in each of next $28(33-37)$ sts. 1 dc in each of next 3 ch of foundation ch. 1 hdc in next ch. 1 sc in each of next 1 (2-2) ch. Turn. 34 (40-44) sts.
6th row: Ch 1.1 sc in each st to end of row.** Turn.
7th row: (WS). Ch 5. CL in first sc. Ch 1 . Miss next 2 sc. ${ }^{*}(1 \mathrm{dc}$. Ch 2. CL) all in next sc. Ch 1. Miss next 2 sc. Rep from * to last sc. 1 dc in last sc. Turn.

8th row: Ch 2. *2 sc in next ch-2 sp. Working behind previous row, 1 dc in next sc of 6th row.

Rep from * to turning ch-5. 2 sc in ch-5. 1 sc in 3 rd ch of turning ch-5. Turn.
9th row: Ch 3. Miss first st. 1 dc in each st to end of row. 1 dc in top of turning ch-2. Turn.
10th row: Ch 1.1 sc in each dc to end of row. Turn.
Rep 7th to 10th rows once more. Next row: As 9th row.

Size 6 only: Next row: Ch 3. Miss first st. 1 dc in each st to end of row.

All Sizes: Fasten off. ${ }^{* * *}$

## LEFT FRONT

Rep from ${ }^{* *}$ to ${ }^{* *}$ as given for Right Front. Fasten off. Do not

## turn.

Rejoin yarn with ss to first sc of last row and proceed as follows:
Next row: (WS). Ch 5. CL in same sc as last ss. Ch 1. Miss next 2 sc. *(1 dc. Ch 2. CL) all in next sc. Ch 1 . Miss next 2 sc. Rep from * to last sc. 1 dc in last sc. Turn. Rep from ${ }^{* * *}$ to ${ }^{* * *}$ as given for Right Front.

## SLEEVES

With size H/8 hook, ch 23 (2525).

1st row: 1 dc in 4th ch from hook. 1 dc in each ch to end of ch. Turn. 21 (23-23) sts.
2nd row: Ch 3.1 dc in first dc. 1
dc in each dc to last dc. 2 dc in last dc. Turn. 23 (25-25) sts.
3rd row: Ch 3. Miss first dc. 1 dc in each dc to end of row. Turn.
Rep 2nd and 3rd rows 5 (8-9) times more, then 2 nd row $2(\mathbf{0}-0$ ) times. 37 (41-43) sts. Fasten off.

Sleeve Ribbing (make 2 alike)
With size H/8 hook, ch 5 .
${ }^{* * * *} 1$ st row: 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook. 1 sc in each ch to end of ch. Turn.
2nd row: Ch 1.1 sc in back loop only of each sc to end of row. Turn.****
Rep 2nd row until work from beg measures $7\left(7^{1 / 2}-7^{1 / 2}\right)$ ins $[18$ ( $\mathbf{1 9 -}$ 19) cm$]$, when slightly stretched. Fasten off.

Body Ribbing (make 1)
With size H/8 hook, ch 7.
Rep from ${ }^{* * * *}$ to ${ }^{* * * *}$ as given for Sleeve Ribbing.
Rep 2nd row until work from beg measures 25 (27-29) ins [63.5 $(68.5-73.5) \mathrm{cm}]$, when slightly stretched. Fasten off.

Band: With size H/8 hook, ch 110 (123-136).
1st row: (RS). 1 sc in 2 nd ch from hook. 1 sc in each ch to end of ch. Turn. 109 (121-135) sts. 2nd row: Ch 1.1 sc in each of next 82 (91-98) sc. [Ch 1 . Miss next sc. 1 sc in each of next 5 (6-6) sc] 4 (4-
5) times. Ch 1 . Miss next sc. 1 sc in each of next 3 (2-2) sc. Turn.
3rd row: Ch 1.1 sc in each sc and ch-1 sp to end of row. Turn.
4th row: Ch 1.1 sc in each sc to end of row. Fasten off.

## FINISHING

Sew shoulder seams. Place markers $6(61 / 2-7)$ ins [15 ( $\mathbf{1 6 . 5 - 1 8 ) ~ c m}]$ down from shoulder seams on Fronts and Back of Cardigan. Sew in Sleeves between markers. Sew ribbing onto Sleeves. Sew Sleeve and side seams. Sew ribbing onto Body. Sew Band onto Cardigan. Sew buttons to correspond to buttonholes.

## Girl's Cap

With size G/6 hook, ch 4. Ss to first ch to form a ring.
1st rnd: Ch 3 (counts as first dc). 11 dc in ring. Ss to top of ch 3.12 dc .
2nd rnd: Ch 3.1 dc in same sp as last ss. 2 dc in each dc around. Ss to top of ch 3.24 dc .
3rd rnd: Ch 3.1 dc in same sp as last ss. ${ }^{*} 1 \mathrm{dc}$ in next dc. 2 dc in next dc. Rep from * to last dc. 1 dc in last dc. Ss to top of ch 3.36 dc . 4th rnd: Ch 3.1 dc in same sp as last ss. ${ }^{*} 1 \mathrm{dc}$ in each of next 2 dc . 2 dc in next dc. Rep from * to last 2 dc .1 dc in each of last 2 dc . Ss to top of ch 3.48 dc .
5th rnd: Ch 3.1 dc in same sp as
last ss. ${ }^{*} 1 \mathrm{dc}$ in each of next 3 dc . 2 dc in next dc. Rep from * to last 3 dc .1 dc in each of last 3 dc . Ss to top of ch 3.60 dc .
6th rnd: Ch 3.1 dc in same sp as last ss. ${ }^{*} 1 \mathrm{dc}$ in each of next 9 dc . 2 dc in next dc. Rep from * to last 9 dc .1 dc in each of last $9 \mathrm{dc} . \mathrm{Ss}$ to top of ch 3.66 dc .
7th rnd: Ch 3. Miss first dc (where last ss was worked). 1 dc in next dc and each dc around. Ss to top of ch 3 .
8th rnd: Ch 1.1 sc in same sp as last ss. 1 sc in each dc around. Ss in first sc.
9th rnd: Ch 5. CL in same st as last ss. Ch 1 . Miss next 2 sc. ${ }^{*}(1$ dc. Ch 2. CL) all in next st. Ch 1. Miss next 2 sc. Rep from * to end of rnd. Ss in 3rd ch of ch-5.
10th rnd: Ch 1.2 sc in first ch-2 sp. Working behind previous rnd, 1 dc in next sc of 8th rnd. *2 sc in next ch-2 sp. Working behind previous rnd, 1 dc in next sc of 8th rnd. Rep from * to end of rnd. Ss in first sc.
11th rnd: Ch 3. Miss first sc (where last ss was worked). 1 dc in next sc and each st around. Ss to top of ch 3 .
Rep 8th to 11th rnds once more, then 8th rnd once. Fasten off.

## Doll's Cardigan

Note: Cardigan is worked sideways.

## BACK

With size H/8 hook, ch 24.
1st row: (RS). 1 dc in 4th ch from hook (counts as first dc). 1 dc in each ch to end of ch. Turn. 22 sts.
2nd row: Ch 3 (counts as first dc). Miss first dc. 1 dc in each dc to end of row. Turn.
Rep last row until work from beg measures $61 / 2$ ins $[16.5 \mathrm{~cm}]$. Fasten off.

FRONTS (make 2 alike)
With size H/8 hook, ch 24 loosely. 1st row: ( RS ). 1 dc in 4 th ch from hook. 1 dc in each of next 20 ch. 22 sts.
2nd row: Ch 1.1 sc in each dc to end of row. Turn.
3rd row: Ch 1.1 sc in each sc to end of row. Turn.
4th row: Ch 5. CL in first sc. Ch 1. Miss next 2 sc. ${ }^{*}(1 \mathrm{dc}$. Ch 2. CL) all in next sc. Ch 1. Miss next 2 sc . Rep from * to last sc. 1 dc in last sc. Turn.
5th row: Ch $2 .{ }^{*} 2$ sc in next ch-2 sp. Working behind previous row, 1 dc in next sc of 3rd row. Rep from * to turning ch- 5.2 sc in ch5.1 sc in 3 rd ch of turning ch-5. Turn.
6th row: Ch 3. Miss first st. 1 dc in each st to end of row. 1 dc in
top of turning ch-2. Turn.
7th row: Ch 1.1 sc in each dc to end of row. Turn.
8th and 9th rows: Ch 3. Miss first st. 1 dc in each st to end of row. Turn.
Fasten off at end of 9th row.

## SLEEVES

With size H/8 hook, ch 15 .
1st row: 1 sc in 2 nd ch from hook. 1 sc in each ch to end of ch. Turn. 14 sts.
2nd row: Ch 1.1 sc in each sc to end of row. Turn.
3rd row: Ch 3. Miss first st. 1 dc in each st to end of row. Turn.
4th row: Ch 3.1 dc in first dc. 1 dc in each dc to last dc. 2 dc in last dc. Turn.
Rep 3rd and 4th rows twice more. 20 sts. Fasten off.

## FINISHING

Place markers on top edge of Back, $21 / 2$ ins $[6 \mathrm{~cm}$ ] in from left and right sides. Sew Fronts to Back along shoulders to markers. Place markers $31 / 4$ ins $[8.5 \mathrm{~cm}$ ] down from shoulder seams on Fronts and Back. Sew in Sleeves between markers. Sew side and sleeve seams.

Front, Neck and Bottom Edging: Join yarn with ss to bottom corner of Right Front. With size H/8 hook, ch 1. Work 21 sc
up right front, 3 sc in corner st, 24 sc around neck edge, 3 sc in corner st, and 21 sc down Left Front. Ch 1. Work 45 sc along bottom edge.
2nd row: (Bottom edge only). Ch 1.1 sc in each of next 45 sc . Fasten off.

Sew on buttons as illustrated.
Note: Spaces between dc posts create buttonholes.

## Doll's Cap

With size G/6 hook, ch 4. Ss to first ch to form a ring.

1st rnd: Ch 3 (counts as first dc). 11 dc in ring. 12 dc . Ss to top of ch 3.
2nd rnd: Ch 3.1 dc in same sp as last ss. 2 dc in each dc around. 24 dc. Ss to top of ch 3 .

3rd rnd: Ch 3.1 dc in same sp as last ss. ${ }^{*} 1 \mathrm{dc}$ in next dc. 2 dc in next dc. Rep from * around to last dc. 1 dc in last dc. 36 dc . Ss to top of ch 3 .
4th to 7th rnds: Ch 3. Miss first dc (where last ss was worked). 1 dc in next dc and each dc around. Ss to top of ch 3 .
8th rnd: Ch 1. 1 sc in each dc around. Ss in first sc. Fasten off.

## Pattern Ratings

Easy Means an easy knit or crochet. This includes knit and purl stitches with some basic increasing and decreasing.

Intermediate Means an average knit or crochet. These require some specialized knowledge, such as color block, fair isle or aran techniques. They may also require the ability to keep continuity of simple pattern stitches during shaping.

Advanced Means a challenge knit or crochet. These will require the ability to keep continuity of pattern stitches during shaping and may combine several different techniques.
