WHAT YOU'LL NEED



SHOP KIT

GAUGE

7 <u>single crochet (</u>sc) and 8 rows = 4" [10 cm]



YARN

Bernat[®] Blanket[™]
 (10.5 oz/300 g; 220 yds/201 m)

COLORS

Quantity

Lilac Bush (10185)
 4 balls or 870 yds/790 m

TOOLS

- Size U.S. L/11 (8 mm) Susan Bates[®]
 Silvalume[®] crochet hook or size
 needed to obtain gauge.
- Susan Bates[®] yarn needle.
- Tape measure.

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INSTRUCTIONS

USING THIS GUIDE

Click on the underlined words throughout the pattern to access our library of helpful tools.

NOTES

- Chain (ch) 3 at beginning (beg) of row counts as double crochet (dc).
- Ch 5 at beg of row counts as dc and skipped 2 ch.

ABBREVIATIONS

Approx =Pat = PatternApproximatelyRem = RemainingBeg = BeginningRep = RepeatCh = Chain(s)RS = Right sideCont = Continue(ity)Sc = Single crochetDc = Double crochetSp(s) = Space(s)

St(s) = Stitch(es) Tog = Together WS = Wrong side Yoh = Yarn over hook


MEASUREMENTS

Approximately (approx) 56" [142 cm] x 58" [147.5 cm].

Make a slip knot and place it on your hook.

<u>Slip knot</u>

Make a loop with yarn and fold it on itself to make a pretzel shape.



Then draw through to make slip knot.





ABBREVIATIONS


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INSTRUCTIONS

Chain (Ch) 101.

Chain *Yarn over hook (Yoh), draw through loop -1 chain made.




Repeat (rep) from 100 times more – 101 chains made.*

1st row: (1 dc. Ch 1. 1 dc) in 5th ch from hook (counts as dc. Skip 2 ch). *Skip next 2 ch. (1 dc. Ch 1. 1 dc) in next ch. Repeat (Rep) from * to last 3 ch. Skip next 2 ch. 1 dc in last ch. Turn.

See diagram on page 5.

Double crochet Yoh and insert hook into 5th ch from hook.



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INSTRUCTIONS


Yoh and draw through first 2 loops on hook.

Yoh and draw through remaining (rem) loops on hook – 1 dc made.

ABBREVIATIONS


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Ch 1, then rep above steps in same st – (1 dc. Ch 1. 1 dc) made.

2nd row: Ch 3 (counts as dc). *(1 dc. Ch 1. 1 dc) in next ch-1 space (sp). Rep from * to end of row. 1 dc in last dc. Turn.



Rep last row for pattern (pat) until work from beginning (beg) measures approx 60" [152.5 cm]. **Do not** fasten off. Proceed as follows for side edging:



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Pat = Pattern **Rem** = Remaining **Rep** = Repeat **RS** = Right side

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INSTRUCTIONS


Side Edging

With RS facing, work 104 single crochet (sc) evenly down side edge. Fasten off.

Single crochet Insert hook into side of first st.

Yoh and draw up a loop. Yoh and draw through both loops on hook -1 sc made.





Join yarn with **<u>slip stitch</u>** (sl st) in bottom right corner and work 104 sc evenly up opposite side of Blanket. Fasten off.
