MATERIALS

Bernat[®] Baby Blanket Tiny™ (3.5 oz/100 g; 316 yds/288 m)	
Main Color (MC) Tea Rose (14005)	1 ball
Contrast A Polar Bear (14003)	1 ball
Contrast B Sunflower (14007)	1 ball
Contrast C Clear Sky (14009)	1 ball

Size U.S. G/6 (4 mm) crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge.

CROCHET I SKILL LEVEL: INTERMEDIATE

ABBREVIATIONS

Approx = Approximately
Ch = Chain(s)
Cont = Continue(ity)
Dc = Double crochet

MEASUREMENT

Approx 32" [81.5 cm] square.

GAUGE

15 sc and 16 rows = 4" [10 cm].

INSTRUCTIONS

Note: When working from chart, wind small balls of the colors to be used, one for each separate area of color in the design. Start new colors at appropriate point. To change color, work to last 2 loops on hook. Draw loop of next color through 2 loops on hook to complete st and proceed in next color.

With MC, ch 6. See chart on page 2.

1st row: (RS). 1 dc in 4th ch from hook. 1 dc in each of last 2 ch. Turn.

2nd row: Ch 6. 1 dc in 4th ch from hook. 1 dc in each of next 2 ch. Sl st to next ch-3 sp. Ch 3. 3 dc in same ch-3 sp. Turn.

3rd row: Ch 6. 1 dc in 4th ch from hook. 1 dc in each of next 2 ch. *SI st to next ch-3 sp. Ch 3. 3 dc in same sp as last sl st. Rep from * to end of row. Turn.

First 3 rows of chart are complete. Cont in chart, rep last row until 39th row of chart is complete. 39 blocks.



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Keeping cont of Chart, proceed as follows:

Next row: SI st in first 3 dc. *SI st in next ch-3 sp. Ch 3. 3 dc in same sp as last sl st. Rep from * to last ch-3 sp. SI st to last ch-3 sp. **Turn**. Keeping cont of Chart, rep last row until 1 block rem. Fasten off.

Edging

With RS facing, join C with sl st between any 2 blocks along edge.

1st rnd: Ch 1. 1 sc in same sp as sl st. Ch 3. *1 sc between next 2 blocks. Ch 3. Rep from * around, working (1 sc. Ch 3. 1 sc) in each corner. Join with sl st to first sc. **2nd rnd:** Sl st in next ch-3 sp. Ch 3 (counts as dc). 2 dc in same sp as last sl st. *3 dc in next ch-3 sp. Rep from * around, working (3 dc. Ch 1. 3 dc) in corner ch-3 sp. Join with sl st to top of ch-3.

3rd rnd: SI st in each of next 2 dc and sp between 2 groups of 3 dc. Ch 1. 1 sc in same sp as last sl st. *Ch 3. 1 sc in sp between next 2 groups of 3 dc. Rep from * around, working (1 sc. Ch 3. 1 sc) in corner ch-1 sps. Join with sl st to first sc.

4th and 5th rnds: As 2nd and 3rd rnds. Join A at end of last rnd. **6th rnd:** With A, sl st in next ch-3 sp. Ch 1. 3 sc in same sp as last sl st. *3 sc in next ch-3 sp. Rep from * around, working (3 sc. Ch 1. 3 sc) in corner ch-3 sps. Join with sl st to first sc. Fasten off.
