## MATERIALS

Bernat ${ }^{\oplus}$ Super Value ${ }^{\text {TM }}$ (Ombres: $142 \mathrm{~g} / 5$ oz; $232 \mathrm{~m} / 254 \mathrm{yds}$ ) Main Color (MC) Renegade ombre (28483) 4 balls
Bernat ${ }^{\oplus}$ Super Value ${ }^{\text {Tm }}$ (Solids: $197 \mathrm{~g} / 7 \mathrm{oz} ; 402 \mathrm{~m} / 440 \mathrm{yds}$ )
Contrast A DK Heather (53022) 1 ball
Contrast B Taupe (53012) 1 ball
Contrast C Chocolate (53013) $\mathbf{1}$ ball
Size 5.5 mm (U.S. I/9) crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge.

## MEASUREMENTS

Approx 49"x61" [124.5 cm x 155 cm ].

## GAUGE

14 sc and 16 rows $=4$ " $[10 \mathrm{~cm}$ ]. Square $=12$ " $[30.5 \mathrm{~cm}]$.

## INSTRUCTIONS

Square (make 20)
With MC, ch 2.
1st row: (RS). 3 sc in 2nd ch from hook. Turn.
2nd row: Ch 1.1 sc in first sc. 3 sc in next sc. 1 sc in last sc. Turn. 5 sc . 3rd row: Ch 1.1 sc in each of first 2 sc .3 sc in next sc. 1 sc in each of last 2 sc . Turn. 7 sc .
4th row: Ch 1.1 sc in each of first 3 sc .3 sc in next sc. 1 sc in each of last 3 sc . Turn. 9 sc .
5th row: Ch 1.1 sc in each of first 4 sc .3 sc in next sc. 1 sc in each of last 4 sc . Turn. 11 sc .
Cont in same manner, having 2 sc more in corner of every row until 17 rows are worked. 35 sc . Break MC.

Join A and work 7 rows in pat as established. Break A. 49 sc.
Join $B$ and work 6 rows in pat as established. Break B. 61 sc.
Join $C$ and work 6 rows in pat as established. Fasten off. 73 sc .

## FINISHING

Join Squares into 4 strips, having 5 Squares in each strip. Join strips tog.
Edging: 1 st rnd: With RS of work facing, join MC with sl st in any corner st of Afghan. Ch 1.3 sc in same sp as sl st. Work in sc around, having 3 sc in corners. Join with sl st to first sc.

2nd rnd: Working from left to right instead of right to left as usual, work 1 reverse sc in each sc around. Join with sl st to first sc. Fasten off.
