#### **MATERIALS**

**Bernat**® **Blanket**™ (10.5 oz/300 g; 220 yds/201 m) Main Color (MC) Vintage White (10006) 3 balls Contrast A Light Teal (10734) 1 ball **Contrast B** Teal Dreams (10736) 2 balls Contrast C Dark Gray (10044) 2 balls

Size U.S. L/11 (8 mm) crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge.









CROCHET I SKILL LEVEL: INTERMEDIATE

#### **ABBREVIATIONS**

**Approx** = Approximate(ly)

Ch = Chain(s)

**Dc** = Double crochet

**Hdc** = Half double crochet

**Rep** = Repeat

Rnd(s) = Round(s)

**Sc** = Single crochet

**SI st** = Slip stitch

Sp(s) = Space(s)

**St(s)** = Stitch(es)

#### **MEASUREMENTS**

Approx 65" [165 cm] square.

## **GAUGE**

7 sc and 8 rows = 4'' [10 cm]. Motif = Approx 20" [51 cm] square.

## **INSTRUCTIONS**

#### MOTIF

With MC, ch 6. Join with sl st to first ch to form ring. See diagram on page 3.

1st rnd: Ch 1. 16 sc in ring. Join with sl st to first sc.

**2nd rnd:** Ch 1. 1 sc in same sp as sl st. Ch 5. 1 sc in next sc. \*1 sc in next sc. Ch 5. 1 sc in next sc. Rep from \* around. Join with sl st to first sc. (8 ch-5 sps).

3rd rnd: Ch 1. \*(1 sc. Ch 3. 1 dc. Ch 3. 1 sc) all into next ch-5 sp. Ch 2. Rep from \* around. Join with sl st to first sc.

4th rnd: Ch 1. \*3 sc in next ch-3 sp. Ch 2. 3 sc in next ch-3 sp. 1 sc in next ch-2 sp. Rep from \* around. Join with sl st to first sc.



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**5th rnd:** Ch 6 (counts as dc and ch 3). \*2 sc in next ch-2 sp. Ch 3. Skip next 3 sc. 1 dc in next sc (between two petals). Ch 3. Rep from \* around, ending with "Ch 3. Skip next 3 sc." Join with sl st to 3rd ch of ch 6.

Proceed in Jacob's Ladder pat as follows:

6th rnd: Ch 1. 4 sc in next ch-3 sp. Skip next 2 sc. 4 sc in next ch-3 sp. \*(2 sc. 1 hdc. 1 dc) in next ch-3 sp. 2 dc in next sc. Ch 10. SI st in first ch to form loop. 2 dc in next sc – corner made. (1 dc. 1 hdc. 2 sc) in next ch-3 sp. 4 sc in next ch-3 sp. Skip next 2 sc. 4 sc in next ch-3 sp. Rep from \* around, ending with "(1 dc. 1 hdc. 2 sc) in last ch-3 sp". Join with sI st to first sc. Break MC. 20 sts per side

7th rnd: Join A with sl st to first dc after any ch-10 sp. Ch 3 (counts as dc). \*1 dc in each st to next ch-10 sp. Ch 10. Skip next ch-10 sp. Rep from \* around, ending with "Ch 10." Join with sl st to top of ch 3. Break A. 20 sts per side

8th rnd: Join B with sl st to first dc after ch-10 sp. Ch 3 (counts as dc). 1 dc in same sp as sl st (counts as 2 dc). \*1 dc in each dc to last dc before ch-10 sp. 2 dc in next dc. Ch 10. Skip next ch-10 sp. 2 dc in next dc. Rep from \* around, ending with "Ch 10." Join with sl st to top of ch 3. Break B. 20 sts per side

**9th rnd:** With C, as 8th rnd. **Do not** fasten off. 24 sts per side

Create Jacob's Ladder by chaining loops as follows:

Pick up ch-10 loop from 7th rnd and pull through ch-10 loop of 6th rnd.

Pick up ch-10 loop from 8th rnd and pull through ch-10 loop of 7th rnd.

Pick up ch-10 loop from 9th rnd and pull through ch-10 loop of 8th rnd.

**10th rnd:** With C, ch 3 (counts as dc). 1 dc in same sp as sl st (counts as 2 dc). \*1 dc in each dc to last dc before corner. 2 dc in next dc. (Ch 1. 3 sc) in corner sp. Ch 1 – corner made. 2 dc in next dc. Rep from \* around. Join with sl st to top of ch 3. Fasten off. 26 sts per side

#### Edging First Motif

1st rnd: Join MC with sl st to center sc of any corner. Ch 1. 3 sc in same st as sl st. \*1 sc in next st. 1 sc in next ch-1 sp. 1 sc in each st to next center sc of corner. 3 sc in center sc. Rep from \* around. Join with sl st to first sc.

2nd rnd: SI st in next sc (center sc of corner). Ch 1. (1 sc. Ch 3. 1 sc) in same sp as last sl st. \*(Ch 3. Skip next sc. 1 sc in next sc) 8 times. 1 sc in next sc. (Ch 3. Skip next sc. 1 sc in next sc) 8 times. Ch 3. Skip next sc. (1 sc. Ch 3. 1 sc) in next corner sc. Rep from \* around. Join with sl st to first sc. Fasten off.

Make 8 more Motifs joining them as you go into Afghan (3 groups of 3) as follows:

#### **Joining 2 Motifs**

**1st rnd:** Work as given for Edging of First Motif.

**2nd rnd:** SI st in next sc (center sc of corner). Ch 1. (1 sc. Ch 3. 1 sc) in same st as last sl st. \*(Ch 3. Skip next sc. 1 sc in next sc) 8 times. 1 sc in next sc.\* (Ch 1. SI st to ch-3 sp of adjoining motif. Ch 1. Skip next sc.

1 sc in next sc) 8 times. 1 sc in next sc. Rep from \* to \* twice more. Join with sl st to first sc.

### **Joining 3 Motifs**

**1st rnd:** Work as given for Edging of First Motif.

2nd rnd: SI st in next sc (center sc of corner). Ch 1. (1 sc. Ch 3. 1 sc) in same st as last sl st. \*(Ch 3. Skip next sc. 1 sc in next sc) 8 times. 1 sc in next sc.\* (Ch 1. SI st to ch-3 sp of first adjoining motif. Ch 1. Skip next sc. 1 sc in next sc) 8 times. 1 sc in next sc. (Ch 1. SI st to ch-3 sp of second adjoining motif. Ch 1. Skip next sc. 1 sc in next sc) 8 times. 1 sc in next sc. 1 sc in next sc) 8 times. 1 sc in next sc. Rep from \* to \* once more. Join with sl st to first sc.

## **Afghan Edging**

**1st rnd:** Join C with sl st to any ch-3 sp of Motif edging. Ch 1. 2 sc in same sp as sl st. Work 2 sc in each ch-2 sp around, having 3 sc in corner sc. Join with sl st to first sc. Break C.



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
**2nd rnd:** Join B with sl st to any corner sc. Ch 3 (counts as dc). 4 dc in same sp as sl st. Work 1 dc in each sc around, having 5 dc in each corner sc. Join with sl st to top of ch 3. Break B.

**3rd rnd:** Join A with sl st to any corner dc. Ch 3 (counts as dc). 2 dc in same sp as sl st. 1 dc in each dc around, having 3 dc in each corner dc. Join with sl st to top of ch 3. Break A.

**4th rnd:** With MC as 3rd rnd. Break MC.

**5th rnd:** Join C with sl st to any corner dc. Ch 1. 3 sc in same sp as sl st. 1 sc in each dc around, having 3 sc in each corner dc. Join with sl st to top of ch 3. Fasten off.
