



MATERIALS

Bernat® Colorwhirl™ (8.8 oz/250 g; 77 yds/70 m)

Contrast A Hedgerow (31015) **2 balls**

Contrast B Surfer (31009) **2 balls**

Contrast C Lido (31010) **3 balls**

Contrast D Violet Dreams (31013) **2 balls**

Contrast E Heather (31014) **2 balls**

Size U.S. Q (16 mm) crochet hook **or size needed to obtain gauge.**

 CROCHET | SKILL LEVEL: **EASY**

ABBREVIATIONS

Approx = Approximately

Ch = Chain(s)

Cont = Continue(ity)

Dc = Double crochet

Dc2(3-5)tog = (Yoh and draw up a loop in indicated space. Yoh and draw through 2 loops on hook) 2 (3-5) times. Yoh and draw through all loops on hook.

Pat = Pattern

Rep = Repeat

RS = Right side

Sts = Stitches

Tog = Together

Yoh = Yarn over hook

MEASUREMENTS

Approx 50" x 59½" [127 x 151 cm].

GAUGE

5 dc and 2½ rows = 4" [10 cm].

INSTRUCTIONS

Note: To join new color, work to last loops on hook of first color. Yoh with new color, draw through loops and proceed with new color.

Stripe Pat

2 rows A. 2 rows B. 2 rows C.

2 rows D. 2 rows E. 6 rows C.

2 rows E. 2 rows D. 2 rows C.

2 rows B. 2 rows A.

These 26 rows form Stripe Pat.

With A, ch 83. (Foundation ch multiple of 16 ch + 3). See diagram on page 2.

1st row: (RS). Dc2tog over 4th and 5th ch from hook (counts as Dc3tog). 1 dc in each of next 5 ch. 5 dc in next ch. 1 dc in each of next 5 ch. *Dc5tog. 1 dc in each of next 5 ch. 5 dc in next ch. 1 dc in each of next 5 ch. Rep from * to last 3 ch. Dc3tog. Turn.

From this point on, work all sts into back loop only.

2nd row: Ch 3 (counts as dc). Dc2tog (counts as dc3tog). Ch 1. Skip next dc. (1 dc in next dc. Ch 1. Skip next dc) twice. (1 dc. Ch 1. 1 dc. Ch 1. 1 dc) all in next dc. Ch 1. Skip next dc. (1 dc. Ch 1. Skip next dc) twice. *Dc3tog, drawing

up loops in first, third and fifth dc of next 5 dc. Ch 1. Skip next dc. (1 dc in next dc. Ch 1. Skip next dc) twice. (1 dc. Ch 1. 1 dc. Ch 1. 1 dc) all in next dc. Ch 1. Skip next dc. (1 dc in next dc. Ch 1. Skip next dc) twice. Rep from * to last 3 dc. Dc3tog over last 3 sts. Break A, join B. Turn.

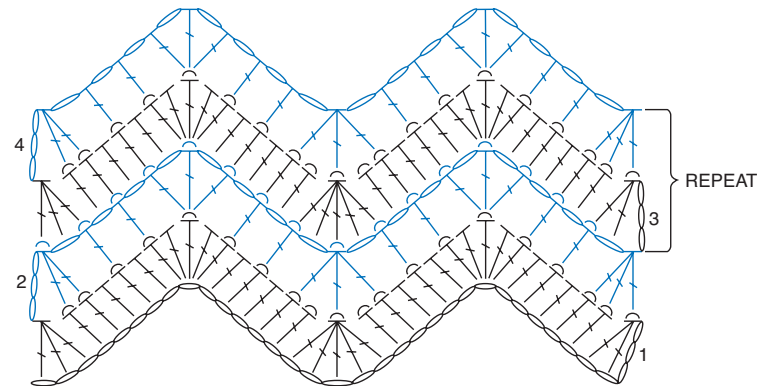
3rd row: With B, ch 3. Dc2tog over first ch-1 sp and next dc (counts as Dc3tog). (1 dc in next ch-1 sp. 1 dc in next dc) twice. 1 dc in next ch-1 sp. 5 dc in next dc. 1 dc in next ch-1 sp. 1 dc in next dc) twice. 1 dc in next ch-1 sp. *Dc5tog (over next 3 dc and 2 ch-1 sps). (1 dc in next ch-1 sp. 1 dc in next dc) twice. 1 dc in next ch-1 sp. 5 dc in next dc. (1 dc in next ch-1 sp. 1 dc in next dc) twice. 1 dc in next ch-1 sp. Rep from * to last 3 sts. Dc3tog over last 3 sts (2 dc and 1 ch-1 sp). Turn.

4th row: As 2nd row. Break B. Join C.

Last 2 rows form Peaks and Valleys Pat. First 4 rows of Stripe Pat are complete.







Cont in Peaks and Valleys and Stripe Pats, until 26 rows of Stripe Pat are complete.

Fasten off.

STITCH KEY

-  = chain (ch)
-  = double crochet (dc)
-  = double crochet 2 together (dc2tog)
-  = double crochet 3 together (dc3tog)
-  = double crochet 5 together (dc5tog)
-  = worked in back loop only
