MATERIALS
Bernat ${ }^{\oplus}$ Blanket Ombre ${ }^{\text {Tm }}$ ( $10.5 \mathrm{oz} / 300 \mathrm{~g} ; 220 \mathrm{yds} / 201 \mathrm{~m}$ )
Navy Ombre (36005)
7 balls or 1510 yds/1381 m
Size U.S. 11 ( 8 mm ) crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge.

## ABBREVIATIONS

Approx = Approximately
Beg $=$ Beginning
$\mathrm{Ch}=$ Chain(s)
Dc = Double crochet
Hdc = Half double crochet
Hdcfp = Yoh and draw up a loop
around post of next stitch at front of work inserting hook from right to left. Yoh and draw through all loops on hook

## MEASUREMENTS

Approx 51 " $\times 60$ " $[129.5 \times 152.5 \mathrm{~cm}$ ], excluding fringe.

## GAUGE

7 sc and 8 rows $=4$ " $[10 \mathrm{~cm}$ ].

## INSTRUCTIONS

Notes: Ch 3 at beg of row counts as dc. Ch 1 at beg of row does not count as st.

Ch 105.
Foundation row: 1 dc in 4th ch from hook (counts as 2 dc ). 2 dc in each of next 2 ch . ${ }^{*}$ (Skip next ch. 1 dc in next ch) 5 times. Skip next ch. 2 dc in each of next 6 ch . Rep from * to end of row, ending final

Pat = Pattern
Rep $=$ Repeat
RS $=$ Right side
$\mathbf{S c}=$ Single crochet
SI st = Slip stitch
$\mathbf{S t}(\mathbf{s})=$ Stitch(es)
WS = Wrong side
Yoh = Yarn over hook
rep with 2 dc in each of last 3 ch . Turn. 102 dc .
1st row: (WS). Ch 1. 1 hdcfp around each dc to end of row. Turn. 102 hdc .
2nd row: Ch 3.1 dc in first st. 2 dc in each of next 2 sts. *(Skip next st. 1 dc in next st) 5 times. Skip next st. 2 dc in each of next 6 sts. Rep from * to end of row, ending final rep with 2 dc in each of last 3 sts. Turn.
Rep these 2 rows until work from beg measures approx 60" [152.5 cm], ending on a WS row. Do not fasten off.

## Top Fringe

1st row: Ch 1.1 sc in each st to end of row. Turn. 102 sc .
2nd row: Ch 1. *(SI st in next sc. Draw up a loop 16" [ 40.5 cm ] long. Twist loop 40 times. SI st in same st, allowing twisted loop to coil around itself) twice. SI st in next sc. Rep from * to last st. SI st in next sc. Draw up a loop 16" [ 40 cm ] long. Twist loop 40 times. SI st in same st, allowing twisted loop to coil around itself. Fasten off.

## Bottom Fringe

With RS facing, join yarn with sl st to last ch of foundation ch.
1st row: Ch 1 . Work 1 sc in each ch to end of chain. Turn. 102 sc .
2nd row: Ch 1. *(SI st in next sc. Draw up a loop 16" [ 40.5 cm ] long. Twist loop 40 times. Sl st in same st, allowing twisted loop to coil around itself) twice. SI st in next sc. Rep from * to last st. SI st in next sc. Draw up a loop 16" [ 40 cm ] long. Twist loop 40 times. SI st in same st, allowing twisted loop to coil around itself. Fasten off.
