



## MATERIALS

**Bernat® Velvet™** (10.5 oz/300 g; 315 yds/288 m)

**Contrast A** Indigo (32007)      **2 balls**

**Contrast B** Velvet teal (32005)      **2 balls**

**Contrast C** White (32029)      **2 balls**

Size U.S. I/9 (5.5 mm) crochet hook **or size needed to obtain gauge.**

## ABBREVIATIONS

**Approx** = Approximately

**Beg** = Beginning

**Ch** = Chain(s)

**Cont** = Continue

## MEASUREMENTS

Approx 48" x 57" [122 x 144.5 cm].

## GAUGE

12 dc and 6 rows = 4" [10 cm].

## INSTRUCTIONS

### Notes:

- Worked over foundation ch multiple of 12 ch + 2.
- Ch 1 at beg of row does not count as st.
- To join new color, work to last loops on hook of previous color. Yoh with new color, draw through rem loops and proceed with new color.

## Stripe Pat

With A, work 2 rows.

With B, work 2 rows.

With C, work 2 rows.

These 6 rows form Stripe Pat.

With A, ch 158. See Chart on page 3.

**1st row:** (RS). 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook. 1 sc in each ch to end of chain. 157 sc. Turn.

**2nd row:** Ch 1. 1 sc in first sc. Sl st in each of next 2 sc. Skip next 2 sc. 3 dc in next sc. 4 dc in next sc. 3 dc in next sc. Skip next 2 sc. Sl st in each of next 2 sc. \*Ch 1. Skip next sc. Sl st in each of next 2 sc. Skip next 2 sc. 3 dc in next sc. 4 dc in next sc. 3 dc in next sc.

Skip next 2 sc. Sl st in each of next 2 sc. Rep from \* to last sc. 1 sc in last sc. Join B. Break A. Turn.

**3rd row:** With B, ch 1. Skip next sc and 2 sl sts. (1 dcbl in next dc. 2 dcbl in next dc) twice. 1 dcbl in next dc. Ch 3. (1 dcbl in next dc. 2 dcbl in next dc) twice. 1 dcbl in next dc. Skip next 2 sl sts. \*1 sc in next ch-1 sp. Skip next 2 sl sts. (1 dcbl in next dc. 2 dcbl in next dc) twice. 1 dcbl in next dc. Ch 3. (1 dcbl in next dc. 2 dcbl in next dc) twice. 1 dcbl in next dc. Skip next 2 sl sts. Rep from \* to last sc. Ch 1. Sl st in last sc. Turn.

**4th row:** Ch 1. Sl st in each of first 5 dc. Skip next 2 dc. 10 dc in next ch-3 sp. Skip next 2 dc. Sl st in each of next 3 dc. \*Ch 1. Skip next (2 dc, 1 sc, 2 dc). Sl st in each of next 3 dc. Skip next 2 dc. 10 dc in next ch-3 sp. Skip next 2 dc. Sl st in each of next 3 dc. Rep from \* to last 2 dc. Sl st in each of next 2 dc. Fasten off. Turn.

**5th row:** Skip first 2 sl sts. Join C with sl st in next sl st (the sl st worked in the 3rd dc from 2 rows below). With C, skip next 2 sl sts. (1 dcbl in next dc. 2 dcbl in next dc) twice. 1 dcbl in next dc.

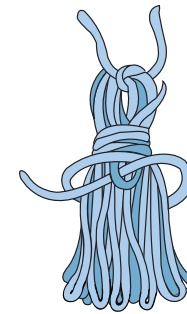
Ch 3. (1 dcbl in next dc. 2 dcbl in next dc) twice. 1 dcbl in next dc. Skip next 3 sl sts. \*1 sc in next ch-1 sp. Skip next 3 sl sts. (1 dcbl in next dc. 2 dcbl in next dc) twice. 1 dcbl in next dc. Ch 3. (1 dcbl in next dc. 2 dcbl in next dc) twice. 1 dcbl in next dc. Skip next 3 sl sts. Rep from \* across, ending last rep with skip next 2 sl sts. Sl st in next sl st. Turn.

**6th row:** Ch 1. Sl st in each of first 5 dc. Skip next 2 dc. 10 dc in next ch-3 sp. Skip next 2 dc. Sl st in each of next 3 dc. \*Ch 1. Skip next (2 dc, 1 sc, 2 dc). Sl st in each of next 3 dc. Skip next 2 dc. 10 dc in next ch-3 sp. Skip next 2 dc. Sl st in each of next 3 dc. Rep from \* to last 2 dc. Sl st in each of next 2 dc. Fasten off. Turn.

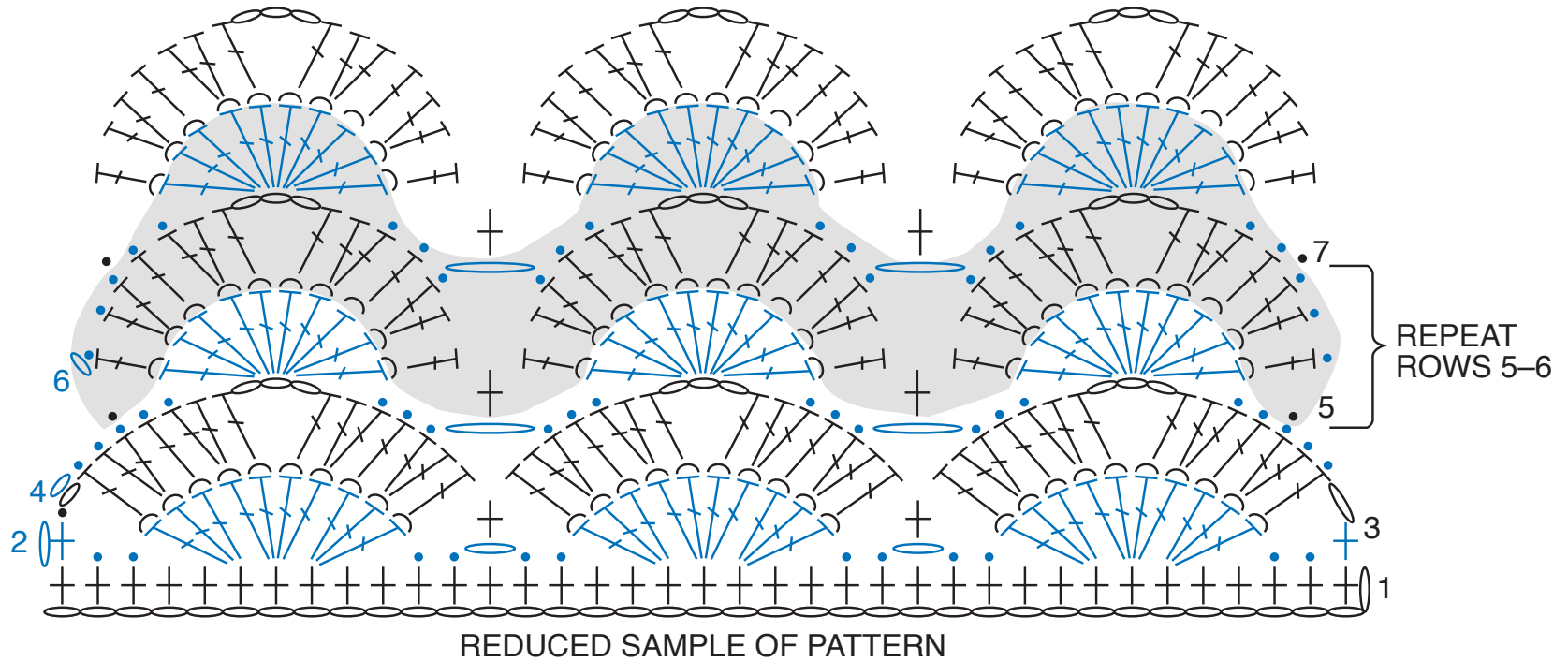
First 6 rows of Stripe Pat are complete. Keeping cont of Stripe Pat, rep 5th and 6th rows until work from beg measures approx 57" [144.5 cm], ending with 1 row of A on a RS row. Fasten off.

## FINISHING

**Loopy Tassels** (make 5 with A. Make 4 with each B and C): Wind yarn around a piece of cardboard 5" [12.5 cm] wide 15 times. Tie through loops securely at 1 end. Wrap yarn 3 times around Tassel 1" [2.5 cm] down from tied end. Fasten securely. Do not cut loops at bottom of tassel. Sew Tassels at each ch-3 sp from last row, alternating A, B, and C as shown in photo.
