Bernat ${ }^{\oplus}$ Blanket ${ }^{\text {Tm }}$ ( $10.5 \mathrm{oz} / 300 \mathrm{~g} ; 220 \mathrm{yds} / 201 \mathrm{~m}$ )

Contrast A Cold Sea (04805)
Contrast B Birch (04809)
Size U.S. M/13 ( 9 mm ) crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge.

Approx = Approximately

## MEASUREMENTS

Approx 47" x 58" ( $119.5 \times 147.5 \mathrm{~cm}$ )

## GAUGE

6.5 sc and 7 rows $=4$ " $(10 \mathrm{~cm})$.

## INSTRUCTIONS

## Notes:

- To change color, work to last loop on hook of previous color. Yoh with new color, draw through loop, tighten previous color and proceed with new color.
- Carry color when not in use loosely up side of work.
- Each skipped sc has ch-2 worked above it for 2 rows. This establishes the 'gap' where Mosaic Dc will later be worked
- Mosaic Dc always replaces sc directly behind it on working row
- WS of your work maintains alternating 2 -row striped pattern because you are working in front of chain spaces each time you work Mosaic Dc you are never working around chain-spaces. The chain-spaces sit behind Mosaic Dc.
- Blanket worked over foundation ch multiple of 4 ch .

With A, ch 80 .
1st row: (RS). 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook. 1 sc in each ch to end of chain. Turn. 79 sc .
2nd row: Ch 1.1 sc in each sc to end of row. Join B. Turn.

## Yarnspirations <br> spark your inspiration!

Proceed in Mosaic Pat as follows: 1st row: (RS). With B, ch 1.1 sc in each of first 3 sc . *Ch 2. Skip next sc. 1 sc in each of next 3 sc . Rep from * to end of row. Turn.
2nd row: Ch 1.1 sc in each of first 3 sc . ${ }^{*}$ Ch 2 . Skip next 2 ch .1 sc in each of next 3 sc . Rep from * to end of row. Join A. Turn.
3rd row: With A, ch 1.1 sc in each of first 2 sc . *Ch 2 . Skip next sc. Mosaic Dc in skipped sc 2 rows below. Ch 2. Skip next sc. 1 sc in next sc. Rep from * to last sc. 1 sc in last sc. Turn.
4th row: Ch 1.1 sc in each of first 2 sc. *Ch 2. Skip next 2 ch. 1 sc in next st. Rep from * to last sc. 1 sc in last sc. Join B. Turn.
5th row: With B, ch 1.1 sc in first sc. Ch 2. Skip next sc. *1 Mosaic Dc in skipped sc 2 rows below. 1 sc in next sc. 1 Mosaic Dc in skipped sc 2 rows below. Ch 2. Skip next sc. Rep from * to last sc. 1 sc in last sc. Turn.
6th row: Ch 1.1 sc in first sc. Ch 2. Skip next 2 ch . ${ }^{* 1}$ sc in each of next 3 sts. Ch 2 . Skip next 2 ch. Rep from * to last sc. 1 sc in last sc. Join A. Turn.

7th row: With A, ch 1.1 sc in first sc. *1 Mosaic Dc in skipped sc 2 rows below. 1 sc in each of next 3 sc . Rep from * to last 2 sts. 1 Mosaic Dc in skipped sc 2 rows below. 1 sc in last sc. Turn.
8th row: Ch 1.1 sc in each st to end of row. Join B. Turn.
9th and 10th rows: With B, ch 1. 1 sc in each sc to end of row. Join A. Turn.

11th and 12th rows: With $A$, as 1st and 2 nd rows.
13th and 14th rows: With $B$, as 3rd and 4 th rows.
15th and 16th rows: With $A$, as 5th and 6th rows.
17th and 18th rows: With $B$, as 7th and 8th rows.


19th and 20th rows: With $A$, ch 1. 1 sc in each sc to end of row. Join B. Turn.

Rep these 20 rows for Mosaic Pat until work from beg measures approx 58 " [147.5 cm], ending on a 20th row of pat. Do not fasten off. Cont as follows for Side Edging:

Side Edging: 1 st row: (RS). With A, work 1 row of sc evenly down left side edge of Blanket. Turn.
2nd row: Ch 1.1 sc in each sc to end of row. Fasten off.
With RS facing, join A with sl st in bottom right corner and work as for opposite side edging.
