



CROCHET | SKILL LEVEL: **EASY**

ABBREVIATIONS

Approx = Approximately

Beg = Begin(ning)

Ch = Chain(s)

Cont = Continue

Dc = Double crochet

Hdc = Half double crochet

Rep = Repeat

RS = Right side

Sc = Single crochet

Sp(s) = Space(s)

St(s) = Stitch(es)

WS = Wrong side

Yoh = Yarn over hook

MEASUREMENTS

Approx 48 x 60" (122 x 152.5 cm)

GAUGE

10 sc and 11 rows = 4" (10 cm).

INSTRUCTIONS

Notes:

- Blanket is worked side to side.
- Blanket is reversible - there is no RS or WS. It will be helpful to mark 1 side as 'WS' for the purpose of pat continuity.

Ch 161.

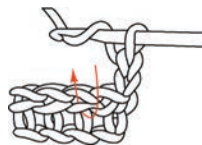
Set-up row: (WS). 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook. 1 sc in each ch to end of chain. Turn. 160 sc.

Proceed in pat as follows:

1st to 9th rows: Ch 1. *Working in back loops only*, 1 sc in each sc to end of row. Turn.

10th row: Ch 2 (**does not** count as st). *Working in back loops only*, 1 hdc in each sc to end of row. Turn.

11th to 19th rows: Ch 2 (**does not** count as st). Work 1 hdc in horizontal bar created below st in previous row (bar is below loops normally worked on WS-see diagram) in each hdc to end of row. Turn.



MATERIALS

Bernat® Symphony™ (7.9 oz/225 g; 309 yds/282 m)

Brocade (21008)

6 balls

Size U.S. L/11 (8 mm) crochet hook **or size needed to obtain gauge.**

Piece of cardboard 5½" [14 cm] wide for tassels.

20th row: Ch 1. *Working in back loops only*, 1 sc in each hdc to end of row. Turn.

These 20 rows form pat.

Cont in pat until work from beg measures approx 45" [114.5 cm], ending on a 20th row of pat.

Next 9 rows: Ch 1. *Working in back loops only*, 1 sc in each sc to end of row. Turn.

Fasten off at end of 9th row.

Tassels (make 12): Wind yarn around a piece of cardboard 5½" [14 cm] wide 20 times. Tie through loops securely at one end. Cut loops on opposite end. Wrap yarn 3 times around Tassel 1" [2.5 cm] down from tied end. Fasten securely. Sew Tassels (6 on each side), evenly spaced, along top and bottom edges of Afghan having 1 Tassel in each corner.
