

MATERIALS
Bernat $^{\oplus}$ Blanket ${ }^{\text {TM }}$ ( $10.5 \mathrm{oz} / 300 \mathrm{~g} ; 220 \mathrm{yds} / 201 \mathrm{~m}$ )
Contrast A Silver Steel (10001) $\mathbf{4}$ balls or $\mathbf{8 0 8} \mathbf{y d s} / 739$ m
Contrast B Vintage White (10006) 3 balls or 557 yds/509 m
Size U.S. L/11 (8 mm) crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge.

## ABBREVIATIONS

| Approx = Approximately | RS = Right side |

| Ch = Chain(s) | SI st = Slip stitch |

## MEASUREMENTS

Approx 50½" x 64" [128 x 162.5 cm ].

## GAUGE

7 sc and 8 rows $=4$ " $[10 \mathrm{~cm}$ ].
3 V-sts and 4.5 rows $=4$ " $[10 \mathrm{~cm}]$ in pat.

## INSTRUCTIONS

## Notes:

- Ch 3 at beg of row counts as dc.
- Work initial chain firmly to match height of following rows.
- To change colors, work to last 2 loops on hook of last st. Draw new color through last 2 loops and proceed.

With A, ch 117 (multiple of $3 \mathrm{ch}+6$ ).
(See diagram on page 2.)
Foundation row: (RS). (1 dc. Ch 1. 1 dc - V-st made) in 6th ch from hook (skipped ch-5 counts as 1 dc and 2 skipped ch). *Skip next 2 ch. V-st in next ch. Rep from * to last 3 ch. Skip next 2 ch. 1 dc in last ch. 37 V-sts. Turn.
1st row: Ch 3. V-st in ch-1 sp of each V-st to end of row. 1 dc in top of turning-ch. Turn.
Rep last row to form Pat.
With A, work 6 more rows in pat. Join B.
**With B, work 8 rows in pat. Join A.

With A, work 8 rows in pat. Join
B.**

Rep from ** to ** 3 times more. Fasten off.

## FINISHING

Side edging: With RS facing, join A with sl st to bottom right corner of Blanket. Ch 1. Work 1 row of sc evenly up side edge of Blanket. Fasten off.
Rep for opposite side.
