

## MATERIALS

Bernat $^{\oplus}$ Blanket $^{\text {Tm }}$ ( $10.5 \mathrm{oz} / 300 \mathrm{~g} ; 220 \mathrm{yds} / 201 \mathrm{~m}$ )

Contrast A Lapis (10800)
1 ball or $118 \mathrm{yds} / 108 \mathrm{~m}$
2 balls or 404 yds/369 m
Contrast B Vintage White (10006)
5 balls or $1100 \mathrm{yds} / 1005 \mathrm{~m}$
Contrast C Malachite (10802)
Bernat ${ }^{\oplus}$ Blanket Brights ${ }^{\text {TM }}$ ( $10.5 \mathrm{oz} / 300 \mathrm{~g} ; 220 \mathrm{yds} / 201 \mathrm{~m}$ )
Contrast D Race Car Red (12001) $\mathbf{1}$ ball or $\mathbf{1 1 8}$ yds/108 m
Size U.S. L/11 ( 8 mm ) crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge. Yarn needle.

## ABBREVIATIONS

## Approx =

Approximately Ch = Chain(s)
Cont $=$ Continue(ity)
Dc = Double crochet Dc2tog = (Yoh and draw up a loop in next stitch. Yoh and draw through 2 loops on hook) twice. Yoh and draw through all loops on hook.

Dc3tog = (Yoh and draw up a loop in next stitch. Yoh and draw through 2 loops on hook) 3 times. Yoh and draw through all loops on hook.
Pat = Pattern
Rem = Remain(ing)
Rep $=$ Repeat Rnd(s) = Round(s) RS = Right side

## MEASUREMENTS

Approx 54" x 63½" [137 x 161 cm ]

## GAUGE

7 sc and 8 rows $=4$ " $[10 \mathrm{~cm}]$.

## INSTRUCTIONS

## Notes:

- To join new color, work to last loops on hook of previous color. Yoh with new color, draw through rem loops and proceed with new color.
- Numbers are made after Blanket and sewn on in Finishing


## Stripe Pat

With A, work 9 rows. Join B. Break A.
*With B, work 1 row. Join C. Break B. With C, work 9 rows. Join B. Break C.*
Rep from * to * 9 times more (for a total of 10 C-stripes).
With B, work 1 row. Join D. Break B. With D, work 9 rows.
These 119 rows form Stripe Pat.

## BLANKET

With A, ch 89.
1st row: (RS). 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook. 1 sc in each ch to end of chain. Turn. 88 sc
2nd row: Ch 1.1 sc in each sc to end of row. Turn.
First 2 rows of Stripe Pat are complete.

Keeping cont of Stripe Pat, rep last row 117 times more until Stripe Pat is complete.
Fasten off.

Edging: 1st rnd: (RS). Join B with sl st to any corner of Blanket. Ch 1. Work sc evenly around working ( $1 \mathrm{sc} . \mathrm{Ch} 2.1 \mathrm{sc}$ ) in each corner. Join with sl st to first sc.
2nd to 4th rnds: Ch 1.1 sc in each sc around working ( $1 \mathrm{sc} . \mathrm{Ch} 2.1 \mathrm{sc}$ ) in each corner ch-1 sp. Join with sl st to first sc.
Fasten off.

## NUMBERS

Number 5 (make 2)
With B, ch 29.
1st row: (RS). 1 dc in 4th ch from hook (counts as 2 dc ). 1 dc in each of next 2 ch .2 dc in next ch. Ch 2. 2 dc in next ch. 1 dc in next ch. 2 dc
in next ch. Ch 2. 2 dc in next ch. Dc3tog. Dc2tog. 1 dc in next ch. (Dc3tog) twice. 1 dc in each of next 2 ch . Dc2tog. 1 dc in each of last 2 ch . Fasten off.

## Number 0 (make 2)

With B, ch 22. Join with sl st to first ch, taking care not to twist ch.
1st rnd: Ch 3 (counts as 1 dc). 2 dc in same ch as last sl st. 1 dc in each of next 7 ch .3 dc in next ch. 1 dc in each of next 2 ch .3 dc in next ch. 1 dc in each of next 7 ch .3 dc in next ch. 1 dc in each of next 2 ch . Sl st in top fo first ch-3. Fasten off.

## FINISHING

With RS facing and B, sew Numbers 5 and 0 onto right edge of Blanket on either side of central white stripe to indicate 50 -yard line (as shown in photo). Rep for left side of Blanket.
