Size U.S. L/11 ( 8 mm ) crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge. Yarn needle.

## MEASUREMENTS

Approximately (approx) $501 / 22^{\prime \prime} \times 59^{\prime \prime}$ [128.5 x 150 cm ], excluding fringe.

## GAUGE

7 dc and 4 rows $=4$ " $[10 \mathrm{~cm}$ ].

## INSTRUCTIONS

## Notes:

- To begin working with the O'Go format, carefully cut plastic tie where the ends of the O'Go meet.
- Pull tie to remove.
- For this pattern, colors can be easily separated by gently pulling apart and cutting at the color transition. Each color is ready to use.
- Follow color guide shown in Materials section for O'Go (Contrast A, B, C, D, E, F, G, H). You may find it helpful to place each color section in its own resealable (zip lock) bag and label each bag - A, B, C, D, E, F, G, H (notice that Contrast E appears in $2 \mathrm{O}^{\prime}$ Gos).
- To change color, work to last 2 loops on hook and draw new color through last 2 loops and proceed in new color.
- Blanket is worked in 3 Motifs worked diagonally from corner to corner, and joined together in finishing.


## BLANKET

## Panel 1

Color 1 is $A$
Color 2 is D
Color 3 is E

## Panel 2

Color 1 is $B$
Color 2 is G
Color 3 is F

## Panel 3

Color 1 is C
Color 2 is H
Color 3 is E

PANEL (Make 1 each of Panels 1, 2 and 3)

With Color 1, ch 6 . See stitch diagram on page 3 and Chart on page 4. Each square of chart represents 1 block.

1 st row: (RS). 1 dc in 4th ch from hook (counts as 2 dc ). 1 dc in each of last 2 ch . Turn. 1 block made.
2nd row: Ch 6. 1 dc in 4th ch from hook. 1 dc in each of next 2 ch - beg block made. (SI st. Ch 3.3 dc) in next ch-3 sp - block made. Turn. 2 blocks.
3rd row: Beg block. *Block in next ch-3 sp. Rep from * to end of row. Turn. 3 blocks.
Keeping cont of color changes in Chart (each square on grid represents 1 block), rep last row until 14th row of chart is complete. 14 blocks.

Keeping cont of Chart, proceed as follows to work sides even:
15th row: Sl st in each of first 3 dc . *Block in next ch-3 sp. Rep from * to end of row. Turn.
16th row: Beg block. *Block in next ch-3 sp. Rep from * to last ch-3 sp. Sl st in last ch-3 sp. (Do not make a block.) Turn.
17th to 36th rows: Rep last 2 rows 10 times more.

Keeping cont of Chart, proceed as follows to dec corner:
37th row: Sl st in each of first 3 dc . *Block in next ch-3 sp. Rep from * to last ch-3 sp. SI st in last ch-3 sp. (Do not make a block.) Turn.
Keeping cont of Chart, rep last row until 1 block rem. Fasten off.

## FINISHING

## Joining Panels

Using color to match stripes, sew 3 Panels tog as seen in Assembly Diagram on page 3, noting Panel 2 is mirrored with WS facing, and Panels 1 and 3 are RS facing. Take care to align edges and match stripes, and make sure seams are hidden.


Fringe: Cut strands of $D, E$, and $F$ 10 " [ 25.5 cm ] long. Taking 1 strand each of D, E, and F (3 strands tog), fold in half and knot into fringe around last st at end of each row along top and bottom edges of Blanket (end of each row along bottom edge will be either a ch-3 or dc st; end of each row along top edge will be either a ch-3 or center dc of block - refer to Stitch Diagram on page 4 for fringe placement). Trim fringe evenly.
