



CROCHET | SKILL LEVEL: **EASY**

ABBREVIATIONS

Approx = Approximately	Hdc = Half double crochet	Sc = Single crochet
Beg = Beginning	Pat = Pattern	St(s) = Stitch(es)
Ch = Chain(s)	Rep = Repeat	Tog = Together
Cont = Continue	RS = Right side	WS = Wrong side

MEASUREMENTS

Approx 47" x 57" [119 x 145 cm].

GAUGE

7 sc and 8 rows = 4" [10 cm].

INSTRUCTIONS

Notes:

- Ch 2 at beg of row **does not** count as st.
- To change colors, work to last loops on hook of last st. Draw new color through last loops and proceed.

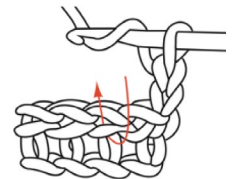
Stripe Pat

With MC, work 6 rows.
With A, work 2 rows.
These 8 rows form Stripe Pat.

With MC, ch 84.

Proceed in Stripe Pat as follows:
Set-up row: (RS). 1 hdc in 3rd ch from hook and each ch to end of chain. Turn. 82 hdc.

1st row: (WS.) Ch 2 (**does not** count as st). *Working in horizontal bar only, created by hdc at front of work (see diagram), 1 hdc in next st. Rep from * end of row. Turn.



Note: Diagram illustrates WS of work.

First 2 rows of Stripe Pat are complete.

Keeping cont of Stripe Pat, rep last row until work from beg measures approx 57" [145 cm], ending with 6 rows of MC. Fasten off.

MATERIALS

Bernat® Blanket Speckle™ (10.5 oz/300 g; 220 yds/201 m)

Main Color (MC) Typewriter (02009) **5 balls**

Bernat® Blanket™ (10.5 oz/300 g; 220 yds/201 m)

Contrast A Gray Silt (04823) **2 balls**

Size U.S. L/11 (8 mm) crochet hook **or size needed to obtain gauge.**
