



CROCHET | SKILL LEVEL: **EASY**

## ABBREVIATIONS

<b>Approx</b> =	<b>Pat</b> = Pattern	<b>Sl st</b> = Slip stitch
Approximately	<b>Rep</b> = Repeat	<b>Sp(s)</b> = Space(s)
<b>Beg</b> = Beginning	<b>Rnd(s)</b> = Round(s)	<b>St(s)</b> = Stitch(es)
<b>Ch</b> = Chain(s)	<b>RS</b> = Right side	
<b>Dc</b> = Double crochet	<b>Sc</b> = Single crochet	

## MEASUREMENTS

Approx 50" x 60" [127 cm x 152.5 cm].

## GAUGE

8 sts (including dc and ch-1 sps) and 4 rows = 4" [10 cm] in Granny St Pat.

## INSTRUCTIONS

### Notes:

- Beg working from darkest end of yarn at bottom edge of Blanket.
- To maintain ombre effect join next ball from opposite end so shades match (lightest end to lightest end or darkest end to darkest end) as necessary, resulting in a fade from dark-to-light to light-to-dark, and back again across the Blanket.
- Ch 3 at beg of rows counts as dc.

## BLANKET

Ch 103 (multiple of 4 ch + 3).  
See diagram on page 2.

**1st row:** (RS). 3 dc in 8th ch from hook (skipped ch-7 counts as 1 dc, ch 1, and skip next 3 ch). \*Ch 1. Skip next 3 ch. 3 dc in next ch. Rep from \* to last 3 ch. Ch 1. Skip next 2 ch. 1 dc in last ch. Turn. 24 groups of 3-dc.

**2nd row:** Ch 3. 2 dc in first ch-1 sp. \*Ch 1. 3 dc in next ch-1 sp. Rep from \* to last turning ch-7 sp. Ch 1. 3 dc in 7th ch of ch-7 sp. Turn. 25 groups of 3-dc.

**3rd row:** Ch 4 (counts as dc and ch 1). \*3 dc in next ch-1 sp. Ch 1. Rep from \* to last group of 3-dc. 1 dc in top of turning ch-3. Turn. 24 groups of 3-dc.

## MATERIALS

**Bernat® Blanket Perfect Phasing™** (10.5 oz/300 g; 220 yds/201 m)  
Dark Orchid (43007) **8 balls**

Size U.S. L/11 (8 mm) Susan Bates® Silvalume® crochet hook **or size needed to obtain gauge.** Susan Bates® yarn needle.

**4th row:** Ch 3. 2 dc in first ch-1 sp.  
\*Ch 1. 3 dc in next ch-1 sp. Rep from  
\* to last turning ch sp. Ch 1. 3 dc in  
turning ch-4 sp. Turn. 25 groups of  
3-dc.

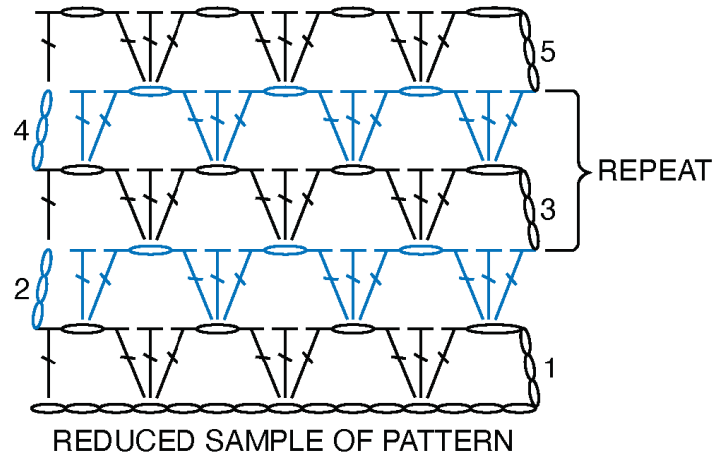
Rep last 2 rows for Granny St  
Pat until Blanket measures 60"  
[152.5 cm], ending on a WS row.  
Fasten off.

## FINISHING

### Edging

**1st rnd:** (RS). Join yarn with sl st to  
any corner of Blanket. Ch 1. (1 sc.  
Ch 1. 1 sc) in same sp as sl st. Work  
sc evenly around, having (1 sc. Ch 1.  
1 sc) in each corner. Join with sl st  
to first sc.

**2nd rnd:** Ch 1. 1 sc in each sc  
around, working 3 sc in each corner  
ch-1 sp. Join with sl st to first sc.  
Fasten off.
