



CROCHET | SKILL LEVEL: **EASY**

## ABBREVIATIONS

**Approx** = Approximately

**Beg** = Begin(ning)

**Ch** = Chain(s)

**Hdc** = Half double crochet

**Hdchb** = Work 1 hdc into horizontal bar created below in previous row (bar is below loops normally worked on WS)

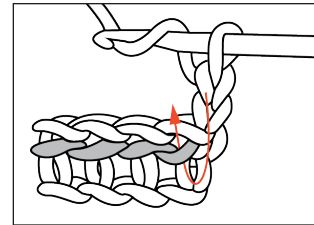
**Pat** = Pattern

**Rep** = Repeat

**RS** = Right side

**St(s)** = Stitch(es)

**WS** = Wrong side



## MEASUREMENTS

Approx 46½" x 55" [118 x 139.5 cm].

## GAUGE

8 hdc and 5 rows = 4" [10 cm] in Pat.

## INSTRUCTIONS

### Notes:

- Ch 1 at beg of row **does not** count as st.
- Blanket is worked from side to side.

Ch 111.

**1st row:** (RS). 1 hdc in 2nd ch from hook. 1 hdc in each ch to end of chain. Turn. 110 hdc.

**2nd row:** Ch 1. 1 hdchb in each st to end of row. Turn.

Rep 2nd row until Blanket measures approx 46½" [139.5 cm], ending on a WS row.

Fasten off.

## MATERIALS

**Bernat® Forever Fleece Tweeds™** (8.8 oz/250 g; 158 yds/145 m)

Rolling Sky Tweed (79015)

**10 balls or 1566 yds/1437 m**

Size U.S. N/15 (10 mm) Susan Bates® Silvalume® crochet hook **or size needed to obtain gauge.** Susan Bates® yarn needle.
