



CROCHET | SKILL LEVEL: **INTERMEDIATE**

ABBREVIATIONS

Approx = Approximately

Beg = Begin(ning)(s)

Ch = Chain(s)

Dcbp = Yoh and draw up a loop around post of next stitch at back of work, inserting hook from right to left. (Yoh and draw through 2 loops on hook) twice.

Dcfp = Yoh and draw up a loop around post of next stitch at front of work, inserting hook from right to left. (Yoh and draw through 2 loops on hook) twice.

Hdc = Half double crochet

Hdchb = 1 hdc in horizontal bar (see diagram below)

Pat = Pattern

Prev = Previous(ly)

Rep = Repeat

RS = Right side

Sc = Single crochet

St(s) = Stitch(es)

WS = Wrong side

Yoh = Yarn over hook

MEASUREMENTS

Approx 42 x 52" [107 x 132 cm].

GAUGE

10 sc and 11 rows = 4" [10 cm].

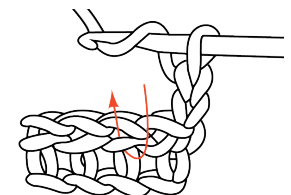
INSTRUCTIONS

Note: Ch 2 at beg of row **does not** count as st.

Ch 133.

1st row: (RS). 1 hdc in 3rd ch from hook. 1 hdc in each ch to end of ch. 131 hdc. Turn.

2nd row: Ch 2. [Work 1 hdc into horizontal bar created below st in prev row (bar is below loops normally worked on WS – 1 hdchb made. See diagram)] 9 times. *1 dcbp around each of next 3 sts. 1 dcfp around each of next 7 sts. Rep from * to last 12 hdc. 1 dcbp around each of next 3 sts. (1 hdchb in next st) 9 times. Turn.



MATERIALS

Bernat® Maker™ (8.8 oz/250 g; 317 yds/290 m)

Clay (06002)

8 balls or 2333 yds/2133 m

Size U.S. L/11 [8 mm] Susan Bates® Silvalume® crochet hook **or size needed to obtain gauge.** Susan Bates® yarn needle.

3rd row: Ch 2. (1 hdchb in next st) 9 times. *1 dcfp around each of next 3 sts. 1 hdc in each of next 7 sts. Rep from * last 12 hdc. 1 dcfp around each of next 3 sts. (1 hdchb in next st) 9 times. Turn.

Rep last 2 rows for pat until Blanket measures 48" [122 cm], ending on a 2nd row. Fasten off.

Top and Bottom Edgings

Ch 11.

1st row: (RS). 1 hdc in 3rd ch from hook. 1 hdc in each ch to end of ch. Turn. 9 hdc.

2nd row: Ch 2. *Work 1 hdc into horizontal bar created below st in prev row. Rep from * to end of row. Turn.

Rep last row until Edging measures length (when slightly stretched) to fit bottom edge of Blanket. Fasten off.

Rep for top edge.

Sew Edgings to top and bottom of Blanket.
